Brookshire swears in new council members; community plans town hall

In a brief Monday afternoon meeting, Brookshire's newest alderperson, Monique Taylor, was sworn in for the Position 1 seat alongside re-elected Mayor Darrell

Branch and Alderperson for Po-

sition 2 Lyndon Stamps after the council voted to approve canvasing of the May 1 election tallies.

Taylor took the Position 1 seat with about 69% of the vote in her race against incumbent Marilyn Vaughn. Branch retained the mayoral seat with roughly 62% of the

vote while Stamps held his posi-tion more narrowly with only about 34% of the vote, narrowly beating runner-up, Susette Inez Baines.

The election is over, but Baines said she is working to still serve the Brookshire community. She is planning a town hall meeting for

city residents with representatives from city government as well as Waller County. The meeting will be held at The Hangar Unity Center - 4010 Fourth Street in Brookshire - at 2 p.m. on June 6. Anyone with questions for panelists can email those questions in advance

to brookshiretownhallmeeting@ gmail.com. Questions are due no later than May 21, Baines said.
