The Vaccination Clinic is being offered by the Elk Animal Shelter from Atlanta, Michigan.

Clinic Fees (Include Dog License)

\$5.00 for altered (spayed or neutered)

\$10.00 for unaltered

\$20.00 Rabies Vaccination

\$20.00 Dist. Parvo

\$25.00 Parvo w/Lepto

\$25.00 Microchips

A current rabies certificate, proof of age and proof of spayed or neutered, if applicable. For a 3-year rabies certificate, bring past rabies cert; otherwise rabies will be valid for a year.

Dog license and rabies shot must be up-to-date by **February 28, 2019**. The Animal Control Officer will be issuing citations to those owners of dogs that do not have the proper tags. (A citations for no license \$150-\$200 and citations for no rabies from \$150-\$200). Inquires may contact the Oscoda County Animal Control Officer at **989-745-1910**.
