

# **PA 188 of 1954 Proceedings Comins Township Oscoda County, Michigan**

## **Notice of Public hearings on the proposed AIS Plan for the Special Assessment District and the Special Assessment Roll for Perry Lakes**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that as resulting from signed petitions of property owners whose parcels constitute more than 50 percent of the total parcel IDs of the Perry Lake assessment district, the Township Board of the Township of Comins proposes to improve the lakes and to create a special assessment for the recovery of the cost thereof by special assessment against the properties benefited therein.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the district within which the foregoing improvement is proposed is further described as the removal and control of the invasive weed Eurasian Milfoil that is growing in Perry lakes.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the township board has received a lake management plan from Restorative Lake Sciences for this improvement showing the estimated cost will be an annual cost of \$15,000 for a contract for 6 years including all administrative township fees. The township is planning to vote on a resolution that states its intention is to make the improvement and to create the special assessment district.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that said plans, estimates of cost, proposed special assessment district and petitions may be examined at the Comins Township Office of the township clerk from the date of this notice through the date of the public hearings and may be examined at such public hearings.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that public hearings on the petitions, plans, district and estimate of costs will be held at the Comins Township hall at 1651 N. Abbe, Fairview, Michigan, commencing at 6:00 o'clock p.m. on April 24th and April 26th .

At the hearings, the board will consider any written objections to any of the foregoing matters filed with the board at or before the hearings as well as any revisions, corrections, amendments, or changes to the plans, estimates and costs or special assessment district.

All interested persons are invited to be present at the hearing to voice comments and concerns.
