## PUBLIC NOTICE

All citizens are advised that Ogemaw County Board of Commissioners on behalf of the Ogemaw County Public Transit has prepared an application for State of Michigan financial assistance for fiscal year 2019 as required under Act 51 of the Public Acts of 1951, as amended, and for federal assistance as required under the federal transit laws, as amended. Ogemaw is requesting a total of \$2,121,750 through the following funding source(s):

Federal Operating \$171,267. State Formula Operating \$362,885. Local revenue \$65,627 millage revenue \$249,871, estimated fare box revenue \$98,500, other funding sources \$19,500, and \$1,154,100 Federal/State capital funding. \$88,200 in STP funding for a revenue vehicle and maintenance equipment. \$1,065,900 in Section 5339 funding for the purchase of 5 revenue vehicles, a 6-passenger expansion van, an in-ground hoist, office and security equipment, facility improvements and expansion, and a fueling station.
