# The American Legion Post 72 celebrates over 100 years!

The post, located in Crawford sville, applied for a charter in 1919 which took until October 1, 1920 to obtain. The organization as a whole traces its roots to March 15-17, 1919 in Paris, France in the aftermath of World War I. The American Legion was federally chartered on September 16, 1919 and quickly became an influential force at the national, state and local levels, dedicated to service to veterans, strong national defense, youth and patriotism.

A year after it was formed, The American Legion had chartered more than 5,400 local posts that continue to operate today. Since then it has grown to more than 13,000 posts around the world and more than 2.2

million wartime-veteran members. Throughout its first century, The American Legion built a legacy on such accomplishments as leading the way to create U.S. Flag Code, helping start the Veterans Administration. drafting and getting passed the Servicemen's Readjustment Act of 1944 (the GI Bill) which transformed America in the second half of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, and helping veterans receive benefits for healthcare conditions based on their honorable service including acceptance of Agent Orange exposure as serviceconnected. Today, The American Legion has nearly 3,000 accredited service officers worldwide who assist veterans with their benefits

claims and other concerns.

Post 72, was named after Byron Cox (the first Montgomery County boy to die in WWI). 


