## GENERAL LEW WALLACE STUDY & MUSEUM

General Lew Wallace was a military hero, artist, musician, politician and also was the author of "Ben-Hur: A Tale of the Christ." The General Lew Wallace Study & Museum honors his memory and works. The museum houses personal artifacts from

his service as the Minister of Turkey, Governor of the New Mexico Territory, Civil War Major General and Vice President of the trial of those who conspired to assassinate President Abraham Lincoln. Its interior has been fully restored to its 1896 appearance. In 2008, the museum was awarded the National Medal for Museum Service, which is the highest honor for museums that make their communities better places to live. A gift shop is offered. Museum

hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday. Paid tours take about an hour. For more information, call 765-362-5769 or visit [www.ben-hur.com](http://www.ben-hur.com).

The Carnegie Museum of Montgomery County is an interdisciplinary, interactive museum of history, science and art. It is located in downtown Crawfordsville and housed in Indiana's first Carnegie Library. The building opened in 1902 and served as Crawfordsville's public library until 2005, when the library relocated to a new building across the street. The Museum opened in 2007 and is owned and operated by the Crawfordsville District Public Library. The Carnegie Museum has seven galleries on two floors with a variety of themes and rotating exhibits. The "Montgomery County WOW!" gallery highlights local residents who have achieved fame, as well as Montgomery County crinoid fossils, popular movies with ties to the area and the county's impact on the early years of basketball. Other galleries feature Local Authors, Military, Early History and Local Businesses. The museum also hosts a variety of state and national traveling exhibits each year, along

with hands-on science activities and local art shows. In addition to the annual changing exhibits, the museum presents a number of interactive, family-friendly programs throughout the year. The annual Summer at the Museum program gives kids a fun way to learn about the museum's exhibits, while special event days such as Pi Day, Brain Day and Maker Day are designed to bring educational fun to community members of all ages. The Carnegie Museum is open to the public year-round, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday and also by appointment. Admission is free. Entrance to the museum is at street level, and the building is stroller and wheelchair accessible. Visitors of all ages are welcome, including tour groups and field trips. Lane Place is the home of Senator Henry S. and Joanna Lane. The grounds are the setting of the annual Strawberry Festival, free summer concerts performed by the Montgomery County Civic Band and many other events. Lane Place is

recognized on the National Register of Historic Places. In 1845, Henry and Joanna Lane built the home in an area now called the Elston Grove Historic District. He was a governor, U.S. Representative and Senator. He helped form the Republican Party and was chair of the first National Republican Convention in 1856. At the 1860 Republican National Convention he was very instrumental in getting Abraham Lincoln placed on the ballot. Joanna Lane's sister, Susan, married Lew Wallace making Lane and Wallace brothers-in-law. Lane Place is open for tours and most of the furnishings are original to the Lanes. The home takes visitors back to an era of elegance and beauty. The Speed Cabin sits on the grounds at Lane Place. The cabin was owned by John and Margaret Speed and was used as a safe place for the Underground Railroad in Indiana. The Pattison Pavilion, constructed in 1995, is the home of the Montgomery County Civic Band and serves as a beautiful setting for numerous weddings. Museum hours are 1-5 p.m. Tuesdays and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesdays through Saturdays (closed on Sundays and Mondays). The museum closes Dec. 1 and opens April 1. Paid admission. **ROTARY JAIL MUSEUM**

The Rotary Jail Museum of Montgomery County was one of 18 rotary jails built in the United States in the 1880's. It was the first rotary jail built in the nation, and is the only one that still revolves. By rotating a giant turntable on which a two-tiered cellblock sits, a jailer could bring one of 16 wedge-shaped cells to the single front opening, allowing a prisoner in or out. The jail is located behind the residence the sheriff's family would occupy during his term in office. The sheriff's residence is home to changing exhibits throughout the year. Behind the jail is the Tannenbaum Cultural Center, a renovated 1887 steam plant that once heated the jail, the sheriff's residence and the courthouse. It is now host to art classes, summer art camps and special events, and can be rented out by local residents for special occasions. The Rotary Jail Museum is open for tours 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday and is open to 5 p.m. in the summer from Memorial Day to Labor Day. The museum is closed in the winter from mid-December through February.

From train collectors to those who are fascinated by rail travel, the Linden Depot Museum can put you on the right track. The museum features a 1907 intact junction depot, which is the oldest of its kind and has been recorded on the National Register of Historic Places. Linden-Madison Township Historical Society operates the museum depot, which was restored to reflect a 1950s look. The area previously served the Monon and Nickel Plate railroad lines. History on the two railroads can be found in the museum. The E.E. Kauffman train collection is displayed in the Monon agent's room. A live steam train model of the Monon 4-4-0 locomotive with a passenger coach is included in the display as well as a three-quarter-inch scale. Model railroad layouts are on display along

with many railway artifacts. Also on display are the Nickel Plate Caboose No. 497, the Monon 1620, a cabooses, a flat car, a boxcar, a Plymouth switch engine and the Monon and Nickel Plate baggage rooms. A gift shop is available. The museum is open to the public from 12-5 p.m. Friday, Saturday and Sunday, May through September. Paid admission required. Off-season and special visitations or tours can be arranged by calling the society. The society waives its admission fees for school groups, daycare groups and scouting groups if they pre-schedule their visits in advance. **FISHING SUGAR CREEK**

Outdoor lovers have access to Sugar Creek with the opening of the Sugar Creek Public Fishing Area, southwest of Crawfordsville. The Montgomery County site is approximately 1.5 miles south of State Road 32 on Camp Rotary Road, and approximately 1 mile west on Offield Road. The DNR Division of Fish and Wildlife purchased the approximately 12.5-acre area as part of a larger partnership to acquire 41 acres. The 12.5-acre site has been planted with trees using a tree planter



from the Indiana State Chapter of the National Wild Turkey Federation and includes a parking lot. The existing path to the creek for canoes has been improved. Pheasants Forever will plant a portion of the site with warm-season grasses. The remaining land, owned and managed by NICHES Land

Trust, was acquired with funds from the Indiana Heritage Trust, NICHES Land Trust, The Nature Conservancy and Friends of Sugar Creek. That 28.5-acre area, known as Bachner Nature Preserve, also has been planted with native trees and grasses with support from Pheasants Forever. Fishing is al-



Bachner Nature Preserve comprises 28 acres of woodland and includes 1/4-mile of creek frontage at the confluence of Rattlesnake and Sugar Creeks. The stream fea-

tures abundant macro-invertebrate species, fish and juvenile amphibians, such as soft-shell turtle. The riparian edge offers excellent habitat for a variety of birds, such as the belted kingfisher. In addition to birds, the woods support various land wildlife including raccoon, fox and potentially river otter.

The community center, at 26,000 square feet, has a gymnasium, walking track, group fitness room, gymnastics room, locker rooms, children's playroom, weight room with cardio equipment and a multi-purpose room. pad opened in 2012 at the pool. Park visitors will find a baseball field, softball field, picnic sites and shelters. The park is home to several special events throughout the year. To rent a shelter, call 765-364-5175.

Elston Park South — The 13.5-acre park is partially wooded and is located along the banks of Sugar Creek on Lafayette Road. The site is used for a public canoe launch, adult touch football league and various "pick-up" games.

Elston Park North — The Crawfordsville Area Softball Association developed Elston Park North with three lighted softball fields, a picnic shelter, play equipment, batting cages and a concession stand. The 23-acre park is along the banks of Sugar Creek with its entrance off Lafayette Avenue. Park and Rec-sponsored softball leagues, including men's, women's and co-ed, use the park for games.

Neighborhood parks — Smaller neighborhood parks in Crawfordsville include Lincoln Park on West Wabash Avenue, Goose Nibble Park on East Tuttle Avenue, the Frances Wooden Northside Park on North Grant Avenue and the Kathleen J. Steele Park on West Main Street.

## MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS

In Indiana, you may make a right turn on red unless otherwise notes. (Left turns on red from a one-way street onto a one-way street also are allowed.) A complete stop is required before turning. Speed limits are generally 30 mph in town and 55 mph on highways. Interstate speeds are 70 mph in

rural areas and 55 mph near cities. Buckle your seat belt in Indiana; it's the law. Children younger than age 4 must be secured in a car seat and children ages 4-12 must be in a child's safety seat or seat belt. To establish residency, register your vehicle and get your Indiana driver's license within 60 days of moving to the state. You'll be required to pass visual and written tests and surrender your old license.

- You will be 18 years of age by the time of the next general election;
- You will have been a resident of your precinct for 30 days before the election and you are not currently in prison after being convicted of a crime.

As of July 1, 2001, anyone wishing to vote must give their 10 digit Indiana Driver's License number or if you do not have an Indiana Driver's License, you may give the last four digits of your social security number.

## DEADLINES & IMPORTANT DATES

The deadline to register to vote is 29 days before an election. Registration begins 30 days after an election.


