# Businesses positive about future, growth

A majority of Cedar Park's businesses feel Cedar Park is heading in the right direction and feel they are doing better or the same as they did last year, according to over 300 individuals associated with Cedar Park businesses in a recent business climate survey conducted by the Cedar Park Chamber of Commerce.

The respondents were evenly split - 45% each - between feeling they were doing better than last year or doing just the same.

On the other end of the spectrum, only 5% said they were doing worse than last year, and only 10% said Cedar

Park was moving in the wrong direction.

An overwhelming majority of respondents said they feel the Chamber is doing a good job advocating for local businesses and supporting its efforts to lobby for more transportation upgrades that will impact Cedar Park and against bills damaging to "Texas' reputation as a 'business-friendly' state."

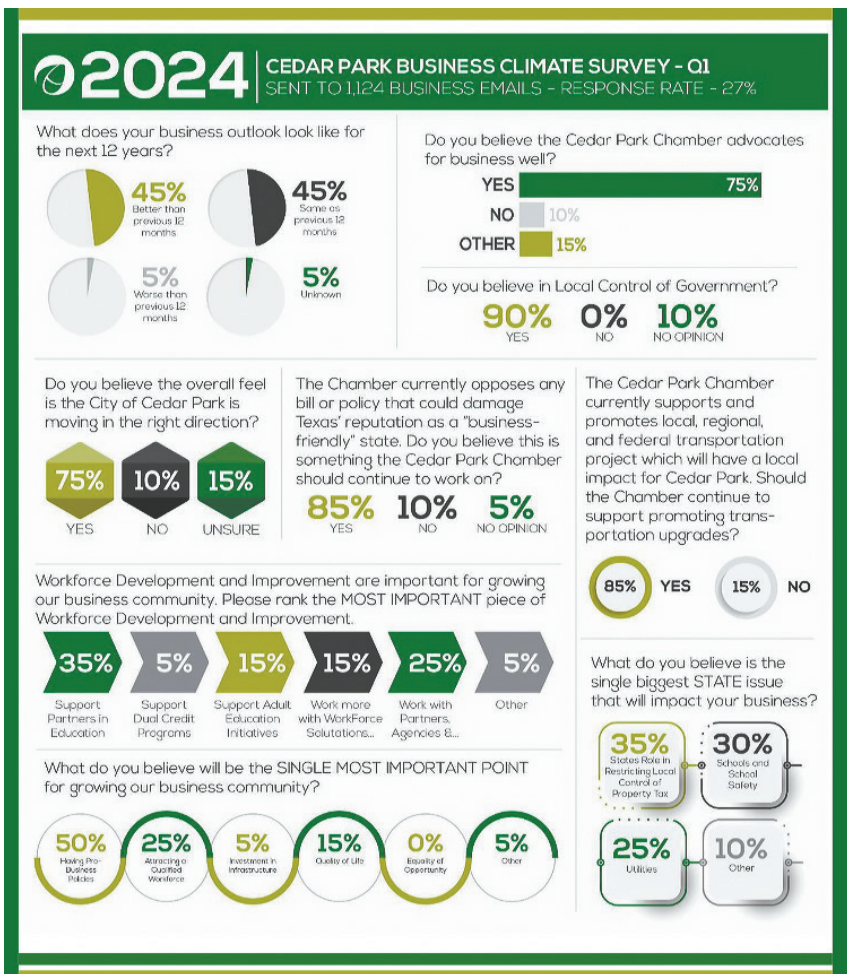
A major new law still hovering over local businesses is the so-called "Death Star bill," named after the planet-destroying space station from "Star Wars" by its critics because they believe it will destroy the entire concept of local control in Texas. Passed by the Texas Legislature last year,

the law eliminates and blocks future passage of any local ordinances by cities or counties that exceed or conflict with laws passed by the Legislature, such as ordinances that would establish a minimum wage, paid parental leave or mandatory water breaks.

The survey found 90% of respondents said they "believe in local control of government" and 35% of them listed state restriction of local control of property taxes as the statewide issue most likely to impact their business - the highest cited statewide issues in the survey.

Additionally, 30% cited school and school safety being the most impactful statewide

# Texas counties lead the U.S. in population growth, Census says

Texas' four most populous metro areas — Dallas-Fort Worth, Houston, San Antonio and Austin — were among the top 10 metro areas with the biggest population increases from 2022 to 2023.

Six out of the 10 fastest-growing counties in the U.S. from 2022 to 2023 are in Texas, according to recent estimates from the U.S. Census Bureau.

Kaufman County, just east of Dallas, led the list with a 7.6% increase that brought its population over 185,000, Census data shows. Rockwall and Liberty counties followed closely behind, each with growth bursts of 6.5% and 5.7%, respectively.

Population increases across the southern U.S. were largely due to people relocating from other parts of the country, Census officials said. On average, counties in the

# Man sentenced in St. David's parking lot pipe bomb explosion

A Jonestown man was sentenced to two and a half years in federal prison last Friday in federal court for possessing a pipe bomb that exploded back on Aug. 9, 2023, in his pickup truck while it was in the parking garage at St. David's Hospital in Austin.

Raymond Luke Garner, 39, pleaded guilty back on Oct. 2, 2023, to possessing an unregistered destructive device.

"Garner's use of unregistered and unstable explosive material jeopardized the safety of individuals who may have been near his vehicle," said Special Agent in Charge Aaron Tapp of the FBI's San Antonio Field Office. "We are grateful to our partners at the

ATF, members of our Joint Terrorism Task Force, and the Austin and Cedar Park Police Departments, for their vigilant work to keep our communities safe."

According to court documents, the pipe bomb exploded in the back of Garner's pickup a short time after he parked in the parking garage. Investigators later found the remains of the pipe bomb at the scene, including evidence that the pipe bomb

# Roussel-Methena challenging incumbent Thompson for Place 4 seat

Leander City Council Place 4 incumbent Na'Cole Thompson, a Leander small business owner, is being challenged by newcomer candidate Monica Roussel-Methena, a rental management business owner and state employee, in the upcoming May 4 municipal elections.

Early voting for these races starts on April 22.

Roussel-Methena did not respond to requests for an interview about her candidacy for this article, and she did not send any written statements. For the last month, the Hill Country News repeatedly tried to contact her via her listed campaign phone, email, social media accounts, and even her mutual contacts.

She is the only candidate running for council this year - and the only Leander candidate in more than a decade - not to participate in an interview about how she will vote on specific issues if elected.

## CANDIDATES

Thompson, owner of Leander Beauty Supply in Leander, is proud of what she and the council accomplished during her first term. In addition to securing progress on new commercial development projects like Home Depot, Southside Market and light industrial developments, she feels she accomplished many of the priorities voters sent her to work on while on the council, including:

# Court upholds law requiring minors get parental consent for contraception

A three-judge panel in New Orleans ruled that a Texas law requiring minors to obtain parental consent to obtain birth control does not conflict with the goals of the federally-funded Title X program, which has given teens birth control confidentially.

The 5th Circuit Court of Appeals upheld a Texas law requiring parental consent to obtain contraception for minors.

The decision from a three-judge panel of the federal appeals court in New Orleans largely affirms a 2022 ruling from U.S. District Judge Matthew Kacsmarky in Amarillo, that ended one of the only avenues for Texas teens to confidentially obtain birth control, through federally funded family planning clinics.

Since 1970, the federal Title X program has provided free contraception to anyone regardless of age, income or immigration status.

The 5th Circuit panel, which heard the case last year, found parental consent required for minors' medical treatment under the Texas Family Code does not conflict with federal law that allows U.S. teens to obtain contraception confidentially at federally-funded family planning clinics.

"Moreover, Title X's goal (encouraging family participation in teens' receiving family planning services) is not undermined by Texas's goal (empowering parents to consent to their teen's receiving contraceptives)," wrote Judge Stuart Kyle Duncan. "To the contrary, the two laws reinforce each other."

The decision, from Duncan and Circuit Judges Priscilla Richman and Catharina Haynes, mostly affirms the findings by Kacsmarky, who ruled that the Title X program violates parents' rights and state and federal law. Texas law requires minors to get parental permission before obtaining medical treatment but Title X clinics were previously exempt from that law.

The case was filed by Jonathan Mitchell, a former Texas solicitor general, the legal architect behind the 2021 Texas law that banned abortion after the sixth week of pregnancy.

Mitchell represented Alexander Deanda, an Amarillo father who said he raised his three minor daughters in accordance with his Christian beliefs to abstain from premarital sex. Although Deanda didn't show that his daughters obtained birth control without his consent, he still argued that the program violated his rights as a parent in Texas.

Under Title X, clinics are to "encourage family participation...to the extent

practical." Federal courts have repeatedly held that clinics cannot require parental consent.

U.S. Department of Justice attorneys had argued in 2022 and again last year in New Orleans that Deanda had no standing to bring the case forward. The three-judge panel ruled Deanda did have standing because the program prevents him from exercising his parental rights to consent to his child's medical care.

The three-judge panel did reverse part of Kacsmarky's ruling. The district judge had struck down a regulation that barred Title X-funded groups from notifying parents or obtaining consent. The 5th Circuit said it was too soon to rule on the new regulation.

Every Body Texas is the nonprofit that administers the Title X grant in Texas. Since 2022, the group has advised its 156 clinics in Texas to require parental consent for minors "out of an abundance of caution" as it awaits further guidance from the federal government.

The Texas Title X administrator filed an amicus brief in the case before the 5th Circuit. On Wednesday, the group issued a statement, pointing out the mixed ruling from the 5th Circuit was "not a clear statement on whether minors in Texas can legally access confidential contraceptive care without parental consent in Title X clinics" or whether the clinics must continue to comply with Texas state parental consent law.

For now, Every Body Texas believes its clinics should continue operating as they had after Kacsmarky's ruling, by requiring parental consent for minors seeking birth control, as the group consults with the federal government as to how to proceed.

"While we agree with the court's decision to keep in place the 2021 Title X rule that prohibits clinics from requiring parental consent, we remain concerned that the ambiguity of the ruling continues to impose barriers for young people in Texas who are trying

to access birth control," said Stephanie LeBleu, Title X Project Director.

"Minors have been unable to access confidential contraceptive care in our network of Title X clinics for more than a year," said LeBleu. "Title X encourages young people to involve a parent or guardian in their healthcare decision-making. However, not all teens have a trusted adult with whom they can have those important conversations, and they turn to their healthcare provider for confidential care."

Last Wednesday, they had little comment about the ruling issued the previous day.

"We are currently working to understand the full implications of the opinion from the 5th circuit today," Mimi Garcia, spokesperson for Every Body Texas, said in a statement. "We continue to operate under previous guidance at this time."

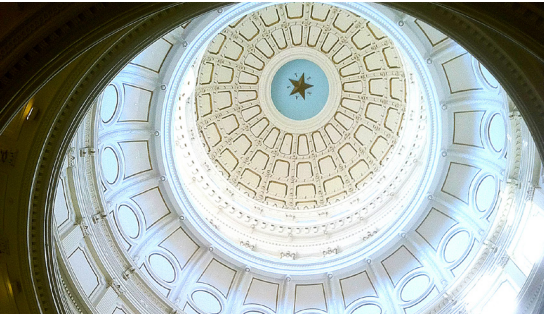
DOJ attorneys also declined to comment on the ruling or appeal plans.

The decision could have ripple effects across the country if other states adopt similar parental consent policies, said Lucie Arvallo, executive director of Jane's Due Process, an organization that helps young people access abortions and contraceptives.

"We know from over two decades of working with teens that young people will frequently include parents in their reproductive health care decisions, but for some, parental involvement and legal decisions like this one are insurmountable barriers," Arvallo said. "Teens should be able to access birth control, no matter their circumstances or where they live."

Arvallo added that abortion rights groups will likely be hesitant to appeal the ruling to the U.S. Supreme Court, which in 2022 revoked a constitutional right to abortion. She said a U.S. Supreme Court ruling that affirms the 5th Circuit's decision could decimate teen access to birth control nationwide.

**Texas counties among fastest growing in U.S.**

Recent estimates from the U.S. Census Bureau indicate that six of the 10 fastest-growing counties in the United States from 2022 to 2023 were in Texas. According to the Texas Tribune, Kaufman County, just east of Dallas, led the list with a 7.6% increase in new residents that brought its population to more than 185,000. Census data shows that Rockwall and Liberty counties closed out the top three, with growth rates of 6.5% and 5.7%, respectively.

Also in the top 10 with the largest residential growth rates are Chambers, Comal and Ellis counties. All 10 of the fastest-growing counties are in the South, Census officials said, and are due to people relocating from other parts of the country.

"Domestic migration patterns are changing, and the impact on counties is especially evident," said Lauren Bowers, chief of the Census Bureau's Population Estimates Branch.

Texas also holds eight of the 10 counties that added the most residents from 2022 to 2023, with Harris, Collin and Montgomery counties leading nationwide. Harris County added 53,788 residents, more than any other county in the U.S.

## Major wildfires nearly contained

The largest wildfire in Texas history is 89% contained as of Sunday, according to the Texas A&M Forest Service, after burning more than a million acres. The Smokehouse Creek fire in Hutchinson County is one of two active wildfires in the state. The only other wildfire not contained is the Windy Deuce Fire in Moore County, 94% contained and consuming 144,045 acres.

There are currently 70 counties with burn bans in place. The U.S. Small Business Administration has approved Gov. Greg Abbott's disaster declaration request for the following Panhandle counties: Armstrong, Carson, Donley, Gray, Hansford, Hemphill, Hutchinson, Lipscomb, Moore, Potter, Randall, Roberts, Sherman and Wheeler.

"These disaster declarations will help Texans in communities affected by the Smokehouse Creek and Windy Deuce wildfires receive critical financial assistance they need as they continue to recover and rebuild," Abbott said.

## Texas challenges federal methane rule

The state is challenging a tougher methane emissions rule recently put in place by the Environmental Protection Agency through a lawsuit filed by the Texas attorney general's office last week. The regulations force oil and gas companies to reduce emissions in the next two years.

Texas oil and gas operators emit more methane than any other state, according to the EPA. A report in the Houston Chronicle said the program would reduce negative climate impacts and improve health, saving up to \$7.6 billion annually through 2038.

The Texas Railroad Commission claims the rule is detrimental to the oil and gas industry, and maintains the industry has made great strides to reduce emissions.

"Texas is taking action against the federal government's egregious overreach," said RRC Chairman Christi Craddick. "The latest attack on oil and gas is nothing more than an attempt to shut down the industry that creates hundreds of thousands of jobs, funds one-third of our state's economy, and produces clean and reliable energy for the world."

## Court: Minors need parental consent for contraceptives

A federal appellate court upheld a state law requiring parental consent for minor seeking access to birth control, the Austin American-Statesman reported. The ruling partially upholds a late 2022 ruling that blocked federally funded clinics from providing contraceptives to teens without proof of parental consent.

Teens have the right to access confidential contraception services at Title X clinics under a program established in 1970. A lawsuit filed in 2022 challenged the Title X regulation, arguing it violates state law and infringes on parental rights.

"Minors have been unable to access confidential contraceptive care in our network of Title X clinics for more than a year," Stephanie LeBleu, a project director at Every Body, a nonprofit that administers federal funds to more than 150 Title X clinics across the state, said in a news release.

## Paxton, Cornyn still exchanging barbs

Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton is possibly considering a run against incumbent U.S. Sen. John Cornyn following a streak of successes in ousting Republican House incumbents in the March primary, The Dallas Morning News reported. Paxton has repeatedly attacked Cornyn, up for reelection in 2026, as being too moderate.

"Super Tuesday showed there is a large base of Paxton-friendly voters who not only admire him but want his kind of unapologetic aggressive conservatism in the United States Senate, said conservative radio talk show host Mark Davis.

The two have clashed several times on social media. When Cornyn announced he would run to replace Sen. Mitch McConnell, R-Kentucky, as the Republican leader in the Senate, Paxton posted on X, formerly Twitter, "Republicans deserve better in their next leader and Texans deserve another conservative senator."

Cornyn replied, "Hard to run from prison, Ken." Paxton faces a trial this spring for securities fraud and is under federal investigation for his ties to a since-indicted real estate investor.

## Third anniversary of Operation Lone Star

Operation Lone Star, the state's border initiative, recently marked its third anniversary. According to Abbott's office, the multi-agency effort has led to apprehension of more than a half-million people believed to be here illegally. More than 36,100 felony charges have been filed and more than 100,000 migrants have been transported to other cities, the governor's office said. In addition, more than 469 million doses of fentanyl have been seized during that three-year period.

had contained a homemade high explosive, circuit boards/timers and electric matches.

While detained by police, Garner contacted another individual to ask that person to move a box out of Garner's home, according to court records, and law enforcement later recovered the box, finding it contained high explosives, precursor chemicals and electric matches. Police searches at other locations revealed a recipe for the

high explosive, remote control devices and other components for destructive devices.

The Cedar Park Police Department, along with the FBI and Austin Police Department (APD) Bomb Squad, also investigated the Cypress Garden apartment complex located at 335 Cypress Creek Road on Aug. 10, 2023. They temporarily evacuated nearby residents out of caution after finding "an object at the scene."

Public records show Garner previously had the apartment complex as an address, and police interviewed the unnamed individual on Aug. 10. But it has still not been confirmed whether the investigated apartment had any direct connection to either man listed in the court records.

However, the Austin Police Department did previously confirm the apartment and explosion investigations are related to each other.

# More for them, less for us

Tesla, Ford, Netflix, and T-Mobile are among scores of profitable U.S. firms that pay their top executives more than they pay in federal taxes.

In his State of the Union address, President Biden called out "massive executive pay" and vowed to "make big corporations and the very wealthy finally pay their share" of taxes.

Corporate tax dodging and CEO pay have gotten so out of control that many major U.S. companies are paying their top executives more than they're paying Uncle Sam.

Tesla is perhaps the most dramatic example. Over the period 2018-2022, the electric car maker raked in \$4.4 billion in profits but paid no federal income taxes. Meanwhile, Tesla CEO Elon Musk became one of the world's richest men.

When it comes to fleecing taxpayers while overpaying executives, Tesla is hardly alone. A new report we co-authored for the Institute for Policy Studies and Americans for Tax Fairness analyzes executive pay data for some of the country's most notorious corporate tax dodgers.

What did we find? In addition to Tesla, 34 other large and profitable U.S. firms — including household names like Ford, Netflix, and T-Mobile — paid less in federal income taxes between 2018 and 2022 than they paid their

top five executives.

Another 29 profitable corporations paid their top executives more than they paid Uncle Sam in at least two of the five years of the study period.

One company on our list stands out for the infamous role its executives played in the 2008 financial crisis: American International Group. Back then, the insurance giant ignited a firestorm by pocketing a \$180 billion taxpayer bailout and then announcing plans to hand out \$165 million in bonuses to the very same executives responsible for pushing the company — and the nation — to the brink of collapse.

Today, AIG is playing the same greedy game of overpaying its top brass and sticking taxpayers with the bill. Between 2018 and 2022, the company paid its top five executives more than it paid in federal income taxes, despite collecting \$17.7 billion in U.S. profits. In 2022, CEO Peter Zaffino alone made \$75 million.

Lavish executive compensation packages and skimpy corporate tax payments are not unrelated. Executives have a huge personal incentive to hire armies of lobbyists to push for corporate tax cuts because the windfalls from these cuts often wind up in their own pockets.

The 2017 Republican tax law slashed the corporate tax rate from 35 percent to 21 percent and failed to close loopholes that whittle down IRS bills even further. Many large, profitable corporations ended up paying no federal taxes at all.

Corporations took the savings from those tax cuts and spent a record-breaking \$1 trillion on stock buybacks, a financial maneuver that artificially inflates the value of executives' stock-based pay.

Wealthy executives became even wealthier while the nation lost billions of dollars in corporate revenue that could have been used to lower costs and improve services for ordinary people. Until this self-reinforcing cycle is broken, we'll have a corporate tax and compensation system that works for top executives — and no one else.

What can we do to break this cycle?

Congress can tackle the entwined problems of inadequate corporate tax payments and excess executive pay on several fronts. Raising the corporate tax rate to 28 percent (just halfway back to Obama-era levels) would generate \$1.3 trillion in new revenue over the next decade.

Congress must also close loopholes and eliminate wasteful tax breaks, for instance by removing the incentives for American firms to shift profits and production offshore.

Policymakers also have a wealth of tools to curb excessive executive pay, from tax and contracting reforms to stronger regulations to rein in stock buybacks and banker bonuses.

We know we need change when corporations are rewarding a handful of top executives more than they are contributing to the cost of public services needed for our economy to thrive.

# Texas off base to go after Catholic halfway house

When Pennsylvania Gov. Josh Shapiro engaged in a legal battle with the Little Sisters of the Poor over their refusal to subsidize birth control for their employees, I got very angry.

As a Catholic who takes her faith very seriously and an asylum lawyer who knows a little something about religious persecution, it seemed to me that the then-attorney general was violating the rights of some women who just wanted to be left alone to serve God's glory.

Of course, there are those who will disagree and believe that Shapiro was fighting to preserve the civil rights of those female employees who, for whatever reason, refused to buy their own birth control, but it's clear that going after nuns is not a good look.

I thought I'd seen the last of that kind of chicanery from a state official, but last week brought another example of what I truly believe is anti-Catholic bigotry.

The irony is that this time it's a Republican attorney general from Texas acting under orders from a Republican governor from Texas.

Bigotry and illegality are, apparently, bipartisan.

We all know that Greg Abbott is waging his own war against the tide of illegal immigration that is making life unlivable at the southern border. He's tried to use constitutional arguments to support his claim that he can interfere with the federal jurisdiction over immigration.

As a lawyer, I have to give him credit for his ingenuity. Also, as a lawyer, I have to say he's completely off base on that one.

And now there's something else he's wrong about. On Feb. 20, Attorney General Ken Paxton, the one they couldn't impeach, has decided to go after Annunciation House, a private organization that acts as a halfway

house and temporary shelter for people who have crossed the border.

It was founded in 1978 by a few young Catholics in the El Paso Diocese who, ironically enough, wanted to help what was then called INS to deal with the human crisis at the border.

Back then it wasn't as serious as it is today and involved mostly single Mexican men instead of entire families from Central and South America, but there was a need to provide some humanitarian aid to the surge of human cargo.

But Paxton has decided to redefine these unpaid workers as human smugglers.

According to Paxton, "Annunciation House knows that at least some of the aliens it provides services to are present illegally and are trying to avoid Border Patrol ... Annunciation House's transportation of those aliens presents a very significant likelihood of human smuggling."

It's a bit disingenuous for Paxton to accuse this shelter of human smuggling. While the Texas law that prohibits human smuggling does include acts involving the transportation of undocumented aliens across the border and within the state itself, he would then have to charge his own governor with human smuggling in order to be consistent with the word of the law.

Remember when Abbott was buying bus tickets to send aliens to Northeastern cities like New York, Boston and Philadelphia? Under the letter of the law, that is also human smuggling.

What Annunciation House is doing is not illegal. It's Catholic and Christian. It provides temporary shelter, food, clothing and medical care to people who are in need of it.

I am actually more offended by this attack on Annunciation House after having visited a similar facility outside of McAllen, Texas, last year. I spent an afternoon reading books to little girls from Venezuela, Brazil and Colombia, braiding their hair, and drawing pictures with them.

In a couple of days, they and their parents would be on a bus to meet with their sponsors in the United States, usually family.

I also attended a Mass in a large gymnasium and helped a frantic father search for his missing toddler, who it turns out was hanging out with a nun.

Come to think of it, I suppose I was involved in human smuggling too. I'm more than ready for my mug shot.

I think it is a dangerous and counterproductive thing to go after religious organizations that are operating within the law and are fulfilling their spiritual mission.

Paxton can try and paint Annunciation House and places like it as centers of human trafficking, gang members, drug smugglers and all other sorts of undesirables, but the truth is that they are simply a small, humane attempt to deal with one aspect of a larger, complicated crisis.

I am in full support of laws that will stop this overflow of humanity at the border, but attacking people of faith is a despicable and ineffective way of doing that.

So, until I see Abbott's mug shot on Fox News, I will condemn the ridiculous assault on my church and its mission.

# Austin seeking federal boost to support airport-area trail

Austin may receive up to \$25 million to transform a stretch of abandoned urban railway into a 6.5-mile trail system. The Bergstrom Spur Trail Network would connect parks, neighborhoods and establish pedestrian and bike connectivity in a recreationally underserved area of South Austin. The city applied for funds from the U.S. Department of Transportation's Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) grant program.

The trail is planned in a high-density, low-income and park-deficient area, according to city officials. Currently in the design phase, federal funding would allow construction to "begin promptly" if federal support is received.

In addition to potentially extending to Austin-Bergstrom International Airport, the trail would provide safe east-west pedestrian and bike connectivity where none currently exists. It would also add key transit connections, including the South Congress Transit Center, 11 existing Capital Metro Local bus routes, a future Capital Metro Rapid bus route and the upcoming Project Connect Light Rail line on Riverside Drive.

Individual awards can tap the program up to \$25 million, Austin will contribute \$6.25 million in city funds drawn from the Urban Trails fund sourced by a \$460 million 2020 Mobility Bond approved by voters. Completion of the project "will provide more ways for people in a historically underserved area to safely access transit, schools, employment centers, and other key destinations," according to the city.

Backed by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), the RAISE discretionary grant program will provide \$1.5 billion annually - split exactly between urban and rural areas- for Fiscal Years 2024-26. Designed to support the completion of critical freight and passenger transportation infrastructure, RAISE supported 162 projects nationwide, in addition to Puerto Rico and the Northern Mariana Islands. Awardees for the latest round of funding will be announced no later than June 27.

National projects that have received RAISE grants include New Orleans' downtown transit center, reconstructing South Dakota's Route 6 on the Standing Rock Indian Reservation and redeveloping a 2.5-mile stretch of road to reconnect historic neighborhoods in Birmingham, Alabama.

issue, followed by 25% citing utilities as the biggest issue and 10% citing all other issues under the "Other" category.

Lastly, the survey noted the importance of workforce development and improvement for growing the local business community. When indicating the workforce development priority most important to them, the respondents' answers included:

- 35% who cited supporting partnerships in education,
- 25% who cited working with partners, agencies and others to support a competitive workforce,
- 15% who cited supporting education initiatives,
- 15% who cited working more with Workforce Solutions, SCORE and other organizations,
- 5% who cited supporting dual credit programs; and
- 5% who cited items under the "Other" category.

South experienced faster growth in 2023 than in 2022.

"Domestic migration patterns are changing, and the impact on counties is especially evident," said Lauren Bowers, chief of the Census Bureau's Population Estimates Branch, in a Thursday statement.

### BIG COUNTIES SEE MAJOR POPULATION INCREASES

Texas also holds eight out of the ten counties across the country that added the most residents from 2022 to 2023. Harris, Collin and Montgomery counties led the pack.

Harris County added 53,788 residents, more than any other county in the U.S. With nearly 5 million total residents, it's now the third most populous county in the country. Harris also saw the second-highest gains from international migration of all counties nationwide.

Collin, Denton and Tarrant counties in the Dallas-Fort Worth area also had significant gains, bringing in tens of thousands of new people. Denton is now the seventh county in Texas to surpass 1 million residents.

Notably, Dallas County didn't make the Census' top ten list.

Growth in the state's major counties boosted Texas' overall population. The state grew more than any other in the country in 2023, by nearly half a million people, according to earlier Census estimates.

### TEXAS' CITIES ARE BOOMING

Texas' four most populous metro areas — Dallas-Fort Worth, Houston, San Antonio and Austin — were among the top 10 metro areas with the biggest population increases from 2022 to 2023.

The greater Dallas area saw the highest jump. It added 152,598 residents, bringing its total population over 8 million. The greater Houston area followed closely behind, adding 139,789 over the same period. Its total population is now over 7.5 million residents.

Nearly 70% of Texas residents live in the state's four largest metro areas, according to estimates from the Texas Demographic Center.

But the Midland metro area grew more rapidly than any of them. From 2022 to 2023, Midland's population increased by nearly 3% — making it the seventh fastest-growing metro area in the country.

Midland is part of the Permian Basin, the highest-producing oil field in the U.S., and is home to much of Texas' oil and gas production.

Tracee Bentley, CEO of Permian Strategic Partnership — a collaboration between Permian Basin communities and oil and gas companies — said job growth in the energy sector could be driving population increases in Midland.

"The nature of the jobs that you're seeing in the oil and gas space are attracting some of the younger professionals who want to come here," Bentley said.

Overall, more U.S. counties saw population gains than losses in 2023, but the South saw faster growth than much of the rest of the country, according to Census data.

- making progress on Leander's water infrastructure by funding and completing eight water-related projects plus funding and starting critical expansion projects for Leander's two water sources - the Brushy Creek Regional Utility Authority (BCRUA) water plant and the Sandy Creek Water Treatment Plant,

- starting the work to finally begin construction this summer on the long-stalled Leander Senior Center,
- securing an Inter-local Agreement with the Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority (CapMetro) system that returns millions of dollars annually to Leander for infrastructure projects,
- completing traffic signal projects at some of the city's busiest intersections; and
- leading the charge in creating new community events - the City of Leander now annually celebrates MLK Day and Juneteenth, a community safety forum after the Uvalde school shooting and an annual Citizens University where citizens learn about city functions.

"When it comes to reelecting our city council, you should think about the work that has already been done (since 2021) and the things that have been put in place," Thompson said. "We have work we need to do. We need to keep it going in the right direction and not get turned around or stalled as things were previously (on the council)."

Thompson also serves as Leander's representative on the boards for the BCRUA and the Capital Area Council of Governments (CAPCOG). She also serves on the boards for the Leander Educational Excellence Foundation, the Leander Black Business Alliance and the nonprofit Kids Helping Kids of Texas.

She is running on finishing the work on Leander's long-term water planning projects, creating a centralized city resource to connect residents with locally available resources, increasing support for small business programming and funding and continuing to support Leander's public safety departments so it can expand enough to meet Leander's future buildout size of over 230,000 people.

With connecting residents to resources, Thompson wants a single, centralized city resource that residents can use to help them find resources they may not realize are already available in Leander or through the county, such as mental health services or other general purpose services that help them maintain their quality of life. She points to how the Leander Police Department has already had success with a similar approach of providing mental health and grief resources during their interactions with residents.

With public safety, she argues the city needs to eventually hire more staff and build new facilities to house them while maintaining these department's strong tradition of community engagement.

She feels that requires not only hiring enough public safety employees to keep the current staff from being overburdened but also offering competitive wages that allow them to attract and retain new, talented public safety employees, especially since the city expects a large number of retirements in the coming years. She believes that the council's recent passage of a STEP Plan pay increase will make a big difference in this area.

"We don't want to lose any depth of talent in our public safety departments (with these retirements). We want to be able to attract quality folks with sound experience," Thompson said.

With helping small businesses, she wants the city and the council to be looking for opportunities to support and collaborate with local small businesses. She cited the council's passage of the long-sought overhaul of the city's Sign Ordinance. She listed how even items like allowing swooper flags - tall, large flag signs - can be a major help for small businesses in locations not on a street by helping them make people aware they exist.

She feels small business owners should be the ones bringing forward any additional changes to the sign ordinance or other improvements to city regulations.

"Small businesses are the backbone of our city and the backbone of the U.S., so anything we can do to help small businesses grow is a huge benefit to our city," Thompson said.

Roussel-Methena, the owner and general manager for rental management company Mojama and a program specialist with the Texas Health and Human Services department, wrote on her campaign website about how she moved away from her childhood home in a suburb of Paris, France and later California due to the cost and regulatory burden she faced there, eventually settling in Texas.

"My goal is to give this city a solid foundation it can trust for the next 25 years. I want our children to want to stay here, raise their own families here. I don't want Leander to just be on the way to Austin, I want it to be our hometown," Roussel-Methena wrote on her website.

She also previously served on the Leander Charter Review Board, Leander Public Arts Commission and Leander Board of Adjustments.

Her campaign website and Facebook page list "work on solutions to promote healthy business growth," "work on infrastructure solutions like water, roads and safety" and "protect homeowners from rising taxes" as her platforms.

She did not submit for an interview for this article to explain what her specific campaign goals and priorities would be to reach these goals. Her campaign website and Facebook page also do not answer these questions.

### WATER

Leander is currently imposing Stage 4 water restrictions, which prohibits all nonessential outdoor water usage, as a precaution to avoid water outages while the BCRUA takes its aging, deteriorating raw water intake pipeline offline so they can install a replacement pipeline. The BCRUA plant provides 60% of Leander's water.

The original pipeline had three unplanned breaks since 2020, the cause of Leander's recent, frequent water restrictions. The replacement project has been planned for more than a year and aims to finally fix the issue.

Longer term, the BCRUA is building a massive "Deep Water Intake" pipeline starting in April 2027, which will address Leander's water needs by increasing how much water the plant can pump from its future total capacity of 42 million gallons per day for all three members to 145 million gallons per day. It will also make the plant drought resilient by pulling from a deeper part of Lake Travis.

"Everyone is using Lake Travis and we've seen over the last several years how much the lake's levels have dropped each summer," Thompson said. "Looking for new water (sources and technologies) should be at the forefront of mind for every city in this area. Water is not an infinite resource, when we run out, we run out. As a city, we need to be proactively looking for ways to ensure that our long-term water needs are met."

While she acknowledges that Leander won't run out of water in the immediate

future - especially with the planned BCRUA and Sandy Creek water plant expansions, she believes the key to long-term water security of Leander is creating regional partnerships with area cities.

"These plants are extremely expensive to build for a city our size...and take a great amount of time and expertise to execute. Partnership is key to maximizing the benefits while minimizing risks and costs," Thompson said. "As a council, I think we've done the heavy lifting in 2021 and 2022 by making sure these projects got on the books and budgets got approved of them. Now, it's about staying on top of them... and ensuring the work continues on time... When all of those projects are complete in 2027, we're be sitting pretty nice in terms of (increased) water capacity."

Because Roussel-Methena did not participate in an interview and her website doesn't list any specific information on the issue, it is unknown what her position is on the issue.

### CAPMETRO

CapMetro provides busing, pickup service and a single rail service from the Leander Station to downtown Austin. Recently, a new rail station near the Q2 Stadium was added, plus double tracking near Leander to speed up the train.

However, CapMetro rail ridership is low due to the rail route being slow and having few notable stops before downtown Austin. Originally envisioned as a comprehensive network, CapMetro missed out on federal funding after a key Austin vote failed by a narrow margin in 2000. Consequently, expanding the system was slow until there was a revenue boost due to the recent population boom.

Under state law, Leander pays half of its sales tax revenues to CapMetro in exchange for membership. As the city has grown, the amount has also grown to approximately \$10 million annually. Without the Texas Legislature passing a new law, CapMetro cannot change the terms of membership.

Approximately 60% or more of Leander voters cast a ballot in favor of joining CapMetro in 1985 and twice again to remain in the system in 2000 and in 2022. During the most recent vote, Leander entered an Interlocal Agreement with CapMetro that returns approximately \$2 million and growing annually to the city - the amount Leander pays in excess of its share of CapMetro's maintenance costs.

Thompson said that if voters make it clear in 2027 that they want Leander's membership in CapMetro put up for a vote again, she believes the council will make the right choice on behalf of residents.

However, she reiterated that Leander voters overwhelmingly voted three times to stay in CapMetro, including in 2022 - when the largest number of voters yet approved it.

Leander cannot legally put its membership in CapMetro up for a vote until 2027.

She feels the "real change will happen when there are legislative updates (to the Texas Legislature) to transportation rules around what member cities pay in exchange for membership with organizations like Capital Metro."

She also feels Leander citizens need to be the ones advocating for changes at the Texas Legislature so any change that might occur will be the change they actually want to see.

Because Roussel-Methena did not participate in an interview and her website doesn't list any specific information on the issue, it is unknown what her position is on the issue.

The municipal elections will be held on May 4, with Early Voting starting on April 22.

# San Antonio sells out Moody Center again

The Austin metro area continues to show love for the San Antonio Spurs, selling out the Moody Center for both NBA regular season games last weekend.

Friday's game saw the defending NBA champion Denver Nuggets down San Antonio on the strength of a 31-point outing by Nikola Jokic. Last year's NBA Finals MVP added seven rebounds, five assists and three steals to help the Nuggets to a 117-106 win in the opener of the Spurs' 1-35 series.

Spurs rookie sensation Victor Wembanyama finished just short of a double-double on Friday, scoring 19 points and recording nine rebounds plus a pair of assists, two steals and three blocks.

Jokic had good things to say about San Antonio's game-changing star.

"He's learning with time," Jokic said. "He's going to have a bad period, a good period. He's really young, so he's going to learn. Like I said last time, we just need to enjoy his process and he's going to change the game for sure."

On Sunday, San Antonio Wembanyama went off for 33 points and 15 rebounds in a 122-115 overtime win against the Brooklyn Nets. The big man also notched seven blocks and seven assists in just over 36 minutes of play.

Wembanyama said he really enjoys close games like Sunday's, where every second counts.

"I love it. It's those moments where we progress, where we get better, rather than any other moment in the game," Wembanyama said. "So, it's really, really enjoyable. Especially when we win."

Devin Vassell had 25 points and Keldon Johnson had 24 for the

Spurs, while guard Cam Thomas led the Nets with 31 points.

Thomas gave the Spurs inside play credit for the edge at the end of the game.

"We just kept letting them get to the paint. When they get into the paint, it's tough... they would just find the center and would just dunk everything. So, it was tough. We tried to keep them out of the lane as much as we could, but we just couldn't," Thomas said.

Spurs coach Gregg Popovich said controlling the pace down the stretch was key.

"It's a double-edged sword," Popovich said. "It depends on the situation. Sometimes you get a rebound in those situations, and you look and if you've got an easy break - we threw one full court one time to, was that [Victor Wembanyama]?"

Five goals, four scored by defenders. Two leads lost to late goals by opposing teams. Three draws and a loss.

It's fair to say that Austin FC hasn't gotten off to the best start this season.

After a number of off-season roster changes, the squad taking the pitch this season has looked a little different, but results haven't.

In last Saturday's match against the winless Philadelphia Union, the Verde & Black

saw a promising 2-1 advantage get erased by a Union equalizer in the 65th minute as Austin salvaged just a point in a 2-2 draw.

The home side surrendered a penalty kick early in the game after Jon Gallagher was called for a handball in the box but Brad Stuver kept the deficit at one with a crucial save in the 22nd minute — one of the two saves he made in the first half.

Austin rebounded and scored twice inside two minutes in the early going of the second half, with newcomer

Rubio, a veteran forward who plays for the Chilean national team, joined Austin ahead of this season on a one-year guaranteed deal after spending three seasons with Sporting Kansas City and five with the Colorado Rapids. His 55 goals and 35 assists heading into this season rank

Sebastian Driussi substituted on for Jader Obrian to make his season debut with 19 minutes remaining after spending the first three matches on the bench recovering from an injury. The MVP candidate from the 2022 season made a noticeable change in Austin's aggressiveness, but shot attempts by Driussi, Owen Wolff, Emi Rigano, Daniel Pereira and

Matt Hedges, all in the closing minutes, were unable to net Austin a game winner.

Brad Stuver remained the brightest spot for Austin, facing 18 total shot attempts and seven shots on goal and making five crucial saves on Saturday. He's now recorded 22 saves in four games against 28 shots on goal.
