# COVID-19 up by 63 cases

The number of COVID-19 cases reported in Kemper County by the Mississippi Department of Health jumped by 63 in the past week.

Kemper County has 1,107 infections reports since March 2020. That has gone up from 1,044 in the past week. There has also been one additional death related to COVID-19 in the past week,

moving the total of 30 people in Kemper County being taken by the dread disease.

Statewide, there have been 368,549 cases reported since last March 2020. That is an increase of 18,479 in the past week. The number of deaths stands at 7,685, an increase 85 deaths.

Mississippi is experiencing high levels of COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations due to the delta variant. The delta variant is much more contagious, and spreads twice as easily compared

to other strains. Outbreaks have been identified in youth camps, faith-based gatherings, funerals and social events.

According to the health department, if you are fully vaccinated, you can participate in many of the activities that you did before the pandemic. To maximize protection from the Delta variant and prevent possibly spreading it to others, wear a mask indoors in public if you are in an area of substantial or high transmission.

Wearing a mask is most impor-

tant if you have a weakened immune system or if, because of your age or an underlying medical condition, you are at increased risk for severe disease, or if someone in your household has a weakened immune system, is at increased risk for severe disease, or is unvaccinated. If this applies to you or your household, you might choose to wear a mask regardless of the level of transmission in your area.

You should continue to wear a mask and practice social distancing, especially if you are in an area of high transmission.

## Voters pass \$12M bond to build new school

Voters living in the Kemper County School District approved a 20-year, \$12 million bond last Thursday.

The ballot proposal was to replace two elementary schools; initially with one new elementary school building for 3rd through 6th graders.

According to unofficial election results from the Kemper County Clerk's Office, 1,244 voters, or 68%, approved of the bond while 380 people, or 32%, voted against it.

The bond will fund the replacement of Kemper County Lower Elementary and Kemper County Upper Elementary schools, which were both over 50-years old.

"We are excited that Kemper County voters chose to show their support to improve the learning environment for our children," said Hilute Hudson, superintendent of education for Kemper County School District.

"Our elementary students and teachers deserve to have a facility built for them to support the learning and educational needs in a safe and constructive environment. On behalf of the Kemper County School Board, administration, staff, families, and students, we offer our heartfelt thanks to the voters," said Hudson.

The district is moving into the next phase of the project, which is to finalize the construction plans and timeline, officials said. The new elementary school will consist of 16 state-of-the-art classrooms, specialty classrooms, multipurpose room, multimedia center, cafeteria, and support spaces.

## Artwork by EMCC's Buob selected for exhibits

Works by East Mississippi Community College art instructor Cynthia Buob have been selected for inclusion in a curated art exhibit and two juried art exhibits.

A painting by Buob was chosen for the Mississippi Invitational, a biennial exhibition of works from visual artists from across the state at the Mississippi Museum of Art in Jackson that runs from Aug. 14 to Nov. 7.

The works of 42 artists were selected for the curated exhibit, in which a guest is invited to help select the artists whose work will be on display. This year's works were selected by guest curator Danielle Burns-Wilson of Houston.

"The curator is not just picking pieces they initially like," Buob said. "They are asking you why you did a piece of art a certain way and they want to know what the artwork is about. The curator is also trying to come up with a theme for the show, so they are dealing with that as well."

The 2021 Mississippi Invitational explores the themes of resilience, reckoning and reflection. Burns-Wilson chose an oil painting by Buob titled "Woman with a Tattoo" for inclusion in the exhibit.

A drawing of a former EMCC faculty member and an oil self-portrait of Buob's were also selected for inclusion in the 2021 Irene Rosenzweig Juried Exhibition in the Arts & Science Center for Southeast

with Chris Gully, who has been my friend for 40 years. It is good to be out here with good friends and the kids are awesome."

Dawkins believes his new team has talent and will be competitive in their division. But, he added, this is a young team.

Getting the Message/Rev. Chris Shelton

## Acts 11:19-30

Antioch is a city that should be etched in the minds and hearts of Christians. It was a major city in northern Syria. Here the first majority Gentile church was planted, and Antioch became the springboard for missions throughout the Roman Empire. And it was here believers were first called Christians (Acts 11:26). Luke tells us how the church there got started.

Christians who fled persecution in Jerusalem settled in Antioch. They didn't just hide away; they began to tell people about Christ. At first it was only to the Jews in Antioch, but then some Christians with roots from Cyprus and Cyrene began speaking to Greeks. They preached the Lord Jesus (verse 20).

To preach the Lord Jesus meant they spoke of his person and works. That he was the Son of God, did mighty works because God was with him, was crucified by men according to the purpose of God to be an atoning sacrifice for sin, was raised from the dead, and will be the judge of all men. He calls on men without distinction to believe and turn to him for the remission of their sins.

We see that a great number of people believed and turned to the Lord (verse 21). The church in Jerusalem heard the news and sent Barnabas (a blessed choice) to minister to the young and growing church. When he arrived, he rejoiced at the grace of God and began to exhort them to remain faithful (verse 21). The church continued to grow, so Barnabas traveled to Tarsus to solicit the help of Saul (Paul), and together they taught the saints at Antioch for the next year (verse 26).

We learn here how great grace is to "believe and turn to the Lord." It means leaving death for life, darkness for light, guilt for forgiveness. And it means an eternal inheritance in the kingdom of God. By faith you become a child of God forever. These Greeks turned away from idolatry, immorality, Caesar, and other things they had known all their days to the Lord Jesus. That took faith.

You should make sure you have believed and turned to the Lord. It is pride to refuse a command of the Lord to come to him and live. Faith is obedience, listening to and heed-

ing the word of the Lord. If you have heard the gospel, you have been summoned by him. Christ came from heaven to heal sinners. He is equal to the need you have. Be like the people in Antioch and lay hold of Christ.

We also see that Barnabas exhorted the Christians to stay faithful with steadfast purpose. He knew they were being tested and would be tested further. Satan loathes seeing people turn to Christ, and the world under his power is against the truth of God.

Coming to Christ does not mean an easy journey through this world. Rather, the Lord tells his people that it is through many tribulations we enter the kingdom of God, and that if the world hated him, do not be surprised that it hates you. The saints in Antioch would have to count the cost of following Christ as we all do.

Having steadfast purpose is connected to being pure in heart. In other words, to put away a divided heart, place your hand on the plow and not look away. Keep your eyes on the Lord, seek to do his will and remember your name is written in heaven.

Samuel Rutherford wrote, "How soon a few years will pass and this life's lease be expired. O happy soul forever! Who can rightly compare this life with its vanity and the lasting life to come with its weight of glory? Do not let the Lord's dealings seem harsh, rough, or unfatherly because they are unpleasant. When his blessed will blows across your desires, it is best to strike sail in humility, and deny yourself so you have no will of your own. Give yourself as a gift to God to make use of for his will. Every day make more and more of Christ, and test your growth in the grace of God."

Luke tells us in verses 27 that Agabus the prophet foretold of a famine that would be hard on the people in Judea. So the saints in Antioch decided to take up an offering to send relief to the Christians there. Generosity is fruit of the Christian faith.

The motive that Paul gives to the church in Corinth to give generously is sufficient: "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich."

# Purple Gallinule better known as 'Swamp Hen'

The American purple gallinule belongs to the rail family of birds and is often referred to as the "swamp hen."

It is normally found among marshes and, when flying, they communicate using a hen-like cackling sound. It grows to between 11 and 13 inches with a wingspan near 21 inches and weighs up to 10 ounces.

The purple gallinule breeds and resides throughout the

South. It prefers to live in freshwater marshes that have lily pads and pickerelweed as vegetation and though rarely seen north of the Mississippi-Tennessee border, some stragglers have been sighted as far north as Massachusetts.

A beautifully colored bird, the purple gallinule can be seen walking on top of floating vegetation or clambering through dense shrubs. A fairly large, duck-like bird, it's extremely long toes enable this bird to walk across lily pads with ease.

Adult purple gallinules

have many beautiful colors about its body. Its head, neck, breast and underside are a dark purple. The back and upper wings are green and its legs and feet are yellow. With a light blue forehead, the purple gallinule has a triangular, red bill tipped with yellow.

The purple gallinule is omnivorous and eats a wide variety of foods. They can be found feasting on seeds, grains, flowers and some fruits but they also enjoy small invertebrates such as grasshoppers, spiders and dragonflies.

Purple gallinules make their

nests among freshwater marshes with dense stands of floating vegetation. The nests are constructed from leaves and tree stems, and are built in a thicket, sawgrass or on a tussock that floats on the water.

The female purple gallinule lays 6 to 10 eggs at a time. Both parents participate in the incubation of the eggs and feeding chicks. Incubation lasts approximately 18 days. Purple gallinules perform a "changing of the guard" ceremony while they are nesting. One partner will bring the incubating partner a leaf. The

bird on the nest takes the leaf and adds it to the nest before turning over the incubating duties to the other parent.

The eggs of the purple gallinule are creamy white with small, irregular brown spots. Both parents feed the chicks for the first week and the chicks are able to feed themselves the second week. At 3 weeks of age, they are completely independent for food. As it grows, the juvenile purple gallinule is actually tan instead of purple with a greenish back, dull bill, dull blue frontal shield and yellow legs.

The juveniles do not reach their full adult coloration until around 2 years of age.

Turtles and alligators prey upon these birds. The purple gallinule population's most urgent threat seems to be wetland loss.

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED AD VALOREM TAX EFFORT Kemper County School District

The Kemper County School District will hold a public hearing on its proposed school district budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 on Thursday, August 12, 2021 at 5:00 pm at the Office of Superintendent, 159 Main Avenue, DeKalb, MS 39328. At this meeting, a proposed ad valorem tax effort will be considered.

The Kemper County School District is now operating with a projected total budget revenue of \$15,628,888. Of that amount, forty-three percent (43%) or \$6,752,482 of such revenue is obtained through ad valorem taxes. For next fiscal year, the proposed budget has total projected revenue of \$17,786,507. Of that amount, forty percent (40%) or \$7,035,195 is proposed to be financed through a total ad valorem tax levy.

For the next fiscal year, the proposed increase in ad valorem tax effort by Kemper County School District may result in an increase in the ad valorem tax millage rate. Ad valorem taxes are paid on homes, automobile tags, business fixtures and equipment, and rental real property.

Any citizen of Kemper County School District is invited to attend this public hearing on the proposed ad valorem tax effort, and will be allowed to speak for a reasonable amount of time and offer tangible evidence before any vote is taken.
