## **COUNTY WINS TELLY AWARD FOR CENSUS OUTREACH VIDEO**

Doña Ana County was honored with a 2021 Silver Telly Award for an animated video encouraging participation in the 2020 Census. # **Cervantes: Redistricting bill** 'erases' partisan boundaries


New Mexico will have three newly drawn U.S. congressional districts thanks to a bill signed into law Dec. 17 by Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham.

The bill, sponsored by state Sen. Joseph Cervantes of Las Cruces and two colleagues from Albuquerque, potentially erases a Republican stronghold in the 2nd **Congressional District** that includes Las Cruces and all of southern New Mexico.

"For 20 years I've worked to erase the chosen boundaries, which historically assigned southern New Mexico to the Republicans in exchange for the north assigned to Democrats. This plan rejects that past thinking, mixes urban and rural areas and will bring us together as a state," Cervantes said in a text to the Bulletin.

Cervantes was the bill's chief sponsor and is chair of the state Senate Judiciary Committee. He served 12 years in the New Mexico House of Representatives, 2001-12 and was elected to the state Senate in 2013. This year's redistricting special session is his third as a legislator.

The new map balances the populations of the three districts to within single digits; each is just above or just below 705,840 residents. The new District 2 is 56.6 percent Hispanic, 33.3 percent white, 4.9 percent Native American. 1.9 percent Black and

1.2 percent Asian; District 1 is 37.3 percent Hispanic, 49.6 percent white, 3.9 percent Native American. 2.4 percent Black and 2.9 percent Asian; District 3 is 40 percent Hispanic, 38.3 percent white, 16.5 percent Native American. 1.3 percent Black and 1.2 percent Asian.

The New Mexico Legislature's website (nmlegis. gov) says the new District 2 has a 53-47 percent preference for Democrats over Republicans, while the figure is 54-46 Democrats over Republicans in District 1 and 55.4-44.6 percent in favor of Democrats in District 3.

The website fivethirtyeight.com (538) agrees the new map gives Democrats a statistical edge in all three districts, but says Republican chances of winning districts 1 and 3 are improved.

"The finalized map makes it easier for Democrats to capture the 2nd District," the website said, with the district moving from a partisan lean of R+14 to D+4. "The tradeoff, however, is that the 3rd District becomes more competitive," 538 said, going from a partisan lean of D+14 to D+5. District 1 moves from D+18 to D+11, according to 538, which says it uses "data and evidence to advance public knowledge."

District 1 is represented by Melanie Stansbury, a Democrat from Albuquerque who won the seat in a June special election

to succeed Deb Haaland. who was appointed secretary of the U.S. Department of the Interior in the Biden administration. District 2 is represented by Yvette Herrell, a Republican from Alamogordo, who won the seat in 2020. District 3 is held by Teresa Leger Fernandez of Santa Fe, who won the seat in 2020 after former U.S. Rep. Ben Ray Lujan gave it up to run successfully for the U.S. Senate.

The Legislature began a special session Dec. 6 to redraw congressional, state Public Education Commission and state Senate and House districts based on the 2020 census.

The state Senate passed the congressional redistricting bill with 25 Democrats voting yes and 15 Republicans voting no. **Democrat Bobby Gonzales** of Ranchos de Taos was excused from the vote and Republican Greg Schmedes of Tijeras (Bernalillo County) was absent.

In the House, the bill passed with 44 Democrats voting for it and 23 Republicans and one Democrat voting against it. State Rep. Candie Sweetser of Deming was the only Democrat to vote against the bill in either house. State Reps. Phelps Anderson, an independent from Roswell, and Republican Jane E. Powdrell-Culbert of Corrales were excused from the vote.

A wink of his eye and a twist of his head,


Soon gave me to know I had nothing to dread.

row without going outside the parameters of scientific definition?


To choose to believe only what is scientifically provable is to assume, I guess, that all human

# Transparency at heart of government deliberations

Transparency is at the heart of everything we do at the New Mexico Foundation for Open Government (FOG). The New Mexico's Legislature actions during this past special session show they do not share this value.

For months this summer the Legislature-mandated Redistricting Committee held public meetings and gathered public comment to create fair, equitable maps outlining congressional, state Senate and state representative districts. It seems much of their work has been done in vain. Surveys show that the public wants a process that is open and engaging. FOG believes the public's business should be conducted in full public view, the actions of the public bodies should be taken openly and all deliberations be made open to the public, yet the Legislature has conducted their meetings about redistricting behind closed doors, in partisan enclaves, eliminating any public access to the proceedings access that is an essential element of a properly functioning democracy. The voters deserve better.

# School board members sworn in for terms beginning Jan. 1



After beginning her career with Albuquerque Public Schools, Cort taught French at Las Cruces High School for 26 years, retiring in May 2019. Cort was named LCPS teacher of the year in 2012 and New Mexico teacher of the year in 2013.

Wofford retired in 2017 after teaching English at Las Cruces High School for 34 years.

If you love movies, and movie musicals more specifically, chances are good that you already know the many delights of "That's Entertainment!"

Originally devised by MGM as a tribute to the studio's 50th anniversary, the 1974 compilation of clips has become a New Year's Eve staple on Turner Classic Movies. The channel will maintain the tradition by showing it again Friday, Dec. 31, along with the three sequels ... but the first film offers the cream of the crop, drawing upon many of the top song-and-dance sequences in MGM history, with some extra curios (such as an all-star luncheon) providing additional pleasure.


The picture is smartly organized into segments, each introduced and narrated by a star with an MGM connection, beginning with Frank Sinatra (who opens the movie with an amusing look at how many times "Singin' in the Rain" has been used in different attractions). Fred

Astaire, Gene Kelly, Peter Lawford, Liza Minnelli (who reflects on the MGM career of her mother, Judy Garland), Donald O'Connor, Debbie Reynolds, Mickey Rooney, James Stewart and Elizabeth Taylor follow as other hosts.

The march of time allows most of them to wax humorous about their earlier days on screen, with Stewart noting that he was no singer (evidence is offered), yet such vocalizing was among the requirements for many of the studio's talents. 




#### "The Lucy Show"







# Julian Alexander keeps coming back to roots in Las Cruces

You could call Las Cruces High School and New Mexico State University graduate Julian Alexander a renaissance man, a jack of all trades, a polymath. Or you could just say he is a talented and daring actor, writer, director, filmmaker, storyteller and entrepreneur.

"I want to be ready for anything," said Alexander, 29. "Every time life gets hard, I think about ... all these things I love."

Alexander has served as an adjunct and a visiting assistant professor at NMSU and as an adjunct at El Paso Community College. He currently is a full-time lecturer in film production at the University of East London, where he is also pursuing doctoral studies that focus on "using rap as the primary storytelling tool on screen," or what Alexander calls "The Cinematic Hip-Hop Narrative."

He also has a BA in digital filmmaking from the Creative Media Institute at NMSU and an MFA from Leeds Beckett University in London.

Alexander has lectured and presented live and online about poetry, theater and filmmaking at public schools, colleges and universities in New Mexico and several other states and internationally, and has performed his own material as well as works by William Shakespeare, Harold Pintar, Samuel Taylor Coleridge, Edgar

Allan Poe and others for audiences in Las Cruces and around the world.

And, even though Covid-19 interrupted the creative process, he has a number of projects in the works.

"For the last couple years, I've been developing and performing a lecture series titled 'Shakespeare Was A Rapper," Alexander said. "It's a project now where I take all the research from my Ph.D. and deliver it in fun and entertaining ways with students and younger audiences in mind. JulianShakesStory is my new initiative where I continue to make classic literature and hip-hop more accessible on both sides of that bridge."

A native of Norfolk, Virginia, Alexander moved with his parents to Las Cruces in 2007 and lived here for nearly a decade. "I love Las Cruces," Alexander said. "Las Cruces taught me everything about movies. It's a place that fosters creativity and allows you to challenge yourself. It's such a supportive community."

And he keeps coming home.

Alexander co-coordinated the City of Las **Cruces Juneteenth Jazz** Festival last summer; he produced and acted in the return engagement of "Othello: The Remix," which he and fellow actors Josh Horton, Juan Apodaca and Mark Katanga also performed in Santa Fe, in August; he co-hosted a poetry slam at Art Obscura Gallery in Mesilla Park; and he emceed and presented at Doña Ana Community College's 10x25 Conference for creators, innovators, educators and entrepreneurs in October. Alexander has also made a number of successful and awardwinning movies, including some he shot in Las Cruces, like "Beat Blue," which was also filmed in Mesilla and Albuquerque.

His film "Buffalo" was featured in the 2016 Cannes Film Festival Short Film Corner. "Leo," a short film he shot in England and France, took the top spot in a number of international film festivals.

Alexander's most recent short film is "Layla, At Last," which he wrote and directed. It was filmed in Spain and Morocco and funded by the Sharjah Art Foundation in the United Arab Emirates, where the film premiered in 2019.

Alexander wrote, directed and starred in the 2019 digital series "Bad Juju," for which he received the rising star

award at Spain's Bilbao Seriesland Festival and earned a best actor nomination.

Alexander also continues to work with his parents and godmother as part of Alexander Consulting and Training, a long-time family-owned company, and Diversity Decoded, which his familv founded in 2020 "to help HR practitioners recognize and respond effectively when they encounter DEI (diversity, equity and inclusion) opportunities and challenges," according to www.diversitydecoded. com.

His parents, who now live in Washington, D.C., "grew up in segregation" in Mississippi and North Carolina respectively, Alexander said, and he has incorporated their life experiences and his own into his classrooms and onto the stage and screen in his plays, poetry and films.

His goal as a storyteller and filmmaker is not to tell just one side of a story, but to show that "there's a complete story," he said.

"My mission is to lift up the forgotten stories of the Southwest and shine a light on the incredible history of the Black people in the Southwest, the tribes and indigenous communities and other minority groups that have been erased through history," Alexander said.

"My mentors in Las Cruces are the ones who inspired me to go to England, and they're probably the reason I keep coming back," he said. "I go to my old schools and love letting students know that there are opportunities to exist elsewhere, but that doesn't mean vou have to leave forever. Leave and return with new information that inspires others around you to explore as well. As creative people, that's necessary. Our job is to make up imaginary worlds and characters, an impossible task if our perspectives are limited."

# **Record oil, gas funds \$176M in Doña Ana County education**

A new report from the New Mexico Tax Research Institute (NMTRI) shows the state's oil and natural gas industry provided \$5.3 billion in state and local tax revenue for fiscal year 2021—the highest figure in New Mexico history, the New Mexico Oil and Gas Association (NMOGA) said in a Dec. 1 news release.

Through its contributions to the state's general fund, the oil and gas industry provided almost \$176.1 million in funding for Doña Ana County's three school districts, New Mexico State University and Doña Ana Community College in FY 2021, NMOGA said in its 2021 report, "Fueling New Mexico: How New Mexico's Oil and Natural Gas Industry Benefits All."

That includes \$114.6 million in K-12 funding -77 schools in Las Cruces Public Schools, the Gadsden Independent School District and Hatch Valley Public Schools; and \$61.6 million for NMSU and DACC.

NMOGA said that translates to 6,374 jobs supported and almost \$300 million in labor income.

Public schools continue to be the largest beneficiary of oil and natural gas revenue, NMOGA said, with \$1.04 billion going to public education and \$275 million going to New Mexico universities, colleges and other institutions of higher education.

State revenue jumped

more than \$500 million from FY 2020 on production growth and improving market conditions, as

New Mexico also became the second-largest oil producer in the United States. NMOGA said.

"Historic revenue equals historic opportunity, and that is great news for teachers and students, critical first responders and health care workers, and each and every New Mexican across this state," said NMOGA President and CEO Leland Gould.

The \$5.3 billion in 2021 revenue surpassed the previous industry record of \$5.16 billion set in FY 2019.

Higher-than-average production coupled with improving market conditions were the primary drivers of revenue growth, NMOGA said. "2021 saw a remarkable

recovery in New Mexico's

oil and natural gas industry as producers maintained record production levels and gradually restored drilling over the course of the year," said NMTRI President Richard Anklam.

"While some revenue streams initially dipped on curtailed drilling activity, the rebound in market prices and consistently high output lifted direct taxes on production by 40 percent," Anklam added.

Oil and gas revenue accounts for 35 percent of the state general fund, supporting education, public safety, economic development, health care and other areas of state spending, NMOGA said. The oil and natural gas

industry is the state's largest economic and fiscal contributor, supporting more than 134,000 jobs and \$27 billion in annual economic activity, NMOGA said.



Golf provides plenty of life lessons to improve your leadership skills

Those of us who have played golf know that the big difference between our success and failure at any given time is almost always mental, not physical. When athletes of similar talent compete, in any sport, mental competence and expertness (I call it "toughness") is what separates winners from others. So it is too

having continual control of our emotions, having and maintaining utmost confidence in our abilities and possessing the presence of mind to size up the circumstances correctly and decide decisively.

Just as golfers need to learn shot making, positioning, recovery plays and other critical skills, leaders in any field need to master certain competencies which are required for performance that is consistent with winning. As golfers we need to master swing fundamentals, course management, touch, feel (e.g. putting and chipping) and nerves.

Leaders need to master business fundamentals, people management, organizational politics, situational feel - oh, and nerves. In both golf and in leadership, we are supposed to know, understand and follow the rules of the game. As golfers and leaders we must always carry ourselves with class and behave with professionalism and honor. In golf and leadership what counts most is what we do alone.

The exceptionally men-

tally tough leaders and war heroes tend to be high in what is called "emotional intelligence" or EQ. To perform brilliantly when it counts, whether you're an athlete or an executive, there are three essential aptitudes we can learn from golf — and all are components of high EQ.

The most basic is getting to know ourselves as deeply as possible. High self-awareness, which means understanding our

strengths, our tendencies, our limitations, our attitudes, our peculiar habits and those areas where we need to grow: this is absolutely essential for someone to manage others effectively. Secondly, high performing leaders need to have a savvy grasp of the situation at all times. They need to see the big picture and they need to be keenly focused on what is happening in the moment.

Donaldson said the team needs to continue practicing hard, focusing on defense and "stopping people."


The Aggies really get going when "our defense is propelling our offense and getting the ball inside
