- At the time of this printing, BOWLING requires proof of Covid Vaccine, mask wearing and picture ID to enter the White Sands Missile Range base – Check with Gary Tuttle on updates.
- ARCHERY WILL ALLOW ONE OF THE FOLLOWING: Recurve (with sights), Compound Fingers (with sights), Compound Release (with or without sights), Barebow Recurve (no sights), and Barebow Compound (no sights).
- THE TRACK ORDER OF EVENTS ARE: 5K power & race walks, 100M run, 1500M run, 50M run, 400M est walk, 400M run, 1500 Power & race walks, 800M run, 800M est walk.
- THE FIELD ORDER OF EVENTS ARE: Standing Long Jump, Running Long Jump, High Jump, Shotput, Discus, Javelin.
- THE RACEWALK AND POWER WALK INCLUDE: 1500M and 5K (you may only participate in either race or power in either event as they are run at the same time).
- THE AIR GUN EVENT INCLUDES: Pistol -standing, pistol -benchrest, rifle -standing, rifle -benchrest.
- FUN&REC EVENTS INCLUDE: Soccer Accuracy Kick, Softball Distance Throw, Frisbee Distance, Frisbee Accuracy Throw.

Registration \$20, each Event \$5, Corn Hole is an exhibition and free, Fun &Rec is \$10 for any or all of the 4 events, the extra fees for golf are \$39.00 and Bowling \$6/day.

elcome to the 2022 Doña Ana County Senior Games!
We've missed playing the past two years but look forward to seeing everyone this year!

Doña Ana County Senior Olympics is committed to a program of sports and recreational events to promote healthy and active lifestyles for all seniors age 50 and above. Our programs encourage both the athlete and the beginner to participate within their own 5-year age category starting from 50-54 and going up to 90+. Senior Olympics in Doña Ana County is a volunteer group, with support coming from your modest registration fees. We offer 19+ sports with opportunities for singles, doubles and mixed doubles play. When participating in any of our events, each person is covered by an athlete insurance policy. Your age group for competition is the age you are on December 31 of the registration year. For more information call Betty Burgess at 575-288-0750.

If you are playing doubles you will need the name, birthdate and email of your partner.

Example: if you turn 50 on Sept. 1, 2022, you are considered 50 for the full year of 2022, and eligible for the spring 2022 games.

# THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR THE 2022 DACSO GAMES.

With this new registration system, you will need an email address, to create a password and be able to pay via credit/debit card.

### **LOCAL SENIOR GAMES**

The Local Senior Games are held in Las Cruces from March 12 to April 30, 2022. No qualifications are needed - just be 50 years old by Dec. 31, 2022.

# Michael R. Simione (1938 - 2020)

who takes the term "User Friendly" to the next level and is a competent, efficient administrator? If you have been involved with the Doña Ana County Senior Olympics (DACSO) in recent years you call that person Mike Simione. After serving as office administrator for the past twelve years, Mike passed away in December 2020.

When contacting DACSO whether in person, email or phone, you were warmly greeted. If you were in the office or at a sports venue you had the added benefit of experiencing his friendly demeanor and smile which was likely to evolve into laughter.

Mike and his wife of 55 years, Marilyn, retired to Las Cruces in 1996 from Northfield, Minnesota. Mike spent a 30-year career as an administrator at St. Olaf College finishing as Director of Auxiliary Enterprise and Purchasing. His community service in Northfield included serving in City Council and as mayor. While in Las Cruces, in addition to Senior Olympics and with the support of Marilyn, he was involved with the Vista program, Community of Hope and St. Albert the Great Parish. Marilyn sums it best, "His work was his hobby, and his hobby was helping others."

DACSO president Paul Fetterhoff recalled, "Mike knew almost every registered athlete by name. Often when calling an athlete at home, he inquired about family members as well...that always amazed me." Long time participant and volunteer Jack Welch said, "Every meeting or encounter with Mike was a pleasure, he truly was a great guy."



# **Amelia Davis**

articipation in Senior Olympics reveals many inspiring stories in meeting the challenges of life. Participants often demonstrate heroic measures of courage, grace and perseverance reminding us that how we journey in life is more important than how far we manage to go.

Amelia Davis is one such hero. She has participated in the Senior Olympics since 1980 and as you can tell, with much success. She has competed in race walking, horseshoes, bowling, and other numerous events. In 2002 she participated in the Bataan Memorial Death March at the White Sands Missile Range.

Amelia has overcome many challenges in her lifetime but states "remaining active has helped her maintain her health and enthusiasm." She was honored in 2010 as the Las Cruces Golden Athlete of the Year for her personal accomplishments and contributions for enhancing the quality of life for seniors. Now in her 90s she has finally hung up her running shoes but remains a loyal supporter of Senior Olympics and is an inspiration to all who know her.
