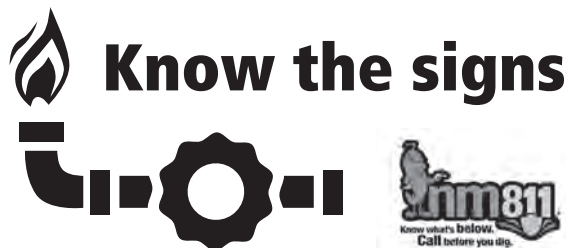

Thanks to the support of the Las Cruces City Manager Ifo Pili, LCU was able to have its awards for the first time at the Las Cruces Convention Center to allow its staff to come together with food, door prizes, and a way to cheer on colleagues who deserve their light to shine.

At the event, employees were honored for their services years, from 5 years to 25 years. Then, four specialty awards were given.

- LCU Solid Waste Supervisor Philip Glasson won the Customer Service Above & Beyond Award for his ability to transition between leadership and keeping customer service its top priority. "He does a great job ensuring that the daily work is monitored and completed by the Solid Waste teams, and at one time, as the only Solid Waste Supervisor on staff," said LCU Deputy Director Solid Waste Carl Pierce.

- LCU Dispatcher Joshua Moreno won the Excellence through Innovation Award for the iPad implementation

project that links those in field to with real-time work orders and data.

- LCU Accountant and Interim Rates and Economic Analysis Manager Abner Gomez won the Cost-Effective Savings Solution Award for analyzing the rotation of vehicles for cost savings and initializing a reserve system on the auction which allowed for a sale of \$472,000 of old vehicles that went back into LCU funds.

- LCU Wastewater Treatment Plant Crew Leader James Woods and LCU Industrial Pollution Prevention (IPP) Inspector Damon Barnes received the 8th Annual LCU Board Cash Award for going "above and beyond their required job duties by providing technical support for extensive odor monitoring. Their efforts lead to the proper identification of the cause and effect of the odor/corrosion issue within the collection line that runs along Motel Boulevard," said LCU Deputy Director Wastewater Laura Montoya.

Lastly, former Chair of the LCU Board of Commissioners William Little was recognized for his 12 years of chairmanship by current LCU Board Chair Ed Archuleta.

New Mexico's ag production tops \$3.1 billion

New Mexico's total value of agriculture production was \$3.17 billion in 2021, five percent above 2020, state Department of Agriculture Sec. Jeff Witte said as NMDA released agricultural statistics for 2021.

"New Mexico chile and pecan production ranked in the top two spots in the United States in 2021," Witte said. Also contributing to the state's value of production, onions ranked third in the nation at \$128 million, milk ranked ninth at \$1.26 billion and cattle and calves ranked 16th at \$1.07 billion."

"New Mexico agriculture has a great story to tell, and our producers live it every day," said Witte. "The statistics are a reflection of

the hard work and dedication of those in the agriculture sector. We would not be able to fill our plates if it weren't for those who live every day tending to the crops and livestock."

Highlights from the 2021 economic analysis of New Mexico's farm sector:

- The value of New Mexico livestock production increased slightly to \$2.41 billion in 2021. Crop value increased to \$756 million, up 15 percent.

- In gross farm income, Doña Ana County, generated more than \$420 million, third highest in the state, behind only Curry County (\$615 million) and Chaves County (\$484 million).

- Milk prices were unchanged at \$16.3 per hundredweight. Cattle prices increased six percent from

2020 to \$1,100 a head. Alfalfa hay prices were up sharply, averaging \$236 per ton. The price for pecans averaged \$2.40 a pound in 2021, up 54 percent from 2020. Chile prices were up 15 percent from 2021's \$882 per ton. Prices also increased in 2021 for corn, cotton, onions and wheat.

- There were 24,700 farms in New Mexico in 2021, down 100 from 2020. The number of farms in the state reached 25,000 in 2017 and has not been below 24,700 for at least 10 years. The average farm size is 1,619 acres. NMDA said there are just over two million farms in the U.S., with an average size of 445 acres.

- New Mexico's inventory of all cattle and calves was 1.3 million as of Jan. 1, 2022, down six percent

from 2021. Milk cow inventory decreased 13 percent to 292,000 head. Sheep and lamb inventory totaled 90,000 head as of Jan. 1, 2022, down six percent from 2021.

- Two fire complexes – the Calf Canyon and Hermits Peak Fire and the Black Fire – consumed more than 666,000 acres of New Mexico land in 2021.

- New Mexico was fourth in cheese production in the U.S. in 2021, with almost 960 million pounds produced, 6.9 percent of the U.S. total. Wisconsin was tops with almost 3.5 billion pounds produced in 2021, more than 25 percent of the national total. New Mexico has produced more than 4.5 billion pounds of cheese since 2017.

- Pecan production in New Mexico totaled 78.7

million pounds in 2021, equal to 30.8 percent of U.S. production. The total was down 100,000 pounds from 2020. The total value of production was \$188.9 million. Georgia led the country in pecan production with 88.6 million tons produced in 2021, 34.7 percent of the national total.

- Chile production totaled 51,000 tons in 2021, down 22 percent from 2020. 8,700 acres were planted, unchanged from 2020. The average yield was six tons per acre, down two tons from 2020. At 4,500 acres in 2021, the red chile harvest increased by 300 acres. The green chile harvest was unchanged at 4,000 acres. New Mexico produced 61 percent of the U.S. chile pepper crop in 2021. California produced the other 39 percent.

- Doña Ana County had 1,946 farms in 2017, the most recent agriculture census year, with just over 25,000 for the whole state. Doña Ana's farms totaled 528,270 acres. The average farm size was 270 acres. The value of products sold was over \$370 million. The average net farm income was \$41,662. In 2021, the county had 2,400 acres in planted cotton, fourth behind Lea, Luna and Eddy counties. It had 31,500 acres in pecan production, compared to 45,000 acres for the whole state. Doña Ana County had 58,000 head of cattle as of Jan. 1, 2022. Chaves County was tops in the state with 170,000 head.

Where does your food come from?

I grew up in Oklahoma not liking pecans.

After moving to New Mexico, I had the chance to eat fresh pecans. By fresh, I mean they had been on a tree the day before. And I actually liked them. It was a lesson in the value of freshness, and of locally sourced food.

And when a lady made me a green chile-apple-pecan pie, made of all fresh New Mexico ingredients, well, I thought if I had to die, that might have been a pretty good day.

If you ask most Americans under 10, "Where does food come from?" you're likely to receive an answer like this: "The grocery store."

Or worse: "The drive-through at McDonalds."

Unfortunately, you might get the same general answers if you ask a lot of Americans of many ages.

In New Mexico, the percentage of correct answers might be higher. As a geographically large, rural state, we have more residents connected in one way or another to farming, ranching and agriculture than in a lot of

states.

We also have the benefit of being the nation's top producer of that deliciously addictive crop: green chile, and the nation's second producer of that international favorite: the

pecan. We produce more than a third of all American pecans, and nearly two-thirds of American chile peppers.

Most New Mexicans don't know, however, our state is a huge producer in a lot of other crops and agricultural products. Wisconsin earned its title as America's Dairyland, I suppose, but did you know New Mexico is fourth in the nation in cheese production? And did you know what an impact all this has on our state's economy and, directly or indirectly, your livelihood.

The New Mexico Department of Agriculture has released its most recent statistics. (These are for the year 2021; there's a lag time on the numbers.)

Our reporter Mike Cook

wrote a summary you'll find on Page 5.

There's a lot of interesting bits of information, but the numbers don't tell the whole story -- the story of all the New Mexico farmers and ranchers who sweat and toil and freeze and bleed and, too often, go broke trying to serve and feed the rest of us.

Remember these neighbors when you're out shopping.

Yes, you probably can find pecans made in Georgia and pistachios from California at the store.

And they might even be cheaper.

But they sure won't taste better, and they sure won't be helping out your fellow New Mexicans.

End of the (almost) million-dollar duo at NMSU

The last time the New Mexico State University Board of Regents set out to pick a new leader, after having unceremoniously rid themselves of Garrey Carruthers, they had a hard time picking between the two finalists for the job. And so, they hired both of them. At a combined salary of almost \$1 million.

Let's hope there's a clear frontrunner this time.

The decision in 2018 to hire both Dan Arvizu, at a yearly salary of \$500,000, and John Floros, at \$450,000, came as a complete surprise to NMSU faculty, staff and students. Carruthers had been earning less than \$375,000 a year at the time his contract was not renewed.

Regents justified the massive increase in executive salaries by explaining that one man would be put in charge of the main campus, while the other would

have authority over the rest of the NMSU system. It was a change they had been considering for some time, then-Regent Kari Mitchell explained.

Maybe so, but it was a private discussion. The rest of the NMSU community was never included in that deliberation, and they never bought into the changes.

In 2021, both the NMSU Faculty Senate and the Senate of the Associated Students passed resolutions of no-confidence against Floros and then-Provost Carol Parker, who was later fired.

The first in a list of five allegations leading up to the no-confidence vote was, "misappropriation of university funds." Organizers of the opposition vote later explained that they weren't alleging theft, but were responding to the huge increase

in executive salaries.

It didn't help that at the same time NMSU was paying nearly \$1 million a year for just two employees, graduate students who do much of the classroom teaching barely earned enough to survive. A

new contract approved last month should help that situation.

The (almost) million-dollar duo was never able to fully implement the new vision that was laid out when they were hired. Floros stepped down a year ago, bringing an end to the two-leader experiment.

And it was announced in a news release last week that regents would not renew the contract of Arvizu when it expires in June. The news release praised Arvizu's accomplishments, but did not explain

why his contract is not being renewed and what changes regents now want to make with a new leader.

The news release did state, "the board plans to make sure the search is transparent and fully engages NMSU faculty, staff, students, alumni, donors, community members and other stakeholders across the region."

We'll see. If they don't, it will demonstrate an inability to learn from past mistakes, no matter how glaring they may be.

Talk about sweet success!

Sylvia Terrazas began business in Las Cruces with a \$1,500 microloan and a video rental store in a 300-square-foot rental property in 2000. In January, Terrazas will celebrate the fifth anniversary of Paleteria La Reyna Michoacana in the 3,500-square-foot building she owns at 870 E. Madrid Ave., just east of the intersection of Madrid and Solano Drive. And Terrazas has plans to expand even more in 2023, including the addition of a food truck.

She has 21 employees and has an investment of more than \$1 million in her business and annual sales

in excess of \$1 million.

Paleteria La Reyna Michoacana is a store full of delights and surprises – ice cream, paletas, aguas frescas, manzana loca, elote en vaso, dulce Mexicano, nieve, funnel cake and other handmade treats.

In fact, “frozen goodness on a stick” is a loose translation of Michoacana. The full name of the business could be translated as “A Taste of the Queen’s Frozen Popsicles.”

“Every day it’s fresh,” said Terrazas, who brings in an assortment of fresh fruits and vegetables to incorporate into her recipes.

You will also find a wide selection of giant piñatas, Mexican candy and sodas, toys and more than 80 different products in all at the store, including items in

NM oil production increasing

BULLETIN REPORT

New Mexico now ranks second only to North Dakota for highest oil production per resident surpassing Alaska, Colorado and Texas, the New Mexico Legislative Finance Committee said in December. New Mexico oil production has increased to 1.7 million barrels a day from 700,000 in 2018, the LFC said. “Coupled with its low population, the high per-capita oil production makes New Mexico the second richest state for per person tax revenue stemming from oil and gas industries,” the LFC said. “Texas produces greater volumes of oil than New Mexico, but Texas’ oil production per capita falls behind the production and tax revenue experienced in New Mexico due to a larger total population. New Mexico production, driven by activity in the Permian Basin, is expected to continue to grow, although revenues from oil production continue to be volatile, fueling a boom-and-bust budget cycle.”

Regents to begin search for next NMSU chancellor

On Dec. 28, the New Mexico State University Board of Regents authorized and instructed the university's administration to begin working with the board on a search process for the university's next chancellor. NMSU Chancellor Dan Arvizu, now 72, signed a five-year contract with the university in 2018. That contract expires June 30, 2023.

"The board thanks Chancellor Arvizu for his service to NMSU, and looks forward to continuing our work with him over the next six months to ensure a smooth transition," the

regents said in a memo to campus.

The board plans to make sure the search is transparent and fully engages NMSU's faculty, staff, students, alumni, donors, community members and other stakeholders across the region.

The board highlighted some of the work done in Arvizu's term.

• Following more than a decade of declines, NMSU saw increased enrollment at each of its campuses this fall, as well as its largest freshman class since

2009.

• Since 2018, NMSU's research and development expenditures have grown by more than \$25 million. Post-doctoral researchers have nearly doubled in that same time frame and external awards now exceed \$129 million, the highest total in five years.

• NMSU will join Conference USA in 2023, allowing Aggie football, the 2022 Quick Lane Bowl champs, to be affiliated with a conference for the first time since 2017.

Regents said the NMSU community will receive continued updates on this search process, beginning early next month.

A look back

(EDITOR'S NOTE: Below are some notes from a 2018 Bulletin interview by Mike Cook just prior to Arvizu's arrival at NMSU.)

Dan Arvizu arrived on the NMSU campus May 22, 2018, leaving his home in Littleton, Colorado and his position as senior advisor to Emerson Collective, a nonprofit focused on social justice initiatives.

Arvizu lived in Alumni and Garcia halls when he was a student at NMSU, he said, and "would walk the length of the campus daily" to attend classes at the engineering center near Hadley Hall. He graduated with

a bachelor of science degree in mechanical engineering in 1973 and went on to earn a masters and a Ph.D. in the same field from Stanford.

Arvizu grew up in Alamogordo, played first-chair trumpet in the Alamogordo High School Band and attended NMSU on a music scholarship.

Being a member of the Aggie Pride Band was "one of my most rewarding experiences on campus," Arvizu said. He played in both the marching band and orchestra at NMSU, along with studying engineering.

Arvizu said he still occasionally plays the trumpet, he said, and has also "picked up guitar."

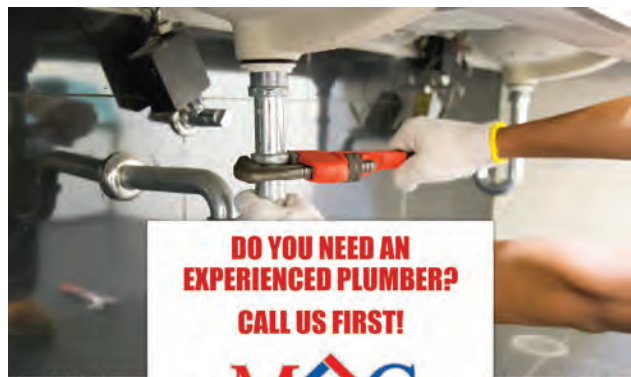

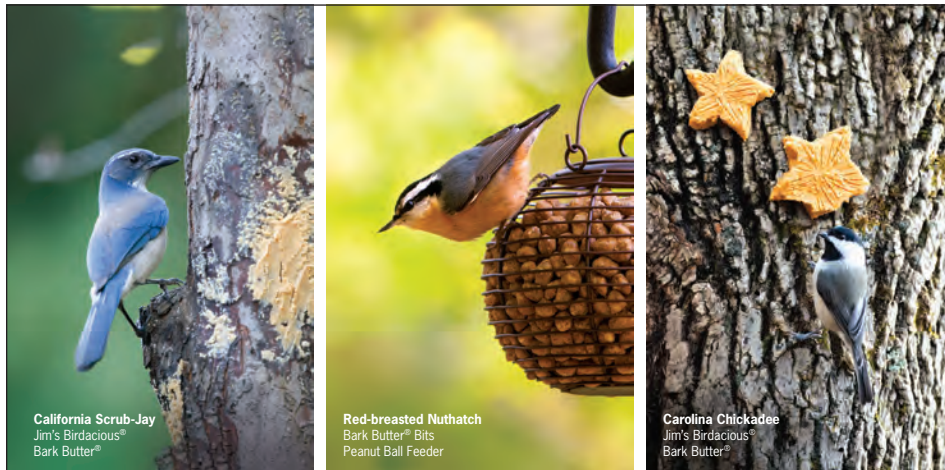

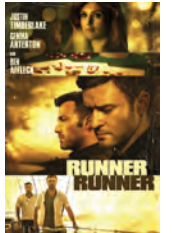
“Movie: Three Minutes: A Lengthening”



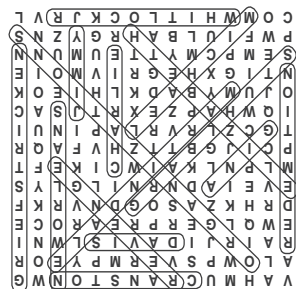

"THE MAN WHO FELL TO EARTH: SEASON ONE"

It has familiar elements from earlier incarnations, but this Showtime series version (which ended up having only this one season) uses those largely to go its own way. Following the Walter Tevis novel and the David Bowie-starring 1976 movie, this take on the story of an alien who comes to our planet casts Chiwetel Ejiofor ("12 Years a Slave," "Love Actually") as an extraterrestrial named Faraday, whose presence on Earth could dictate the future of mankind – something that already started to be charted by Thomas Jerome Newton, the Bowie character who's portrayed here

by another "Love Actually" alum, Bill Nighy. Naomi Harris ("Moonlight," "Skyfall") also has a prominent role as a scientist who monitors the situation closely. Checking in with
SCOTT CAAN

In playing a Philadelphia police officer who is reunited with his missing son after seven years, Scott Caan found himself in unfamiliar waters. As a matter of fact, the character's unique quandary makes it one that he's sure no actor has ever played.

In "Alert: Missing Persons Unit," an hourlong procedural drama that premieres Sunday, Jan. 8, on Fox (before taking its regular Monday time slot the following night), Caan ("Hawaii Five-0") stars as Jason Grant, a Philly cop who is a member of the department's Missing Persons Unit, who is reunited with his son Keith (Graham Verchere, "Stargirl") years after the boy disappeared.

So while Jason and his ex-wife and fellow cop Nikki (Dania Ramirez, "Maids") are overjoyed to have their boy back, they can't help but notice things about the teen that don't seem right and tell them he may not be their child. Which, Caan says, presented him with what he calls an "acting problem."

"This idea of Dania and my character are trying to figure out if this kid is our son or not is really something that's kind of unprecedented," he explains. "You know, it's not something you can go research, it's (not) something you can talk to somebody who's experienced. ... It's something that you really have to figure out and dig into and it's a complicated idea to try to figure out if this kid is our kid or not."

"I read (the script) and I was like, 'S... I don't know what I would do in these situations. I don't know how I would act.'"

But while the role at times left him at a loss, Caan is thankful he had a very easy rapport from day one with his scene partner Ramirez.

"I don't want to be too pretentious and talk about acting," the son of "The Godfather" actor James Caan says, "(but she) brings a certain sensitivity out of me that I haven't really been able to touch before. ... I think she's great."

will open Friday, Jan. 6, at CAV Gallery, 126 S. Main St. Downtown, and continue through Saturday, Feb. 18, gallery owner Marcus Xavier Chormicle said in a news release.

An opening reception will be 6-9 p.m. Jan. 6 at the gallery.

“Cura brings together El Paso artist Jose Lucero and Española artist Maryssa Rose Chavez to unite themes of past, present and

future and bridge physical and emotional distance,” Chormicle said. “Through image making, sculpture and a variety of other mediums, the pair of artists play with the tension between what is observable and what must be felt.

“At the threshold of perception lies a truth that can only be comprehended through experience.

The exhibition addresses a truth known by our ancient ancestors and distant descendants; a truth that lives within us,” Chormicle said. “We see through the same eyes that they had and will have. Our truth exists on the periphery of others’ understanding. Our truth is spiritual, metaphysical and emotional. The work holds space for those with a like mind and invites others to the challenge of comprehension.

What does it mean to understand? What does it mean to be welcomed? What does it mean to withhold? What does it mean to this for ourselves? To show a piece of ourselves? To present the same truth that we previously only found in each other’s eyes?”

Chavez has been an artist and photographer for nearly a decade, Chormicle said, with the focus of her current practice being in intervening, mending and healing in her ancestral homelands of northern New Mexico, Pueblo Territory (Española and surrounding region and tribes), through the use of alternative imaging processes and textile making. Along with her long-time partner, Adrian, Chavez resides in Austin, Texas (unseeded Tonkawa Land), and travels back and forth to Española to help and spend time with her mother and

visit her family, who all still reside there today, Chormicle said.

Lucero is a multidisciplinary artist who focuses on photography, drawing and sculpture, Chormicle said. He is currently pursuing a BFA at the University of Texas El Paso, after years of doing portraiture across the borderland.

“Lucero has lived in El Paso all his life, which is

a significant aspect of his artistic evolution and interdisciplinary practice,” Chormicle said. “His sensibility concerns itself with space and its relationship to the body. He uses the camera as an optical extension, in hopes of displaying the abstract and interconnected nature of reality.”

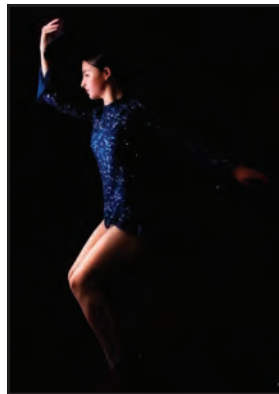

tyrannical and cruel headmistress, Miss Trunchbull, who believes in Crunchem Hall's motto: "Bambinatum est Magitum," or "Children are Maggots." She finds companionship in her teacher, Miss Honey, though well-intentioned, is shy and fragile. Brave little Matilda knows she has to stand up against the adults in her world, and in doing so, discovers her own remarkable powers. Matilda's bravery teaches Miss Honey and her classmates an important lesson -- that even though life can be hard, "nobody but me is gonna change my story" so "sometimes you have to be a little bit naughty."

Dahl (1916-90), a British novelist and screenwriter, wrote "Matilda" in 1988. The musical, staged by the Royal Shakespeare Com-

pany and written by Dennis Kelly, playwright, and Tim Minchin, composer and lyricist, premiered in London in 2011. That production continues at Cambridge Theatre. "Matilda" ran on Broadway 2013-17, and won Tony awards for book, featured actor and scenic design of a musical.

Rosaforte, Kohler: two golf notables we lost in 2022

Tim Rosaforte, perhaps the most universally respected golf writer of the modern era, passed away Jan. 11, 2022, after a two year battle with early-onset Alzheimer's. He was 66. "Rosie," as he was known for the past 20 years, was originally from Mt. Kisco, New York (35 miles north of New York City), and played football at the University of Rhode Island. He started his journalism career at the Tampa Times, later moving to the Palm Beach Post, and eventually Sports Illustrated, Golf Digest and Golf World. He settled in at the Golf Channel in 2007 where he grew into his role as golf's consummate "insider," offering notes, behind-the-scenes perspectives and interviews with the sport's biggest names. Among his honors were the PGA of America's Lifetime Achievement Award; he was also made an honorary member of the PGA of America. In addition, he won the Memorial Tournament's Lifetime Achievement

Award, and the Honda Classic named the Rosaforte Media Center for him. Rosaforte authored four books, the best of which is "Raising the Bar," about the stellar emergence of Tiger Woods.

Rosie's high esteem is found in several comments from important golfing figures. John Hawkins (si.com) writes: "If everyone did their job as well as Tim Rosaforte did his, the world would be a better place. As a golf writer, he was the greatest team-

mate who ever lived – a peerless, indefatigable reporter with a \$2 million rolodex and a 50-cent ego. As a man, Rosaforte was perfectly named. Gentle and vulnerable like a flower, tough and durable like a citadel."

"I've never heard anyone say a bad word about Tim Rosaforte," said Golf Channel announcer Rich Lerner, who worked alongside Rosaforte for 20 years. "He was always there to encourage you, to help you and to congratu-

late you when you did a good job." And this from Jack Nicklaus: "Tim had such a wonderful ability to develop relationships and trust from so many, and because of that – plus his work ethic – if there was an important story to be told in golf, Tim was usually the first one to report

it." Golf lost a major contributor to the game with the passing of Herb Kohler Jr. Sept. 3, 2022,

at age 83. After briefly serving in the U.S. Army Reserve, Kohler attended Yale University, where he studied Industrial Administration. At 35 he became Chairman and CEO of the family manufacturing business, the Kohler Company in 1972, known worldwide for high-end kitchen and bath faucets, plumbing and fixtures.

Through the years he amassed a portfolio of some 200 design and utility patents. Under his leadership annual revenues of the Kohler Co. grew from \$100 million 40 years ago to over \$7 billion today.

However, Mr. Kohler made his mark on the world of golf by developing the American Club resort in Kohler, Wisconsin, originally built in 1918 as an immigrant workers' dormitory. The American Club Hotel attracted so

many guests who yearned for a close-by golf course, so Kohler built Blackwolf Run in 1988, designed by Pete Dye, and soon another 18 holes on the same site. In 1998 he commissioned Dye to create Whistling Straits on the site of an old airfield and Army anti-artillery training facility on the shores of Lake Michigan. Whistling Straits opened on the same day that the 1998 U.S. Open was decided in a playoff at Blackwolf

Run. The final part of his Wisconsin golf course Pete Dye quartet came in 2000 with the opening of the Irish Course. Whistling Straits has hosted the PGA Championship in 2004, 2010 and 20125, the U.S. Senior Open in 2007, and the Ryder Cup in 2021.

Phone and Internet Discounts Available to CenturyLink Customers

The New Mexico Public Regulation Commission designated CenturyLink as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier within its service area for universal service purposes. CenturyLink's basic local service rates for residential voice lines are \$20.41 per month and business services are \$44.00 per month. Specific rates will be provided upon request.

CenturyLink participates in the Lifeline program, which makes residential telephone or qualifying broadband service more affordable to eligible low-income individuals and families. Eligible customers may qualify for Lifeline discounts of \$5.25/month for voice or bundled voice service or \$9.25/month for qualifying broadband or broadband bundles. Residents who live on federally recognized Tribal Lands may qualify for additional Tribal benefits if they participate in certain additional federal eligibility programs. The Lifeline discount is available for only one telephone or qualifying broadband service per household, which can be either a wireline or wireless service. Broadband speeds must be at least 25 Mbps download and 3 Mbps upload to qualify.

CenturyLink also participates in the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP), which provides eligible households with a discount on broadband service. The ACP provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands.

For both programs, a household is defined as any individual or group of individuals who live together at the same address and share income and expenses. Services are not transferable, and only eligible consumers may enroll in these programs. Consumers who willfully make false statements to obtain these discounts can be punished by fine or imprisonment and can be barred from these programs.

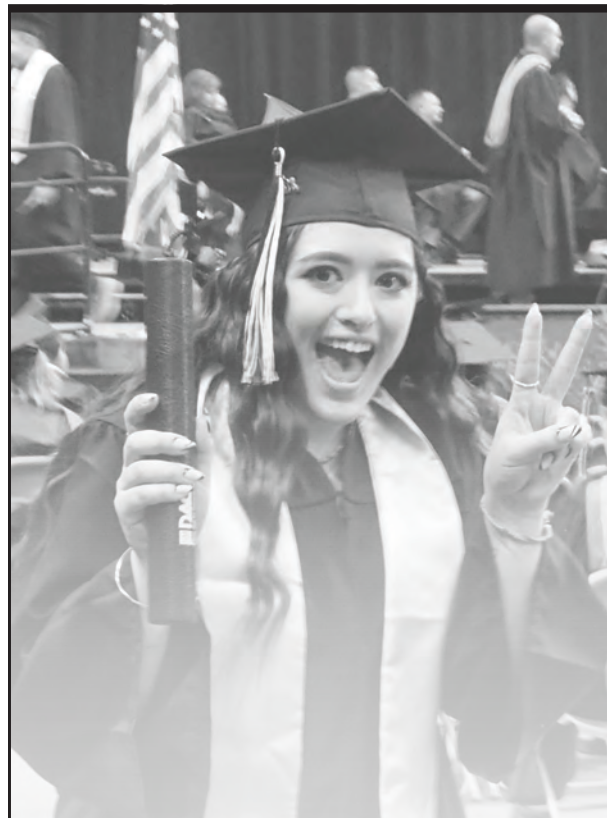
