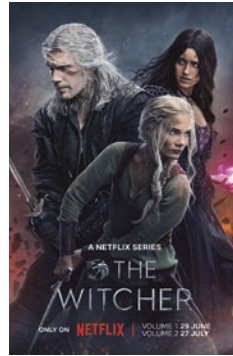
**“Movie:

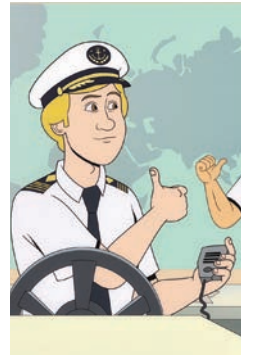

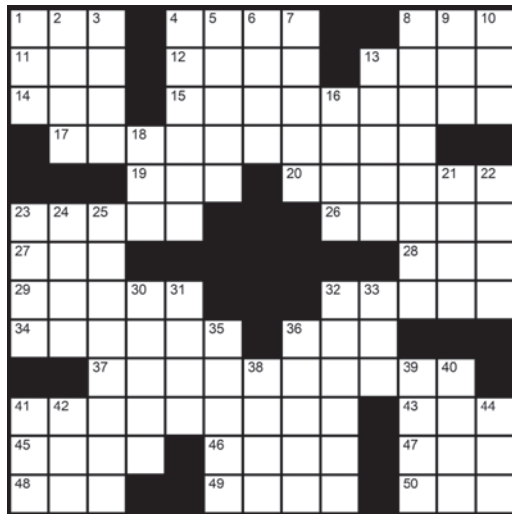

Also an executive producer of the show, America Ferrera is first among equals in the ensemble cast as Amy whose personal plights are balanced by her rise up the corporate chain (which ultimately led to the actress and character being absent for much of the final season). Ben Feldman, Lauren Ash, Colton Dunn, Nico Santos and Mark McKinney also are prominent among the regulars; series creator and executive producer Justin Spitzer went on to make the recently canceled "American Auto," and he'll be represented again next season on NBC by "St. Denis Medical." "PAINT"

Certain television personalities are bound to come to mind from Owen Wilson's portrayal of a Vermont-based painter who seems to have it made with his fame as a celebrity on public TV. Eventually, they all end up on Alcatraz Island, where shared peril awaits them. Cable-movie staple Erin Cahill is in the voice cast, as are Matthew Mercer, Stephanie Panisello, Kevin Dormann and Nicole Tompkins. "THE WAR OF THE WORLDS"

The original movie version of the classic H.G. Wells novel gets its own release in that format. Producer George Pal's 1953 thriller – which has been preserved by the National Film Registry – rightfully earned an Oscar for its special effects, depicting an invasion by Martians of various cities across Earth. California is the principal setting here, as an atomic scientist (Gene Barry) joins a science teacher (Ann Robinson) in trying to evade the unwelcome visitors, who shoot deadly rays from their spaceships to eliminate the sizable military forces dispatched against them. In a neat nod to this telling, Barry and Robinson made cameo appearances in the Steven Spielberg-directed 2005 edition. ★★★ (Not rated: V)

"THE NEIGHBORHOOD: SEASON FIVE"

Now headed toward its sixth year, this CBS sitcom marked a milestone during its most recent round ... its 100th episode, featuring a guest appearance by Jerry O'Connell in a plot involving school principal Gemma's efforts to secure tickets to "The Talk" for a benefit event. Other stories involve Calvin and Marty's (Cedric the Entertainer, Marcel Spears) plan to start a new business, Dave's (Max Greenfield) surprising discovery about his family tree, and Calvin and Tina's (Tichina Arnold) long-delayed honeymoon. Shaun McKinney and Hank Greenspan also star. ★★★ (Not rated: AS)

Checking in with

MALCOLM MCDOWELL

Spending much of the summer in Canada filming a television series suits Malcolm McDowell well.

The veteran of such movies as "A Clockwork Orange," "O Lucky Man!" and "Time After Time" currently is in Newfoundland making the third season of "Son of a Critch" ... which starts a U.S. run of its initial episodes Monday, July 24, on The CW. The autobiographical sitcom casts McDowell as the very candid grandfather of central character Mark Critch, a comedian whose experiences as a youth inspired the show. Interestingly, Critch plays his own father Mike in the show, while Mark is portrayed by young Benjamin Evan Ainsworth.

"I think it's beautifully written," the friendly McDowell says, "and it's a fantastic cast, people I hadn't really known before. This young man they found (Ainsworth) is such a good actor, and we're so lucky to have him. We all rise or fall on his performance, and I think he's fantastic. It's been really nice to see his progression as an actor and his young adult, and he's just lovely, which you can tell by his work."

McDowell earned a Canadian Screen Awards nomination for his Season 1 work as Patrick Critch, or "Pop," in "Son of a Critch." He maintains he's quite comfortable in his surroundings while doing the role: "I hadn't been to Newfoundland before, though I had been to Nova Scotia, and what a wonderful place it's turned out to be. Of course, we're only there in the summer, so I don't know how it is in the winter. I think those can be pretty brutal."

"Son of a Critch" is one of a number of Canadian series picked up by The CW, particularly with the network's newly revised economic model, and McDowell is glad for the show's U.S. exhibition. "It's always nice to be seen," he reasons. "When I've talked about it, some people have looked at me with a blank stare, because they haven't heard of it ... so it's nice to have it out there."
