Q: I've enjoyed Rachel Boston in many of her cable movies. Where did she get her start?

A: Seen most recently in "The More Love Grows" on Hallmark Movies & Mysteries, the actress has been starting to play mothers more frequently ... which is appropriate, since she became a first-time mom herself early in 2022. Her first big credit was the 2002-05 NBC series "American Dreams," inspired by the legendary music show "American Bandstand" and featuring Boston as Beth, who became the sister-in-law of "Bandstand" dancer Beth (Brittany Snow). Boston went on to do guest shots on many series including "NCIS," "Crossing Jordan," "Las Vegas," "Grey's Anatomy," "ER" and "Castle." She landed continuing roles on "In Plain Sight" and "Witches of East End," and in 2014, she began what has become her long association with the Hallmark brand, which started with the movie "A Ring by Spring" (still repeated fairly often). The Christmas season has yielded a particular amount of work for Boston, who has worked again for Hallmark in "Ice Sculpture Christmas," "Christmas in Angel Falls," "Check Inn to Christmas," "The Christmas Carousel" and "A Christmas Cookie Catastrophe." "Stop the Wedding," "The Last Bridesmaid" and "Dating the Delaneys" have been among Boston's other Hallmark projects; she also has made films for Lifetime occasionally.



Additionally, Boston has had a recurring role on "SEAL Team" that enabled her to keep working while she was in later stages of her pregnancy, since her character on the series – Hannah Oliver – also was expecting, with high-school friend and Bravo Team member Sonny Quinn (A.J. Buckley) the father of her child.

“Movie: Reptile” (Available Now)

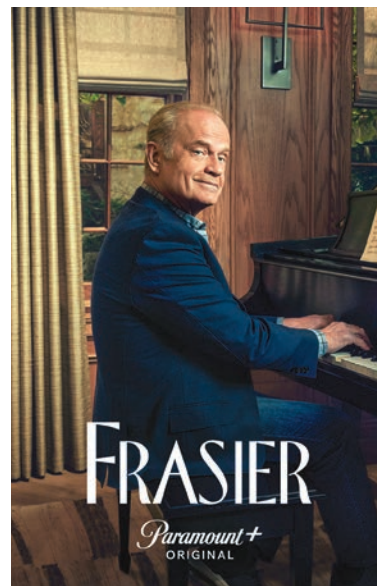

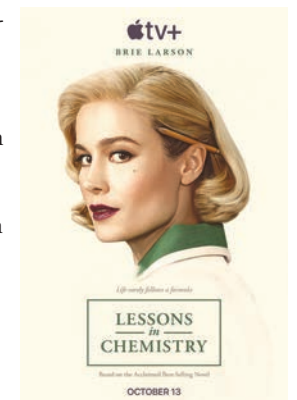
“The Fall of the House of Usher” - Season 1 (Netflix — Oct. 12, Series Premiere)

From Mike Flanagan, the creator of “The Haunting of Hill House” and “Midnight Mass,” this wicked horror series is based on the works of Edgar Allan Poe.

Ruthless siblings Roderick (Zach Gilford, Bruce Greenwood) and Madeline Usher (Willa Fitzgerald, Mary McDonnell) have built Fortunato Pharmaceuticals into an empire of wealth, privilege and power. But past secrets come to light when the heirs to the Usher dynasty start dying at the hands of a mysterious woman from their youth.

“Lessons in Chemistry” (Apple TV+ — Oct. 13, Limited Series Premiere)

Set in the early 1950s, this series, based on the bestselling novel of the same name by Bonnie Garmus, follows Elizabeth Zott (Brie Larson), whose dream of being a scientist is put on hold in a patriarchal society. "PREY"

The "Predator" franchise has yielded a number of movie thrillers, but it backed up in its timeline for this prequel, first shown by Hulu and currently nominated for six Primetime Emmy Awards. It follows the quest of an 18th-century Comanche warrior named Naru (played by Amber Midthunder, of the series "Legion" and "Roswell, New Mexico") to keep her people safe from an enemy who turns out to be an alien predator, of the sort that would torment Arnold Schwarzenegger's character in the original film. Dane DiLiegro plays the villain, who still has the advantage of invisibility even in a much earlier era, and Dakota Beavers and Michelle Thrush also are in the cast. Directed by Dan Trachtenberg – who also put a familiar series on fresh ground with "10 Cloverfield Lane" – the picture received a generally warm reception from critics, many of whom credited this latest chapter with transforming the basic "Predator" concept substantially, in part from making use of the Comanche language extensively. ★★★ (R: AS, GV) (Also on DVD and Blu-ray)

"STEPHEN KING'S THE MIST"

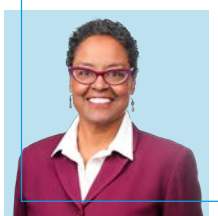
The horror-writing icon's saga of a fog that descends on a Maine town after a fierce storm, and harbors dangerous creatures, makes its debut in the 4K Ultra HD format as the month of Halloween begins. Some of the residents seek shelter inside a supermarket, and not only do they have fears of the monsters, but also of each other as the seeds of paranoia and mistrust are planted. Adapted and directed by Frank Darabont, the 2007 thriller features Thomas Jane, Marcia Gay Harden, Andre Braugher, Toby Jones, William Sadler and Alexa Davalos. Interestingly, several actors who also would work with Darabont on "The Walking Dead"

"THE STING"

One of the most cleverly written of all the movies that have earned Oscars for best picture gets a reissue on 4K Ultra HD – as part of the "Universal Essentials Collection" – as previous "Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid" colleagues Paul Newman, Robert Redford and director George Roy Hill reunite for the 1973 tale of Depression-era con artists. Newman and Redford's con-artist characters stage an elaborate swindle – or sting – to even a score with a vicious mobster (Robert Shaw). The great supporting cast includes Charles Durning, Eileen Brennan, Ray Walston and Harold Gould; the picture's seven Academy Award wins also included honors for writer David S. Ward and composer Marvin Hamlisch, who relied heavily on adapting Scott Joplin's ragtime music in assembling the score. ★★★ (Not rated: AS, P, V)

"NCIS: HAWAII – SEASON TWO"

Given the entertainment-industry strikes, this CBS spinoff is still a ways off from broadcasting new episodes, so this collection of its past season's stories may satisfy fans in the meantime. It opens within a crossover episode with the parent "NCIS" series as Jane Tennant and Ernie Malik (played by Vanessa Lachey and Jason Antoon) work with Nick Torres and Jessica Knight (Wilmer Valderrama, Katrina Law) to clear the name of the latter duo's boss, Alden Parker (Gary Cole). This show also had a Year Two crossover with another of its cousins, "NCIS: Los Angeles" – and that now-finished series' LL Cool J is slated to make recurring appearances here next season, continuing his Sam Hanna character. Alex Tarrant, Noah Mills, Yasmine Al-Bustami and Tori Anderson also star in this adventure-drama. ★★★ (Not rated: AS, P, V)
