Your choice, your vote counts

Tour participation in the upcoming November election matters! Your choices, your vote counts! With the November 7th election right around the corner and early voting beginning on October 10th, know beyond any shadow of a doubt that your vote matters. My father, as perhaps you have often heard me say, was diligent in voting and when I became of voting age took me down to get registered. I remember my first election standing in line with him and hearing him telling me

what a great privilege we have as Americans to be able to participate in our wonderful democratic process we have in this country. As you see the ads

for candidates and listen to the information for the election, I am certain you have become aware of the new Ranked Choice Voting for the City of Las Cruces mayoral and council elections. The Chamber, along with the other Chambers, and other organizations are making it a priority to do our best to educate our community on Ranked Choice Voting. While it sounds complex, we hope to simplify it for our voters. Here is a quick synopsis as distributed by the Doña Ana County Clerk's office:

Ranked Choice Voting is also known as "Instant Runoff." Runoffs are verv ex-

selection. It's important to know that this Ranked Choice Voting ONLY applies to the City of Las Cruces mayoral and council elections. It does NOT

You will also notice your ballot has consolidated from



pensive, so deploying Ranked Choice Voting can save a lot of money. Few people show up to vote in Run Off elections, so the process also increases the number of voters who participate in the final other separate elections, i.e. Soil & Water, etc.

Example: When Las Cruces residents get their ballot, you will see candidates for mayor and councilors. There will be columns where you can rank each of these candidates from 1 to however many candidates are in that particular race.

1. Mark your first choice. If you would like to vote for more than one candidate, it is YOUR CHOICE, not a requirement. If you choose to rank other candidates, then you are participating in the Run-Off Election should after the initial round, no

candidate receives 50 percent plus 1. If you wish for a candidate not to be elected, DO NOT rank

them at all. 2. If no one has 50 percent plus 1 of the vote on the first ballot, the person with the least number of votes is eliminated. Their next choice is distributed to the other candidates. If someone then has 50 percent plus 1 of the vote, they are elected. If no one has 50 percent plus 1

of the vote, the person with the next least number of votes is eliminated and their next choice vote is distributed to the other candidates.
