Las Cruces receives high marks for yearly audit

The city of Las Cruces received high marks from a firm hired to audit its finances during a council meeting on Jan. 16.

The firm, Pattillo, Brown & Hill, L.L.P., said Las Cruces received its highest rating and lauded the city for a record-keeping award it earned.

PBH issued an unmodified or “clean” opinion, meaning auditors received everything they asked for and that information was all provided by the city’s

reporting framework.

“That, in essence, is the highest assurance an auditor can give. It’s exactly the type of report the city wants to receive. In essence, you can’t get a higher mark than an unmodified opinion,” said Chris Garner, a CPA with PBH who presented the information.

Garner also lauded Las Cruces for receiving a Government Finance Officers Association award. Las Cruces was one of four New Mexico municipalities to receive the honor.

“It’s not something that people will take the time or effort to do in the state of New Mexico for whatever reason,” Garner said, adding that the award helps improve the city’s bond rating, which helps reduce the cost of borrowing funds through bond issues.

Garner also said there

were no obstacles in accessing information, suggesting that Las Cruces did well at keeping financial records.

Two minor findings Garner brought up involved the South Central Solid Waste Authority (SCSWA), a jointly run city and county institution

responsible for recycling and solid waste disposal.

Garner said a contract was amended for fuel procurement that needed the city manager’s approval but never got it. The change should have also gone out for bid but never did, Garner said.

“It was an oversight, something that I think has been addressed and dealt with and cleaned up,” Garner said.

Second, Garner reported that city staff attempted to conduct an unscheduled count of petty cash (money in cash

registers, for example), a process called a surprise cash count, but were unable to complete it.

Garner said three findings in prior years were all dealt with.

“You’re going to have situations where you have findings,” Garner said, adding that the important thing is resolving them promptly. “You can see here that that is the culture that has happened over the last several years.”

Next, the audit will be submitted to the state auditor for approval.

'Thriving Together:' Las Cruces celebrates MLK Day

Martin Luther King Jr. is remembered differently by different people.

Some remember him for his assertion that nonviolent struggle was the righteous and effective path to justice. Others reflect on his remarks about those who put the status quo, however unjust, ahead of liberation. Still others see him as a symbol of equality, a great orator, a leader, or a timeless message of hope.

Many of those views, and the people that hold them, came together Sunday and Monday during a series of events in Las Cruces to celebrate, remember and reflect on what King's legacy means in 2024.

From speeches at the Roberto V. Estrada Pavilion to a hundred-person march to City Hall from Plaza de Las Cruces to a breakfast gathering at the Las Cruces Convention Center, hundreds of Las Cruces celebrated King on Jan. 14 and Jan. 15 as part of a yearly celebration.

"'Thriving together' was the theme," Bobbi Green, president of the Doña Ana County chapter of the NAACP, said.

And indeed, people from many walks of life assembled across the two days of events. Members of the public mingled and marched alongside influential people, including former mayor Ken Miyagishima and current Mayor Eric Enriquez, the Las Cruces police and fire chiefs, the district attorney, city councilors, county commissioners, state representatives, civil rights attorneys and more.

The events began Sunday at 2 p.m. with speeches at the downtown plaza.

Tommy Black, aka DJ Black, acted as master of ceremonies for the rally. He began by asking the younger members of the crowd to call on their elders for wisdom, especially in the face of renewed oppression.

"You look at the people with the wrinkled elbows. And what I want you to do is talk to them and get some wisdom. Because times are changing, if y'all haven't noticed. They're trying to take

Black history out of history books," Black said, referring to conservative censorship movements across the U.S. "The only way you're really going to learn it is to get with some of these elder people."

Black then called on Jeremy Story, the Las Cruces Police Department chief since December 2023, and Jamar Cotton, a Doña Ana County Sheriff's Office sergeant and vice president of the county NAACP.

"We're very diverse. But does that mean that we are all included? It

does not. So when we talk about diversity and inclusion, they're not the same thing. And too often we believe they are," Cotton said. "Inclusion is allowing everybody to have a voice. Diversity is what you see; inclusion is doing what we need to do."

Patrick Turner, associate vice president of student academic success at New Mexico State University, led the crowd in chants of "no justice, no peace," a slogan rooted in the aftermath of the 1986 racist beating and killing of 20-year-old Michael

Griffith in New York City.

Turner spoke of King's legacy as a defender of the downtrodden and the power inherent in everyone.

"We often think that these are these people who are way up here, but he (King) was just a person who realized that it was his role and civic duty to fight for those who could not fight for themselves," Turner said.

After about an hour of speeches, a group of students from the Martin

Luther King Jr. Youth Ambassador's program led the crowd on a march to City Hall.

Members of the crowd laughed and talked on the half-mile walk from the pavilion. Some walked with family. Others mingled with elected officials. The crowd gathered after the 15-minute walk for a final round of speeches led by Mayor Eric Enriquez and 3rd Judicial District Attorney Gerald Byers.

Byers brought the conversation back to the event's theme – thriving together – and added context about the origins of the project of American equality.

“So, from where are we thriving from? We're thriving from a time

of segregation. It's not just history. 1963 was the Birmingham church bombing when little kids were blown up in an act of domestic terrorism. We didn't think about it back then as domestic terrorism, but that's exactly what it was,” Byers said. “And that's something that we have to work hard to avoid nowadays.”

If you are like many people, you will open your natural gas bill and look straight to the total amount. The amount you owe may change month to month, and you may have a basic understanding that the more gas you use, the higher your bill will be. Chase Johnson, Customer Service Supervisor for the City of Las Cruces, is here to break down line-by-line what makes up the individual charges on your natural gas bill.

“I want our customers to understand what they are paying for,” Johnson explains. “I hope to clear up any misconceptions that people have and provide information about how Las Cruces Utilities (LCU) serves its customers.”

Natural gas is billed in dekatherms (Dkth), which is about one thousand cubic feet of natural gas. The more dekatherms used, the higher the Cost of Gas (COG) Charge will be. This charge is the

number of dekatherms used multiplied by the COG rate. This rate fluctuates depending on gas market conditions, similar to how gasoline prices fluctuate.

Another reason for the fluctuation in the Cost of Gas Charge is that customers are not charged for natural gas until they have used at least one dekatherm. If a customer uses less than this amount of natural gas, they will not be charged for this gas, with the exception of the monthly access fee, until the next month, or months, when they have reached this threshold.

To receive natural gas into your home or business, you must be connected to the city's natural gas pipeline. For residential customers, a static Access Fee of \$14.25 is applied to your monthly bill to connect you to the pipeline. A customer may wonder, if they do not use natural gas, why would they have to pay

this fee? This fee is vital to maintain the city's natural gas infrastructure.

Those residential customers using natural gas will also pay the Cost of Service Charge, a \$1.34/Dkth charge. This ensures that these pipelines are kept in ready condition, including regular line repair and maintenance, as well as getting the gas to your home.

The next charge is something all too familiar. Everyone knows that there are two things certain in life, and one of them is taxes. Each customer pays natural gas taxes to both the City and

the state. Just like when purchasing items in a store, the higher your gas charges are each month, the higher your taxes will be, as well.

The last charge is the Gas Decarbonization Rider. At \$0.15/Dkth, this is a fee that the City charges to create and manage a transition to a more energy-efficient community as a part of the City's Elevate Las Cruces plan.

LCU is an enterprise fund, which means it functions as a non-profit entity and is only funded through the rates it collects from its customers. These rates enable LCU to keep up with the latest improvements to the natural gas industry.

“The City of Las Cruces is forward-thinking,” says Johnson. “We have a vested interest in continuous improvements to our natural gas system to better serve our customers.”

Iowa caucuses called too early

“Big news” spent the past year assuring us Donald Trump had the Republican nomination in the bag. Then, on the night of the first nomination contest, news outlets raced to be the first to declare him the winner, so much so that Iowa Republicans got news alerts on their phones before they had voted. Was this detrimental to the process?

While it is a standard practice to refrain from calling an election while primaries are underway,

caucuses, like Iowa's, are treated differently. Caucuses require party members to be at the precinct location at a certain hour and participate in a closed-door meeting with speeches by representatives of the different campaigns ahead of voting by secret ballot.

Once the doors shut on the meeting, the Associated Press considers the

polls to have closed. With the earliest results showing a commanding lead for Trump matching AP's voter survey data, it called Iowa's caucuses for Trump within half an hour. As AP goes, other outlets follow.

Is this an ethical problem or not? The case for no is that those voters, despite inclement weather, showed up to their caucuses determined

to vote and presumably did so. There was also no suspense about the winner: Trump took 51 percent of the total votes and claimed 20 of the state's 40 delegates to the GOP national convention. The suspense was over who would claim second place.

The case for yes is that the selection process was still underway when participants were receiving messages from outside the room, by impatient news organizations. The influence of that activity on

voter behavior is unpredictable and if the process of voting deserves respect, plain common sense indicates “big news” should wait.

Data is often predictive, but the ability to predict an outcome before voters have even completed their participation, as I've been arguing all year, does not mean we should.

The pressure to be first is not more important than letting voters participate meaningfully in the selection of their leaders.

Good, if belated, start for city inspector general

The delay in filling the position of inspector general suggested city officials weren't serious about keeping promises made in 2018 following audits that revealed allegations of bid-rigging and the mishandling of public funds by organizers of the now-defunct Country Music Festival.

The person they eventually picked to fill the position proves they are serious.

Charles Tucker has exactly the kind of experience needed to create a new position that will provide the kind of oversight councilors envisioned and the public demanded after the music festival scandal.

Inspectors general are the unsung heroes of government. They may get paid by the state, but they work for the people. And they are often the only ones in government with

both the independence and authority to tell leaders when they have gone astray.

And so, it's no surprise that our last president was not a fan. Donald Trump fired the IGs for Intelligence (Michael Atkinson, who was investigating Trump's dealings with Ukraine); Transportation (Mitch Behm, who was investigating conflict-of-interest allegations against then-Secretary Elaine Chao); Defense (Glenn Fine, who had been picked to lead the Pandemic Response Accountability Committee); Health and Human Services (Christi Grimm, who reported on shortages and testing delays at the start of the pandemic); and State (Steve Linick, who was

looking into allegations that then-Secretary Mike Pompeo misused staff time for his personal benefit).

Trump supporters loathed inspectors general then. Now, they eagerly await any reports that can help feed their narrative of the “Biden crime family.”

Just like the federal IG system, which was created after the Watergate break-in, the city position was also born from scandal.

An investigation by the state auditor found that more than \$1.8 million in public funds had been mismanaged by both city officials and the volunteer group that was organizing the annual music festival. It and other investigations alleged bid-rigging, wage

theft from city employees who worked unpaid overtime and a concerted effort at the top levels of city government to hide what had been done.

An audit by the McHard Firm found, “there is probable cause to believe that criminal violations have occurred,” but nobody was ever prosecuted. Two employees were fired and former City Manager Stuart Ed was not far behind them. The festival was discontinued.

It was under those conditions that the new inspector general position was created. The delay in filling the position means that particular mess has been cleaned up. But the conditions that allowed for it to happen likely have not.

Tucker comes to the job with the experience necessary to make up for lost time. He started in the

Army, first at Fort Knox, where he helped secure the estimated 147.3 million ounces of gold stored there, and later at White Sands Missile Range. He comes into the job with 22 years as an inspector general in both the public and private sectors.

While Tucker has the authority to investigate complaints, his most important work may be in establishing protocols and safeguards that prevent waste and fraud from slipping through the cracks.

If given the independence needed to do his job correctly, Tucker has the opportunity to create a new position that will continue to serve the residents of Las Cruces after he's gone.

Dear editor,

When people relocate to a new city, most consider the availability of a good medical support system. Pet owners also want to ensure the availability of excellent veterinary services. Las Cruces has been without emergency veterinary services since 2018, when the Animal Hospital and Emergency Center on Wyatt Drive closed, forcing residents with sick or injured pets to travel to El Paso for this much needed service.

Animal Companions of Las Cruces, an all-volunteer organization, was formed to address this untenable situation and is working diligently on many fronts to bring back emergency animal care to Las Cruces. We are:

• Recruiting veterinar-

ians for Las Cruces by participating in AVMA conventions and vet school job fairs nationwide.

- Building up a scholarship fund to assist veterinarians with paying down their student debt in exchange for a two-year commitment to work in the region.

- Advocating at the city, county, and state level for resolutions, ordinances and legislation to ease the current crisis.

Dr. Dawn Duncan, Founder/Chair of ACoFLC, worked with Rep. Joanne Ferrary on House Bill 452 in 2023, to eliminate non-compete agreements. She spoke as an expert witness to end this detrimental practice. Dr. Duncan supported HB 384, which became law last year, providing for expedited licensure of veterinarians licensed in

other states. Dr. Duncan has also presented to the Las Cruces City Council, the Mesilla Board of Trustees and the Doña Ana County Commissioners about the serious lack of animal services.

Based on this promise, we doubled our investment in our infrastructure during the past three years. Looking forward, we will focus on the following five key strategic themes.

MODERNIZING INFRASTRUCTURE FOR A SMART COMMUNITY

One key to meeting the demands of a modern technological-based world is the transformation into a smart energy community both to keep pace with the rapid advancements in the energy sector and to provide our customers with greater energy options. For instance, smart meter installations give our customers the power to track their energy use in real time, reduce their energy consumption and help reduce the peak load on our grid that drives prices upward. A smart grid also allows for our customers to choose power when it is at its most sustainable—something our customers care deeply about. Overall, a smart grid is the key to unlocking greater reliability, affordability and sustainability in the energy space and the key to opening the door to a smart city that attracts and keeps businesses and talent.

POWERING RELIABILITY FOR CUSTOMER GROWTH

One of our primary objectives for 2024 is to continue to enhance the reliability of our energy infrastructure to meet the increasing demands of our growing customer base. To ensure that our customers continue to receive the uninterrupted and dependable power supply they have come to expect, we brought 228 megawatts (MW) of needed dispatchable energy online, constructed new substations, upgraded several transmission structures from wood to steel and rebuilt 86 miles of transmission lines, among other improvements.

We are working hard with our developers to make sure we are providing connections as early as possible as we work through supply chain issues, such as the delays we’ve experienced with obtaining transformers. At the same time, we are working with our Chambers of Commerce and other business development organizations to attract and grow our region.

Reliability is at the core of our commitment to customer satisfaction, and these efforts are a crucial step towards achieving that goal.

EXPANDING CLEANER GENERATION RESOURCES

As our region continues to grow, we are facing the challenge of meeting that growth with cleaner, local generation resources. Last year, we added more than 400MW of cleaner generation resources and 50MW of storage—the first large-scale storage and the most generation we have added in any one year. We are particularly proud that we were able to embed greater renewable resources and begin the process of offering more community solar.

We know that larger-scale solar, like community solar, is more efficient and also meets our energy equity goal by allowing a larger range of our customers to participate in the solar sector. While we still need to add more storage to make any solar program more effective, we

know that community solar programs serve an important role as we wait for technology to provide a longer-range solution to meet our goal of carbon neutrality by 2045.

Importantly, last year we contracted for the construction of 150MW more of solar resources and planned for many more in the years to come. We are just getting started.

Science lectures paired with films

The idea of science embedded in movies is not new, and when the board of the Mesilla Valley Film Society (MVFS) noticed an available grant pairing science-related movies with real scientists, the board members were intrigued.

Board member Joel Segal took on the writing of the grant and, falling in love with the concept of pairing film and reason, was able to get the funds to bring a series to the Fountain Theatre working with some of the top scientists in the area.

“The concept of the Science on Screen grant pairs movies that have scientific subject with a very knowledgeable speaker to speak to some theme with the movie,” Segal said. “The speaker can take it a lot of places. This year we have a Ph.D. in math, a Ph.D. astronomer and a woman who is an advocate for science education for women.”

In addition to the films and the speakers MVFS, with help from the grant from the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation and the Coolidge Corner Theatre, can also offer free attendance for up to 20 students. Segal said students who wish to get in free can ask for their tickets at the door.

The “Science on Screen” film series takes place one Sunday night per month for each of three months, pairing a film with an expert-led discussions of a scientific topic.

“We mostly looked for speakers with a strength and then looked for the movies,” Segal said.

The movies include Darren Aronofsky’s first feature film, “Pi,” which screened alongside a lecture by NMSU mathematics professor David Finston on Jan. 14. Next comes “The Martian,” with astronomer William Stein on Sunday, Feb. 11; and “CODE: Debugging the Gender Gap” with computer science teacher

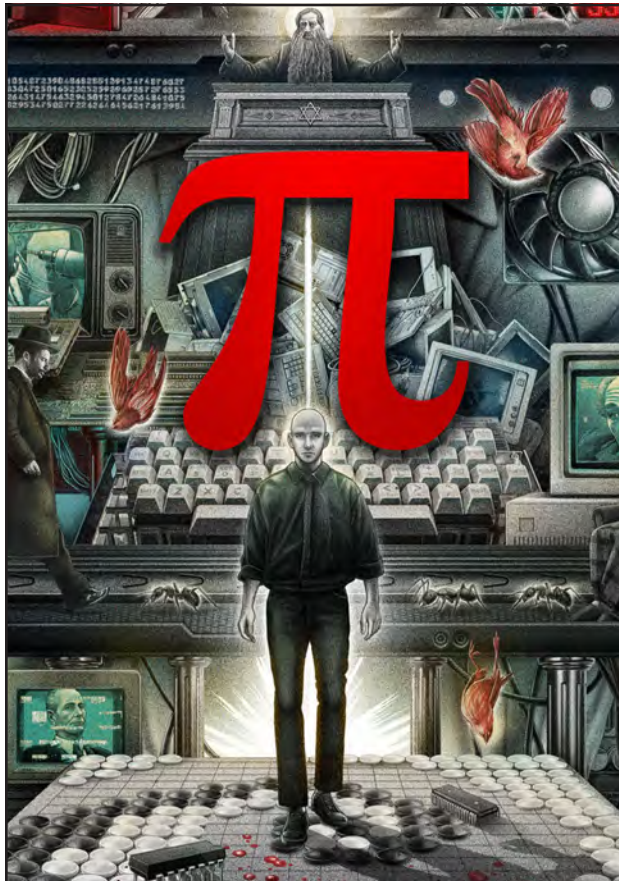

Melody Hagaman on Sunday, March 10.

The “Pi” lecture dem-

onstrated the series’ potential. The film is a psychological thriller that

presents viewers with abstract and cerebral themes. It serves as a precursor to Aronofsky’s later works, such as “Requiem for a Dream,” “The Fountain” and “Black Swan.” It was released in 1998 and marked Aronofsky’s feature film directorial debut. The film is known for its unique style, intense atmosphere and thought-provoking narrative. “Pi” incorporates mathematical and numerical symbolism throughout the narrative, with the number pi (π) itself as a central element. The film also touches on concepts from chaos theory, Kabbalah and mysticism.

Finston, holding a Ph.D. in mathematics and a professor emeritus from NMSU, spoke on Fibonacci numbers, the Golden Ratio and other irrational numbers. Finston has been teaching a liberal arts mathematics course for many years and is nearly done with a textbook for such a course.

The Coolidge/Sloan Foundation nationwide Science on Screen partnership, in a news release, says its mission is “to inspire in theatergoers an increased appreciation for science, technology, engineering and mathematics as compelling enterprises and vital elements of a broad understanding of human culture and current events.” The Mesilla Valley Film Society is one of 12 first-time 2023–24 Science on Screen grantees.

“These events, which pair expert speakers in 40+ states, demonstrate that science can illuminate films, just as films can illuminate science,” Segal said.

Segal joined the MVFS board responding to a call for volunteers at a time the society was struggling to keep the doors open, since then he has been helping with the financial end of the non-profit.

“I think the Fountain Theatre is a treasure and I wouldn’t want to see it go away,” he said.

Q: I saw that the documentary about the 40th anniversary of "Thriller" had a lot of footage of Michael Jackson recording other songs as well for that album. How was that material acquired?

A: As one of music's ultimate superstars at the time, Jackson clearly was worth following for the filmmakers who decided to capture every element of the process that they could, leading to much footage that hadn't been seen before director Nelson George incorporated it into the project. Among the highly notable portions of the program is Paul McCartney's in-studio participation in "The Girl Is Mine," which Jackson wrote, and which was the first single released from "Thriller." Of course, there was plenty of detail on the title tune, which yielded one of the most popular music videos ever. John Landis directed it as a mini-movie at Jackson's behest, since the singer had appreciated the filmmaker's work on "An American Werewolf in London" ... which the style of the "Thriller" video emulates.

As much archival footage as there is in "Thriller 40" — which became available on both Showtime and Paramount+ at the start of December — director Nelson George also included contemporary interviews with such personalities as Landis, Usher, Mary J. Blige, Will.I.Am, Misty Copeland and Mark Ronson. As hard as it might be to conceive that some of today's younger generation might not know who Michael Jackson was, such comments help to contextualize what a major piece of pop culture "Thriller" (the top-selling album of all time globally) was and is.

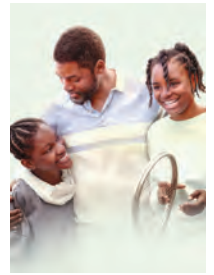

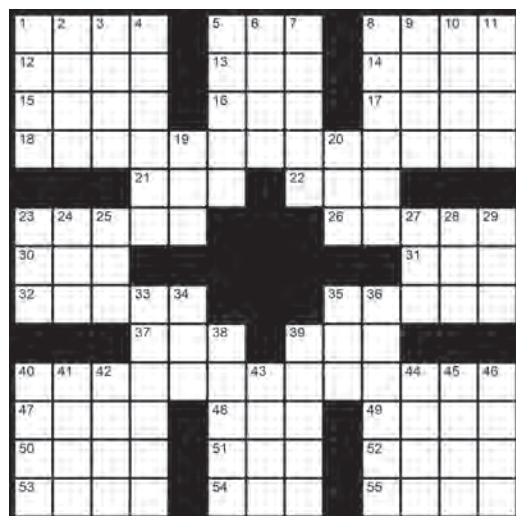

One of Arnold Schwarzenegger's most accessible-for-all-ages makes its 4K Ultra HD debut, as the 1990 action-comedy casts him as an undercover police detective who poses as a schoolteacher to track a murderer (Richard Tyson). Directed by Ivan Reitman, the picture has its tougher moments, but it also has lots of humor as Schwarzenegger's character proves to be a fish out of water in dealing with youngsters in the classroom. (Among the kids is Odette Yustman, who grew up to be the actress currently known as Odette Annable.) Pamela Reed is enjoyable as the cop's sarcastic partner, Penelope Ann Miller is a fellow teacher and romantic interest, and Linda Hunt plays the school principal. Spontaneous compulsion: Improv troupe prepares

What do you think of when you hear the word improv? Chances are, you don't think of it as spontaneous ensemble theatre, but that's exactly what it is – a group of dedicated performers working together to improvise stories on the spot. It's freeform theatre at its most exhilarating, based entirely on audience suggestions.

At its best, improv can be fast-paced, unpredictable and highly entertaining. At its worst, it can be amateurish, clunky and dull. Luckily for those of us living in Las Cruces and the surrounding areas, the Super Secret Improv Troupe falls into the former category, made up as it is of seasoned actors who regularly tread the boards of local theatre.

Who are these players?

Erin Wendorf was part of the highly acclaimed courtroom drama "The Trial of Billy the Kid," directed by Ross Marks, among many other local productions. Both Joshua Taulbee and Rachel Thomas-Chappell had featured roles in the No Strings Theatre Company's latest production, "Ben Hur." Taulbee also received rave reviews for his powerful performance in the one-man show, "Fully Committed," in May of 2023. Casi Galban gave her own riveting performance in the one-woman "Gun Show" in 2022. Both Thomas-Chappell and Galban had pivotal roles in Taulbee's directorial effort, "Murder by Poe," in October of 2023.

Founded in February 2000, just a month before the pandemic lockdown, the ensemble's first year was spent in Zoom meetings and occasional

in-person workshops, in which the members had to wear masks and keep an appropri-

ate distance from one another. Not the most auspicious beginning for a fledgling troupe, but

perseverance and a focus on expression forged what would become a core group of passionate performers, dedicated to the craft.

That dedication comes from adherence to a set of basic rules, including trust, and listening carefully to what your partners are creating.

"Trust is so important," says Thomas-Chappell. "Being on stage with somebody and knowing that they're going to make me look good. As long as we're looking out for each other on stage, our characters are going to be on point, and the story is going to be there."

"It allows us to go to some very weird places," Taulbee admits. "We can go deep, because we know that everybody else is going to go along with it, not mock it or bury it."

New dinosaur named, found 30 years ago near Elephant Butte

In front of a gaggle of school children and various officials, paleontologists gathered Thursday, Jan. 11 to unveil a dinosaur jawbone discovered almost 30 years ago.

"They found a big toothy thing," Dr. Anthony Fiorillo, executive director of The New Mexico Museum of Natural History & Science (NMMNHS) said during the event, held in Santa Fe and shared remotely.

When the fossils (several pieces of a skull) were found on the east side of Elephant Butte Reservoir in 1983 by members of the Rio Grande Sailing Club out of Las Cruces, it was thought to be part of a *Tyrannosaurus rex*.

In 2013, when then-student Sebastian Dalman began a restudy of a found horned dinosaur, it forced a broader rethink of the dinosaurs from western New Mexico.

"I started working on this project with co-author Steve Jasinski and soon we started to suspect we were on to something new," Dalman said.

Dahlman said as he was looking at the bones back in 2013, he noticed some significant differences between the find and *T. rex*. He confirmed it was a new species and invited the others to join in the work.

A team of scientists from New Mexico; Pennsylvania; Washington DC; Utah; Ontario, Canada; and Bath, United Kingdom was assembled to study the animal, going

through the skeleton bone by bone. In each case, they found subtle differences between the specimen and the dozens of *T. rex* skeletons that had been found before. Because *T. rex* is so well-known, it became possible to show the New Mexico tyrannosaur was something new.

Now that team has published their study (in the journal *Scientific Reports*) recognizing a new subspecies, *Tyrannosaurus mcraeensis*. The predator is older and more primitive than its better-known cousin, but just as large, up to 40 feet long and 12 feet high.

Fiorillo said the research is indebted to the first wave of people who excavated the bones.

"This is a discovery decades in the making," he

said. "At that time, the fossil record of tyrannosaur was not so robust as it is today."

He said science is a process and continuously forces people to go back and test and challenge what is known.

"To me, this discovery underscores the value, the reason this museum holds such large collections," he said. "We have the largest

paleontological collections in the entire southwestern United States. What you see on the display is just the tip of the iceberg.

"We are here to foster the spirit of curiosity that encourages scientific inquiry from a very early age."

Joining the press conference on Zoom from the United Kingdom, Dr. Nick Longrich, a co-author from the Milner Centre for Evolution at the University of Bath talked about the differences between the new species and the known *T. rex*.

“That’s why we can tell a heartwarming story about a poodle who joins the circus and falls in love,” Galban adds.

It’s this easy repartee that gives the troupe its dynamics. It also guarantees that every show is different from the last. Each starts off with a few fun exercises to get the juices flowing, with names like “Copycat,” “Movie Pitch” and “Letter of Complaint.” These tend to be short and funny, based on themes

suggested by audience members, some of which can be pretty strange.

“The weirder the better,” Taulbee admits.

The fun really begins once the troupe rolls into their longform segment, in which the audience is asked for a word that is then used to create a story.

“The aim is always the story,” says Wendorf. “They’re usually weird stories, but they have storylines and characters that the audience can follow. In the end, we really want to have them go ‘wow, that was unexpected.’”

“It’s like creating a one-act play, with a beginning, a middle and an end,” adds Thomas-Chappell.

“It may not be a great story arc, but we do try to have character growth, high points, low points, and a resolution,” Taulbee agrees. “We do try to tell a complete story.”

So what’s the secret to success in the improv world? “We’ve never repeated a story,” says Wendorf. “All of our scenarios are completely different from anything we’ve done before. They’re individual to each show because the word

is always different. We never know what kind of show we’re going to have. It really all depends on the audience.”

“The nice thing is,” Thomas-Chappell adds, “we’ve never had a bad show.”

The Super Secret Improv Show returns to the Black Box Theatre on Saturday, January 20. Doors open at 7pm, and the performance starts at 7:30 p.m. More information is available online at Facebook.com/SuperSecretImprov, or on Instagram @TheSuperSecretImprovShow.

America's Best Restaurants to feature La Posta

La Posta de Mesilla is approaching its 85th anniversary of operations, with plans underway to celebrate the occasion in September; but first, the restaurant is to be featured on an episode of the America's Best Restaurant Roadshow.

ABR showcases selected restaurants across the country, conducting interviews with owners and filming on location to present popular dishes and the unique settings presented at the eateries. The company said it will film at La Posta on Friday morning, Jan. 26, for broadcast at a later date.

The show will feature interviews with owners Jerean and Tom Hutchinson. Jerean Hutchinson's great aunt, Katy Griggs Camuñez, opened the restaurant in 1939 and devised some of its unique dishes, including its tostada compuesta.

The Hutchinsons have operated the restaurant since 1996.

On its website, ABR said restaurants may be nominated by customers or restaurants can nominate themselves. In an interview, Tom Hutchinson said he and Jerean were surprised when ABR contacted them, saying they were intrigued by the restaurant's long history in Mesilla and its cuisine.

"It sounds like a pretty neat opportunity to tell our story," he said. "We get so many visitors from out of town and from all over the country, you never know how they hear about you."

Of the three dishes to be showcased on the program, Hutchinson said two would consist of La Posta's pancake-style red enchilada with egg on top — "You don't see that in New York or California!" he remarked — and the compuesta, consisting of a corn tortilla cup with red or green chile, meat and frijoles with slaw or garnish. The third

menu item to be featured was still under discussion.

He added that the ABR team will sample La Posta's gourmet sauces, rubs and salsas.

"Mexican food, by its nature, is very colorful," he said. "You're pleasing the eye even before you take the first bite." Along with the food and its large se-

lection of tequila, La Posta comes with a story. The kernel of its adobe building was constructed in the 1840s and later housed the Corn Exchange Hotel. The site is included in the National Register of Historic Places. The building now includes shops as well as multiple dining rooms, a courtyard, cantina and novelties such as a piranha tank and a large cage for exotic birds.

In 2021, the restaurant was among 25 restaurants deemed culturally significant and awarded grant funds by American Express and the National Trust for Historic Preservation for building improvements, a measure intended to give the awardees a boost after COVID-19-pandemic restrictions hit the industry hard in 2020 and 2021.

An announcement as to when the episode will air will be posted on ABR's Facebook page as well as its website, where a page for La Posta has already been established.

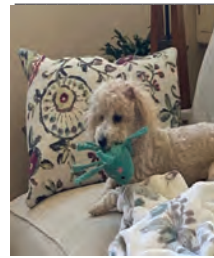

OM Knights: 'Watch out for us'

Organ Mountain High School Boys Basketball has been a monster of a team during the first half of the prep basketball season – only recording one loss and grabbing 12 wins. The Knights have their eyes on a 5A District 3 championship trophy, but they also have bigger goals.

Organ Mountain currently has a 11-game winning streak, their last loss back in early December. Volcano Vista (15-1), another top team in the state, defeated the Knights 63-43 early in the season.

Since then, the Knights have been firing on all cylinders with seniors Brandon Kehres and YehNhi Wilson leading the way. Kehres averages 15.4 points per game and is the team's top scorer while also pulling down 6.9 rebounds a game.

"I'm a very traditional player, go down low post up, get a bucket from there, if need be go out and hit the three or attack," Kehres said about his type of game.

Wilson has a hot hand as well, averaging 11.2 points a game and leading the way in assists with 3.2 per game.

Both Kehres and Wilson said that these wins don't just come down to their individual performances. They credited their teammates and bench players for the Knight's early success.

"They help us a lot, they're very young, they have talent," Wilson said

about his teammates. "We have Ethan (Coomes) coming off the bench as our guard, good defender. We have Pat (Delahousaye), good slasher and rebounder. Ray (Venegas), very long, just like me – and the rest of them, they know how to hoop."

Junior guard Ethan Coomes has a field goal percentage of nearly 60 percent, being the most effective shooter for the knights, while he averages 6.7 points per game, which is the fourth best on the team.

With two non-district games left, the district season is coming up fast for Organ Mountain. The Knights are the clear favorites to claim the district championship, but head coach Rocky Gonzales and his team are not going to take anyone lightly.

"Coaching-wise, if the coaching staff doesn't come ready for every game, I feel anyone in the district can beat us," Gonzales said.

Specifically, Gonzales said that Las Cruces High (6-6), Alamogordo (10-5) and Centennial (6-7) have caught his eye so far. He said Cruces is a very young

team but the way they play, they pose a threat to upset anybody. The Tigers from Alamogordo are a senior-led team, with six seniors on the roster – the only team in the district to beat the Knights last year. In regard to the Hawks, Gonzales said they have a good combination of veteran guards and some younger playmakers who can shoot the three lights out on any given night.

The Knights know they can't look past anybody in the district, but they have their sights set on greater horizons. Last year they came up short against Volcano Vista in the NMAA State Semi-Finals, losing that game by a score of 48-46.

"Last year, I wouldn't even want to talk about a state championship. We got to win district first," Gonzales said. "This year we kind of solidified ourselves as one of the teams to win the district. But last year we kind of made an impression on not just the district, but the rest of the state as far as what we got coming back and we put people on notice as far as, 'Hey, you're going to have to watch out for us.'"

Ways to truly grow the game of golf

In a few days, I'm off to Orlando for my 25th PGA Merchandise Show, often termed "The Major of the Golf Industry." Virtually every year, speakers try to rally the troops to "grow the game." The phrase tends to be thrown around loosely.

Golf is an awesome game and a delightful, albeit perplexing, pastime enjoyed by tens of millions of enthusiasts. But as Bob Dylan sang, "the times they are a-changin'." Golf is no longer a game just for paunchy 50-year-old businessmen who spend six hours on Saturday at the country club for 18 holes and cocktails. Growing the game is about golf as a game, not neces-

sarily growing the golf industry, which is about money. If the game does well, the industry should do well.

The future growth of golf will come from the children of today. Golf courses, including munis, public daily fee venues, resorts and private clubs are encouraged to provide free or nearly free golf green fees for junior golfers up through age 12, and low-cost rounds (\$10) for ages 13 through 17. Next, we need to pump up middle school and high school sports, starting with golf. PGA Jr. golf leagues

around the country, including locally at Red Hawk Golf Club, have provided a much-needed opportunity for kids.

There are certainly summer golf camps for kids, but it's not enough. Millennials, as a generation, have not flocked to golf courses. Perhaps golf is too slow and too boring for them. There is plenty of technology in golf today, but maybe not enough for the millennials. Plus, it's too hard!

Golf as a business and an industry needs to embrace tradition while proceeding with change. That means making

golf more accessible for everyone. The secret to growth is accessibility in the form of diversity and inclusion. Golf has a sorry history in terms of diversity; there is much to be done. Then there's the "green lobby," who wants to shut down golf courses everywhere in favor of "open spaces" for whatever. The city of Minneapolis planned to close the Hiawatha Golf Course due to "flooding," where the only Black golf league had been playing since the 1950's. They compromised on ploughing up nine holes. Additionally, more golf courses are closing than are opening due to the fact that developers make far more money on sub-

divisions and business parks than they do on golf. In the west, water is a much greater issue than chemicals, and the fight will last forever.

There are other things that need to be done to grow the game. Start by reducing cart fees by 50 percent for senior golfers over 70. Somebody has to bridle the USGA and its antigrowth policies to avoid the rollback on the golf ball for recreational players. In terms of golf courses, more par 3 layouts would be a boon. Promotion of 6, 9 and 12 hole "rounds" would bring more players out who are on tight schedules. If I had to choose between less stringent rules, policies, dress and

etiquette or more (well-behaved) golfers, I would choose the latter. If I were speaking to an auditorium full of golf course owners, I would tell them that their courses need to adopt resort-type strategies and mindset, where guests expect and should be treated to a superior golfing experience that they will remember. And that partly depends on golfer ambassadors (i.e. marshals) who have the authority to maintain the paces of play.

I am proud to say that our four championship golf courses in Las Cruces have done a splendid job in providing accessibility to everyone in the community and visitors alike.
