Consistency is key

Recently, I ran across a saying from John Maxwell: "Consistency ... It doesn't matter how talented you are. It doesn't matter how many opportunities you receive. If vou want to grow, consistency is key." This little saying got me thinking just what consistency is and how it applies to business, and in particular to leadership.

• Customer Service – This area can literally make or break a business. Being consistent in the training of employees, particularly the "director of first impressions," or your front-line person is a critical part of consistency. The



Are they treating one another with the same positive. friendly attitude they show your customers? If the answer is not "Yes," then consistency in training has wavered.

• Accountability – Measuring your changes as you implement new processes, products or systems will ensure reliable results. A key element of anything new is to educate, educate, educate -employees and customers alike. If the education and planning are in place, then the consistency of doing this several times will ensure continual forward movement.

Consistency can also be a key to leadership success and thus growth of a business. We all have different definitions of a leader, along with a multitude of reasons for following a leader. 


