Businesses for a Safer Las Cruces

As many of you are aware, recently a group, Businesses for a Safer Las Cruces, was created and consists of concerned business owners coming together to work with the Las Cruces Police Department to improve the safety of our community. The Greater Las Cruces Chamber of Commerce is in full support of this group and is asking businesses in Las Cruces to take a few steps to help improve the safety in our city.

ASK #1: A "We Have Your 6" pro-

gram has been started, a program designed for Las Cruces area businesses to support our local officers. We ask all businesses to place a "We Have Your 6" sticker in their business window. These stickers have been designed by Chad Getz and Vic Villalobos and are printed and sponsored by Getz Funeral Home and Sisbarro Auto Dealerships. The stickers can be picked up at the Greater Las Cruces Chamber of Commerce building at 150 E. Lohman Avenue in Las Cruces. If you are unable to come to the Chamber to pick up a sticker, we will gladly have someone bring one to your business.

ASK #2: If your business is willing and able, please add a police officer benefit program, customized to your business. Ideas include designated parking, fee discount to officers and their immediate families, etc. By customizing it to your business, you can do as little or much as you choose. To sign up for this program, please call us at the Chamber (575-524-1968). Your business will be added to a list given to officers. Each officer will receive a "We Have Your 6" card which they will be able to provide you and your staff to prove they are a part of the LCPD's family of officers.

ASK #3: We're asking all businesses to place "No Soliciting" signs in front of their businesses or business complexes. LCPD has informed us that "No Trespassing" signs are not adequate. If "No Soliciting" signs are placed, officers can come on your property and make anyone, homeless included, that are trying to convince your customers to give them money to leave the premises. Like any other ordinance, this is something that cannot be done unless the guidelines are followed.

Specifications for the signs: Signs must be 12" x 18" and have one visible from the road and another visible in the parking lot from the building. Signs should include a statement at the bottom of the sign that states "unless permit granted." With this phrase, groups such as Girl Scouts or Scouts (formally Boy Scouts) can set up stands in front of your business to sell their fundraisers. You would have them fill out a simple form with their information so that if there is a complaint that you were being discriminative, you can provide proof that they had a permit to be there soliciting.

Chief Story and the Las Cruces Police Department are listening to businesses and are willing to work with us at the Greater Las Cruces Chamber of Commerce as well as the Businesses for a Safer Las Cruces group to improve the safety of our community. These may seem like small steps, but they are steps in the right direction. We will continue to take necessary steps to improve the safety of our community.
