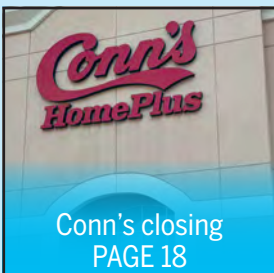

Beer Fest returns to plaza

The Las Cruces beer festival, the annual beer sampling festival and outdoor party, will be held once again at Plaza de Las Cruces downtown.

Although one must be at least 21 years old to sample beer, the event will have attractions and activities for all ages, according to a news release.

From 6 p.m. to 11:30 p.m., according to Facebook and EventBrite announcements online, ticket holders will be welcome to roam the plaza and explore food trucks, lawn games and other activities, peruse a marketplace with independent vendors and enjoy live music.

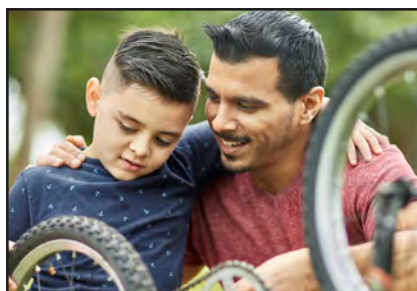
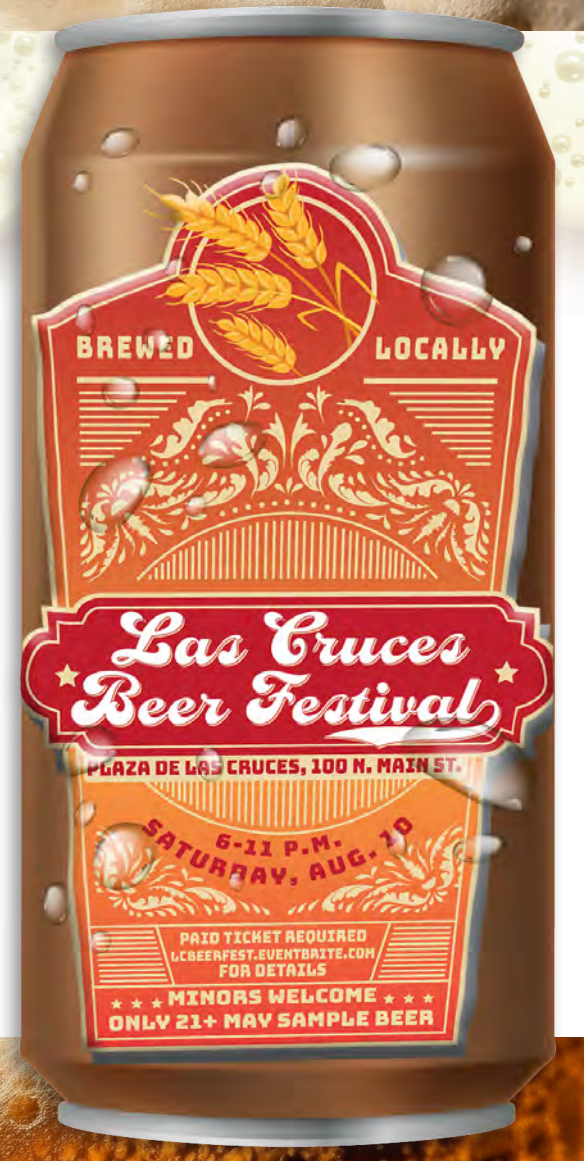
Organizers said more than 100 selections of local, regional and craft beer will be on hand for tasting. Rad Retrocade hosts the main bar as well as beer sampling, organizers said.

Although tickets will be available at the gate, organizers recommended purchasing tickets in advance online, as day-of tickets will be available as capacity permits. Admission fees ranged from \$20 for minors to \$45 or \$80 for different packages and perks. Children under 12 will be admitted for free accompanied by parents or legal guardians. Ticketing information is available online at LCBeerFest.Eventbrite.com.

Organizers said local food vendors will compete for “Bites and Brews” awards, while entertainment will be provided by DJs. The Yarbrough Band is also slated to play live country music.

Plaza de Las Cruces is located at 100 N. Main St. downtown.

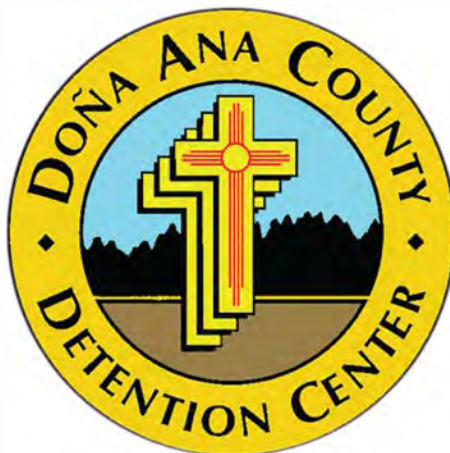

City council narrowly passes shopping cart, panhandling restrictions

The Las Cruces City Council voted 4-3 in favor of two controversial public safety bills during a six-and-a-half-hour meeting on Aug. 5.

The bills allow Las Cruces police to enforce prohibitions on solicitation on private property, prohibit some solicitation on medians and create a new law banning shopping carts outside shopping centers.

The new law also places increased restrictions on businesses to take better care of their shopping carts at risk of jeopardizing their business licenses.

Mayor Eric Enriquez was joined by councilors Bill Mattiace, Becki Graham and Cassie McClure in approving the measures. Councilors Becky Corran and Yvonne Flores joined Mayor Pro Tem Johana Bencomo in opposition.

Before and during the vote, opponents of the changes decried them as inhumane and ineffective even as the police chief Jeremy Story said the new laws would help his officers prevent crime.

“Our officers know people on the street by name – all of them – because we are the ones left to deal with them over and over,” Story said.

But Story’s enthusiasm for the proposals was matched by hesitation and condemnation from civil rights organizations

and local officials responsible for indigent services in Las Cruces.

“We’re targeting people with the least amount of power,” said Nicole Martinez, executive director of Community of Hope.

Those who opposed the bills also pointed to a lack of affordable housing and access to resources as the critical drivers for the increased presence of unhoused residents.

The first bill, Council Bill 25-007, also known as the solicitation bill, makes solicitation or loitering on or near a median illegal, punishable by a fine of up to \$500 or 90 days in jail.

A judge could order community service or mandate mental health or substance abuse treatment. Those services are currently very limited in Las Cruces, although the city has suggested they plan to expand them.

The bill also clarified the language in the city’s existing solicitation ordinance, which had become unconstitutional and unenforceable.

The solicitation bill presents itself as a traffic safety ordinance, its preamble stating that pedestrian fatalities in the city increased 150 percent from 2020 to 2023 and that New Mexico has led the country in pedestrian deaths per capita for seven years. But a Bulletin inquiry about how many of those deaths were related to solicitation in the median – more commonly called panhandling – resulted in the police department failing to provide an example.

Public records such as news releases and news articles indicate that none of the pedestrian killed by cars in recent years were panhandling at the time of their deaths.

The second bill, Council Bill 25-008, also known as the shopping cart bill, would create a new sec-

tion of municipal code addressing businesses that use shopping carts and people who use them outside of a business.

Businesses would be required to prevent shopping carts from leaving their property by affixing restraints to them and securing them outside of business hours. They would also be required to document plans to prevent shopping cart removal. Non-compliance would result in fines and potentially jeopardize the

business’ ability to operate in Las Cruces.

The shopping cart bill also penalizes people caught with a shopping cart outside a business. A conviction would be a petty misdemeanor carrying a potential jail term of up to six months and a fine of up to \$500. However, a judge could choose to sentence the person to community service, substance abuse counseling, or mental health treatment.

LCPD has said it would begin implementation with a “non-enforcement” period during which officers would approach shopping cart users and tell them they need to find an alternative.

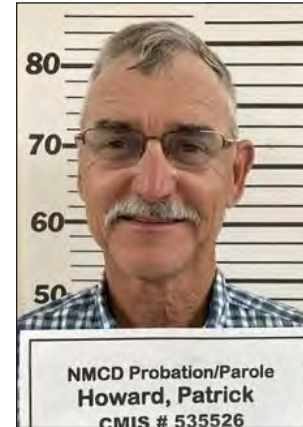

Patrick Howard's hearing rescheduled

A hearing to reassess the sentencing of a Las Cruces teacher convicted of sexually abusing a student was rescheduled after the District Attorney's office failed to notify the women who experienced the abuse.

Court records show the hearing to reconsider Patrick Howard's shortened probation was rescheduled from Aug. 1 to Sept. 5 because "the State did not contact the victims in this case to provide them notice of the Aug. 1, 2024, hearing until Jul. 31, 2024," a motion requesting the new hearing date stated.

"Not all victims are able

to attend the hearing, but all have expressed that they wish to appear after proper notice," the motion, written by Assistant District Attorney Richard Wellborn, said.

Howard, a 61-year-old former agricultural sciences teacher and Future Farmers of America advisor at Las Cruces High School, will return to court on Sept. 5 after the New Mexico Supreme Court said the judge should reconsider Howard's suspended probation.

Justices took up the

case after the New Mexico Attorney General filed a petition requesting the court to reconsider the suspended probation and remove the case from the 3rd Judicial District Court. The Supreme Court did force the judge, Douglas Driggers, to reconsider his previous probation suspension but did not take the case from him as the AG requested.

Howard was charged with three counts of criminal sexual contact with a minor and one count of battery. He pleaded guilty in 2021 to one count of criminal sexual contact with a minor and a count of battery. The charges stemmed from incidents between Howard and his students during his tenure at LCHS.

Driggers sentenced him to five years of probation but did not require him to formally register as a sex offender – a deal that the 3rd Judicial District Attorney's Office approved at the time but has since backtracked on.

In March 2024, Driggers suspended the sentence early. Court records do not indicate what prompted the suspension other than Driggers' belief that Howard had "satisfactorily fulfilled the conditions of his probation."

The Las Cruces Bulletin contacted the District Attorney for comment but received no response.

Hill drops from state House contest, endorses Silva

The June 4 Democratic primary election results included an upset victory in District 53, where incumbent state Rep. Willie Madrid of Chaparral lost a primary challenge to retired educator, and former school board member, Jon Hill.

Two months later, Hill has ended his campaign, citing health reasons, and opened the door for Democrats to select a new nominee who will face Republican candidate Elizabeth Winterrowd.

In an Aug. 2 news release, Hill announced his withdrawal and endorse-

ment of Sarah Silva, a Las Cruces native and longtime community organizer in southern New Mexico. The announcement indicated that Hill, a cancer survivor, was struggling with health complications.

“As a cancer survivor, I know that these symptoms are not normal,” he stated in the news release. “I have come to the realization that I cannot effectively communicate with my supporters and our communities, and must announce my withdrawal from the race.”

Although the situation tempts comparison to President Joe Biden’s last-minute decision in

July to drop his bid for a second term, weeks ahead of the Democratic National Convention, in this case Hill was already the official nominee. Ad-

ditionally, Silva indicated that Hill was contemplating his withdrawal before Biden’s announcement, saying she was approached about a possible

candidacy around July 19. (Biden withdrew on July 21 and endorsed his running mate, Vice President Kamala Harris.)

Democratic Party spokesperson Daniel Garcia confirmed that DPNM State Central Committee members who live in District 53 will meet on Aug. 22 to select a new nominee, and interested candidates have until that date to declare their interest in running. As of Tuesday afternoon, two candidates had done so: Silva, along with Willie Madrid, who lost the primary two months ago by a 16-percent margin.

Hill’s endorsement of Silva was enthusiastic,

noting previous community work she had done in the district, which straddles Doña Ana and Otero counties. “Sarah shares my vision for long-term economic and social growth while building on our strengths to improve the quality of life for all New Mexicans.”

Silva was the founder of New Mexico Comunidades en Acción y de Fé, better known as NM Café, a faith-based advocacy organization, in 2009. She later moved on to a position with the Pacific Institute for Community Organization, now named Faith in Action.

Raíces' new principal hopes to amplify school culture

New Raíces del Saber Xinachtli principal Hector Girón vowed to delve into the culture and emphasize the dual language, two-way immersion program to elevate students from Kindergarten through fifth grade.

The community school, located at 2211 N. Valley Drive, announced Girón would succeed Maria Artiga as head administrator.

The school was founded in 2019 as a dual-language immersion school with students learning the Nahuatl language and Mesoamerican culture alongside core academic standards required by the state. The term “Xinachtli” in the school’s name is a Nahuatl term for a blossoming seed, and refers to the indigenous-based teaching method practiced there. The school’s current charter is in effect through June 2029.

“The mission statement of the school says it all,” Girón told the Bulletin. “You look at the statement and it talks about an implementation of a dual language program, a 90/10 model and just an environment where teachers and students can thrive.”

The 90/10 model means a student that begins at Raíces Del Saber will be taught 90 percent of their lessons in Spanish and 10 percent in English, beginning in Kindergarten.

“This means that in

first grade, they will be taught 80 percent in Spanish and 20 percent in English. In second, 70/30; third is 60/40; fourth is 50/50; but the idea is for a student to be fluent in both languages by the fifth grade,” he said.

In order for the institution to pursue this model, Girón said teachers need to be open to change.

Some staff appeared ready and eager for the change Girón represents.

Third grade teacher and test coordinator Alessa Ibanez said Girón was her principal when she attended Gadsden High School in Anthony, N.M.. Once she found out he would become her new boss at Raíces, she was enthusiastic for his arrival and impact. “When he was my principal I knew he was stern, so having that new presence would be good for the faculty, students and parents,” she said.

His attitude is not the only admirable trait Ibanez recognized. She added that it can be challenging to obtain the right technology and manage operations such as testing. She said Girón is open and willing to make adjustments.

Parent and fourth grade teacher Roberto Moctezuma said he is looking forward to progress in communication and structure.

“I have two young girls who attend here, so for me to know that there is great communication with the

principal, it helps a lot. I have had other parents notice that he is out and about while they are dropping off and picking up the kids,” Moctezuma said. “It makes a big difference when you see the principal making that effort. He even sits out on lunches, so students are not afraid of that principal title.”

Moctezuma said the structure and curriculum of the school is one thing he is proud of and is eager to see Girón flesh out.

“Kids learn base 10 math system, base 20 math, regular Gregorian calendar and the Aztec calendar ... this really teaches kids about nature, themselves. We go outside in the morning and salute the directions,” Moctezuma said.

When the children salute the directions they are also giving “saludos,” which Ibanez said allows children to learn in different ways. “This helps to build the community in the classroom and chal-

lenges their critical thinking,” she said.

During saludos, animals are recognized in a way that personifies the students. At an early age they are taught the symbols of the animals but as they progress they learn about their anatomies. An animal such as a hummingbird is represented to have strength, a trait teachers encourage students to see in themselves. This begins at Kindergarten, and the lessons are elaborated as the students age. By fifth grade, students are learning why hummingbird are known for strength.

“Let’s look at the anatomy of a hummingbird and why it resembles strength. Well, it’s the only animal that can move up, down, left and right. It can also flap their wings 80 times per second. This allows the kids to connect with the animals and then it goes back to rooting them with our culture,” Ibanez said.

Girón has 39 years of education experience.

He began in the field as a social studies teacher at the Gadsden Independent School District before becoming the assistant principal at Gadsden High School. There, he established a dual language immersion program in 2016. He also became known as the campus disciplinarian, he recalled.

After his time at Gadsden, Girón left and became an assistant principal at Canutillo Elementary School in Texas.

He said the switch from high school to elementary was “enlightening.”

“My favorite 12 years of teaching were at (Canutillo), which taught K through sixth,” Girón said. “The most fascinating part of my time there was being able to see year after year, the growth and development of the children and how much they progressed.”

The time Girón spent at Canutillo gave him the opportunity to see elementary school as a critical point for children’s educational development. Girón said when a child struggles with critical thinking and problem solving in elementary, they are set up to struggle for the rest of their educational career.

“In K through three, you’re learning how to read. You must learn your alphabets and learn how to decipher letters and words,” he said. “But at fourth grade, it shifts – it becomes reading to learn. So it’s critical that elementary schools know how to

teach your child how to read at their respective grade level.”

After Canutillo, Girón became the director for bilingual ESL and foreign language instruction in the Ysleta Independent School District in El Paso, Texas. Among the district’s well-known programs is its dual language “international schools” model teaching languages such as Chinese, Japanese, French and German.

Girón later returned to the Gadsden district, where he worked as a college and dual credit coordinator. He accomplished feats such as starting a drone program for high school students and encouraging high schools to offer career readiness and technology classes. He said he started 11 different technology programs for students to choose from at Gadsden High.

He was promoted as head principal of Gadsden High School before retiring in 2022. He completed a doctorate in education at the University of Texas at El Paso before resuming his career at Raíces Del Saber.

The chair of the school’s governance board, Raul Aldair Marquez, said the staff is eager to have Girón in a news release.

“His experience and dedication to the schools he worked in will be a fantastic asset as we continue establishing our school in the community,” Aldair Marquez said.

thoughtfully challenge the status quo?

Considering the polarizing nature of politics, my words won't cause any reader to run right out and change their party affiliation. National politics are a conversation best left for another day.

However, on a smaller stage, I have to believe we all have options for engaging in policy decisions that impact our everyday lives. If we enter that arena with an open mind and a compassionate

heart, how much further will we get in understanding one another? I venture to say, a lot farther than the extreme individuals on either side are willing, or (dare I say) want us, to go.

And as citizens, taxpayers, voters, that should be unacceptable from our leaders.

Now is that pivotal moment in which our elected leaders must serve by listening. The onus is usually on them to lead us. But we need to start ask-

ing them to lead by listening to us objectively.

Both parties are responsible for the current vitriol we find when politics enter the conversation. Both sides paint the other with a single brush, making broad generalizations that just aren't true of the majority of Americans. And in doing so, the conversation is immediately moot, wagons are circled and relationships are, often, irretrievably damaged. And political and policy evolution is no lon-

ger possible.

The extremes on both sides are growing, fed by blind contempt and an unwavering narrative to follow the party at all costs, including off the cliff. The line drawn in the sand continues to grow wider. If allowed to fester, this unwillingness to compromise will leave our country and our small town even more unrecognizable than they are today.

An argument for more arguments

My best friend, Kelly, and I frequently had loud, boisterous arguments over politics that led folks to believe that we disagreed about everything. They were mistaken.

His views were influenced by watching Fox News, and mine are influenced by watching CNN, so that's where the arguments would start. But they didn't end there. It usually didn't take long for both of us to call BS on the TV talking points and get to the heart of the matter. That didn't always lead to an agreement, but it almost always led to a common understanding.

Of course, the folks who were there at the start of the argument didn't stick around until the finish. There are few ways to clear a room faster than

starting an argument over politics.

A recent survey by the Pew Research Center found that only 17 percent of people said they are very comfortable talking about politics with somebody who they don't know well. And nearly six out of 10 respondents described political conversations with those they disagree with as "stressful and frustrating."

More concerning, nearly two thirds of respondents said that people who vote for a different candidate than they do probably don't share their values. So it's not just that the other side has a different plan to achieve peace

and prosperity, it's that they oppose peace and prosperity.

It's impossible to reach that level of cynicism without giving up on honest debate with those who disagree with you.

Honest debate doesn't always mean coming to an agreement. The recent prisoner swap was an issue where Kelly and I would never have agreed. He had a more steely-eyed view of the world than I do, and would have seen it as an incentive for more false arrests. That doesn't mean he wouldn't have celebrated their return, or that I don't appreciate the risk.

There are a lot of issues where people of good

faith can come to different conclusions about the best way forward. The city is wrestling with that now when it comes to problems caused by poverty and homelessness. I have written in a previous column that I disagree with the proposed shopping cart ordinance. But I don't question the motives of Police Chief Jeremy Story, who proposed it. We both want to get to the same place.

All of this mistrust and bad faith will come to a crescendo during the next three months leading up to the election. And not just in the race for president. Our mailboxes will soon be filled with campaign mailers spouting false and misleading claims in both the state and local races as well.

TV ads with scary music and lighting will try to convince us that those running for office from the other party are all a bunch of thieves and scoundrels.

While none of that is new, I would argue that the heightened level of political division has certainly been exacerbated by the former president and current Republican candidate. But this isn't about him. It's about us.

We need to start talking to each other again. Talking face to face, not chatting online. Then, once we're done talking, comes the hard part.

We need to start listening to each other again.

Police say an 80-year-old woman's death was a homicide

Police are investigating the killing of an 80-year-old woman found dead earlier this week as a homicide.

Police discovered Maria Rodriguez, 80, inside a home on the 100 block of W. Madrid Road on Aug. 4. A news release confirming the death said that investigators did not initially classify the death as a homicide but have since escalated the incident.

"Detectives from the Criminal Investigation Section are now actively investigating the case as a homicide," the release said. Anyone with information relevant to the case was asked to contact police at 575-526-0795.

She said she met Hill when he knocked on her door during his primary campaign. She praised his record as an advocate for extending public education and said she supported him over Madrid because of the incumbent's vote against Senate Bill 3, which would have guaranteed paid family and medical leave for workers in the state. Madrid was among 11 Democrats who joined House Republicans in rejecting the bill on a close vote during the 2024 legislative session.

"I was born in Las Cruces; I was raised in Vado; and spent a majority of my career teaching communities how to hold their elected leaders accountable for the things that matter most to people, like their kids, their livelihoods, opportunities for them to be successful and safe," Silva said in an

interview. She said she would wait for the party committee to vote before engaging in campaign activity, but she said, "Issues like housing, affordable housing, are really important to me ... immigration and making sure that our undocumented and mixed-status families have just the same opportunities as anyone else and aren't dehumanized or made illegitimate by other New Mexicans; and I think there are quality-of-life issues in Las Cruces that I'm looking forward to hearing about. There are parts of the district I don't know, and then there's infrastructure and quality-of-life issues in Chaparral. ... I'm looking forward to reintroducing myself to that community and seeing what we can do around infrastructure, because it's the largest colonia in the state."

The Bulletin reached out to Hill for an interview, but did not hear back at press time.

Forecast: Reduced wildfire risk in New Mexico

New Mexico's respite from wildfires will likely continue through August, according to a new forecast, but experts warn the already long fire season here could stretch into September and October.

The National Interagency Fire Center publishes monthly fire risk outlooks across the country. Early monsoon rains in early July blunted what forecasters had predicted would be elevated wildfire risk across the state, particularly in the central mountain chain and in southern New Mexico.

But the new forecast released Aug. 1 shows that average temperatures and

substantial precipitation mean New Mexico won't have high fire risk for August, either. But that doesn't mean New Mexico is out of the woods.

"An uptick in large fire activity very well could re-emerge by late August or early September, then linger much longer than usual," forecasters wrote in their predictions for the Southwest area.

Fire season in the southwest typically lasts until monsoon season. The forecasts this year have said hot, dry conditions might persist well into October, bucking that typical trend.

At the moment in New Mexico, there are two active fires, according to the Southwest Coordina-

tion Center, including the Tanques Fire in the Southwest Fire, which has burned about 6,500 acres. In the Gila National Forest, the Ridge Fire has burned about 4,200 acres.

The forecast is released

as major wildfires burn elsewhere in the West. There are 94 large, uncontained wildfires across the country, according to the NIFC.

Four fires that began last month in Oregon and California each have burned more than 100,000 acres, including the Park Fire in northern California that has reached nearly 400,000 acres.

That's already bigger than New Mexico's biggest-ever wildfire, which burned about 340,000 acres, and it's just 24 percent contained, according to the NIFC.

So far in New Mexico this year, 580 wildfires have been detected that burned more than 84,000 acres.

New Mexico challenges election misinformation on X

New Mexico's top elections official, Secretary of State Maggie Toulouse Oliver, was among five secretaries of state to sign on to a bipartisan letter requesting the social media site X, once known as Twitter, modify its chatbot over complaints it was distributing false election information to subscribers. That information was then "captured and shared repeatedly in multiple posts - reaching millions of people," the letter stated.

The software program, Grok, was cited for writing posts misstating

ballot deadlines in several states immediately following President Joe Biden's withdrawal from the Democratic Party nomination process in July. Grok alleged that deadlines had passed in New Mexico and eight other states, rendering a change to the presidential ticket illegitimate.

"This is false," the letter stated. "In all nine states the opposite is true: The ballots are not closed, and upcoming ballot deadlines would allow for changes to candidates listed on the ballot for the offices of President and Vice President of the United States."

The program continued

to disseminate false information for a week before it was corrected, the secretaries wrote.

The letter, addressed to X owner Elon Musk, was first reported by the Washington Post. The lead author is Minnesota Secretary of State Steve Simon and it is co-signed by secretaries Jocelyn Benson of Michigan, Steve Hobbs of Washington, Al Schmidt of Pennsylvania and Toulouse Oliver. All but Schmidt are Democrats; Schmidt is a Republican.

As a solution, the authors recommended Grok be programmed, as its competitor ChatGPT was, to direct the public to the

nonpartisan CanIVote.org for questions regarding elections.

Toulouse Oliver's office has stepped up efforts this year to combat the use of generative software to produce fake images, audio and video to help spread false information to undermine confidence in elections or discourage participation.

"We're all trying to grapple with this new technology and the new level of perceived reality that it brings to mis- and disinformation," Toulouse Oliver told the Bulletin in an interview in May.

Neither Musk nor X have responded publicly to the secretaries' letter.

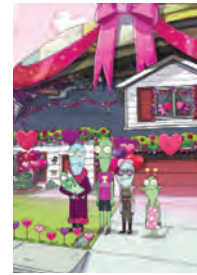

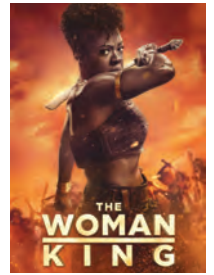
"Solar Opposites" - Season 5 (Aug. 12)

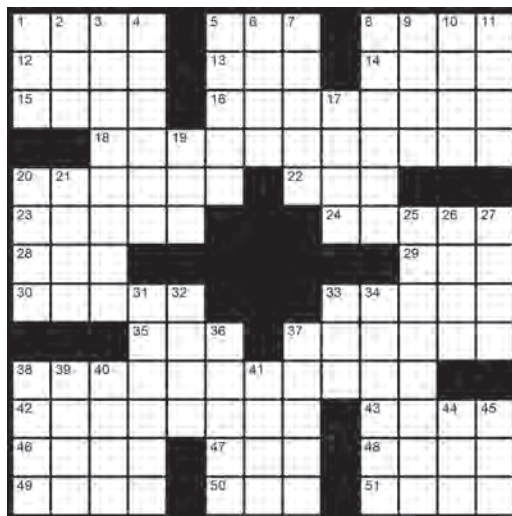

Montopolis orchestrates silent film revival

The idea of combining old silent films with modern scores isn't a new one, but every once in a while, a project comes along that elevates the fusion to rhapsodic levels. Austin, Texas phenom Montopolis is just such a project. Composer, producer and musical director Justin Sherburn is taking his critically acclaimed synthesis on the road, stopping at the Fountain Theatre in Mesilla to present not one, but two silent film classics with modernized scores, Friday, Aug. 16.

Montopolis, named for a suburban neighborhood in Austin, is Sherburn's latest venture in a vast and varied career that has included everything from indie, tango and swing bands to

compositions for feature films, theater and dance productions. His original compositions, according to his website, combine "traditional orchestral instrumentation with analog synthesizers, digital programming, and field recordings." The result, according to the Austin Chronicle, is "stunning and transcendent."

Sherburn creates his ambient atmospheres in a way that makes audiences feel that an entire chamber orchestra is on stage. "I play guitar, keyboards, and electronics," he said. "I also sing through a vocal processor that makes me sound like a chorus of cowboys or demons, depending on the show."

Such showmanship comes in handy when bringing vintage fare such as the 1916 silent classic "The Return of Draw Egan"

back to the big screen. What began as a rugged Western about a New Mexican outlaw-turned-lawman, becomes something altogether different under the Montopolis banner. Featuring a cherry-picked score by the legendary Ennio Morricone, Sherburn gives it a modern

twist.

Enlisting the help of Austin comedians Mac Blake and Caros LaRotta, the movie has been reimagined as an absurdist comedy.

"They removed the original dialogue cards and replaced them with hilarious jokes,"

Sherburn explained. "Also, I'm playing music that is really anachronistic and sometimes just absurd. There's a lot of comedy in juxtaposing music with image. Also, I rock out extensively throughout the program."

The second movie on the bill, a screen adaptation of Dante's *Inferno* titled "*L'Inferno*," is presented in its original form with an inventive, all-original score by Sherburn that is "pretty evil sounding, in a fun way."

Montopolis: Two Silent Classics, Two Live Scores will rock 'n roll out the classics at 7:30 p.m., Friday, Aug. 16 at the Fountain Theatre, 2469 Calle de Guadalupe, in Mesilla. For more info, see MesillaValleyFilm.com and Montopolis-Music.com.

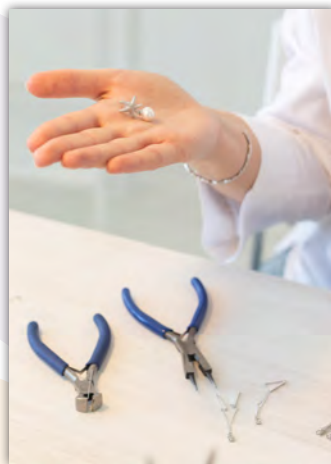

Fire Department to hold public meetings

BULLETIN REPORT

The Las Cruces Fire Department announced in a news release they'll host at least three public meetings and appearances in August, seeking to educate the public and receive feedback.

"The public meetings are a great opportunity for Las Cruces residents and the business community to learn more about the services provided by LCFD

and have a say in how the department can better serve its community," the release said.

The meetings are set for:

- Thursday, Aug. 8 at 3 p.m. in council chambers, Las Cruces City Hall, 700 N. Main St.

- Saturday, Aug. 10, from 8 a.m. to noon at the Farmer's and Crafts Market, 514 N. Main St.

- Wednesday, Aug. 21, at 5 p.m. in the Roadrunner Room, Thomas Branigan

Memorial Library, 200 E. Picacho Ave.

The fire department also noted that it receives about 23,000 calls for services yearly and responds to technical and aircraft rescue calls and hazardous materials response as well as fires.

In 2022, Las Cruces voters approved a \$10 million bond for the city to build a new fire station in the Sonoma Ranch area to service those neighborhoods

and the Highway 70 corridor. In 2018, LCFD used another voter-supported GO bond to build Fire Station 3 off Valley Drive near Amador Avenue. LCFD has also been lauded for launching and maintaining Project LIGHT, a behavioral health crisis team that responds alongside traditional emergency response units like police.

Yet despite success, the city's public dashboard also notes some challenges

for the area's fire and medical emergency response systems. The dashboard

notes that some areas remain difficult for emergency units to access.

Conn's Las Cruces location to close as company declares bankruptcy

BULLETIN REPORT

The Las Cruces location of Conn's HomePlus, a retailer with several locations in New Mexico and West Texas, will close after the company filed for bankruptcy in late July.

The retailer sells household goods such as mattresses, appliances, electronics and more, extending credit for many

purchases.

The Las Cruces location sits in the Mesilla Valley Mall and employs around a dozen people. Their showroom on the northern side of the Mesilla Valley Mall features living and dining room sets as well as bedroom furniture along with large appliances.

The company will also close its three Albuquerque

locations, one in Santa Fe and two El Paso locations.

According to the company's Chapter 11 bankruptcy filing in the Southern District of Texas, Conn's operates in 553 locations in 15 states, 22 distribution and service facilities and employs about 3,800 people full-time. Reporting on the company's contraction in-

dicated Conn's registered a net loss of nearly \$77 million last year.

The court filing indicates Conn's will close all of its business locations and plans to conduct liquidation sales nationwide concluding Oct. 31 if not

sooner.

"We're sorry to see them go. They were part of our mall family," Loretta Pina, the mall's general manager, told the Bulletin. "We should be securing a new tenancy as soon as we possibly can. Right now our

mall is at 96 percent occupancy and we want to keep our occupancy rates up."

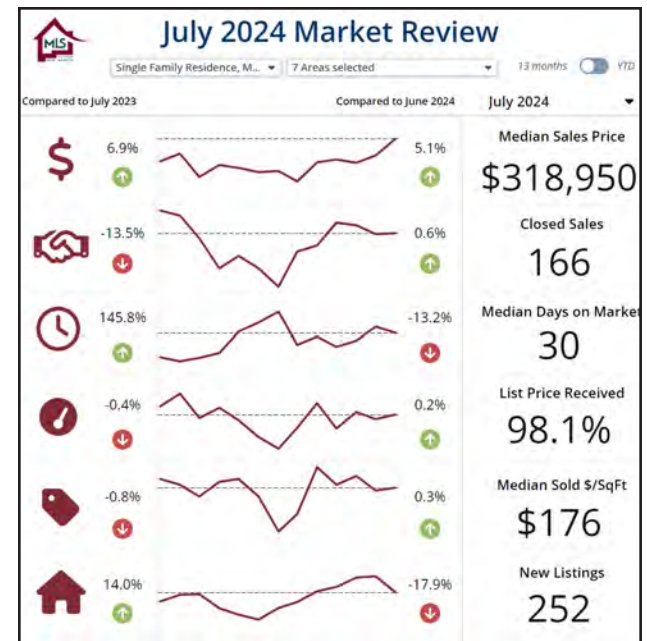
Pina added that interest in leasing retail space at the mall is strong. "We're not going to have too many open spaces left for too long," she said.

As fall approaches, you will start to see national stats and headlines stating a buyers' market is in place. While prices saw a decrease nationwide, that wasn't quite the case in Las Cruces. According to a national report from Realtor.com, home prices dropped by about \$6,000. Las Cruces, however, still saw an increase in its median closing price despite another significant drop in year-over-year closed sales. This downturn is attributed mostly to unaffordable interest rates and buyers looking for better economic signs and financial breaks before making any moves with housing.

Sellers in Las Cruces are still holding on to prices that we saw in 2021, with one price drop on average before going under agreement. Buyers have some ability to negotiate prices, closing costs or even a combination of both, giving signs of a



market that is shifting in favor of many first-time buyers.

At this time, we can also expect a dramatic decrease in interest rates as the latest jobs report and stock market activity are showing signs of a looming recession. The fed is ready to announce at least three drops in basis points before the end of the year, which will give much-needed relief

for homeowners looking to refinance and buyers entering the market.

As you start to see more "For Sale" signs in your neighborhood and possible decreases, don't panic. This is simply our market correcting itself. Homes are still closing, prices are still holding strong and buyers are still driving around looking. It's still a great time to be a Las Cruces homeowner.

Camden Duzenack joined Head Coach Jake Angier on the baseball staff as an assistant coach on Aug. 1. He will be coaching the infield and assisting with all other aspects of the program. Duzenack spent six seasons in the Arizona Diamondbacks farm system after being drafted in the ninth round of the 2017 MLB draft.

Duzenack recorded 454 hits in 1809 at-bats during his six seasons in the minors. He had a career batting average of .251, an

OBP of .318 and an OPS of .735. Duzenack racked up several awards such as Northwest League All-Star in 2017, NWL Post-Season All-Star in 2017, CAL Mid-Season All-Star in 2019 and PCL Player of the Week on Sept. 21, 2022. On Sept. 27, 2022, Duzenack fielded all nine positions in one game.

“I got the honor to coach Cam Duzenack in the minor league system with the Arizona Diamondbacks and he will always be one of my favorite players I’ve coached,” said Javier Colina, manager of the Hillsboro Hops. “The

program.”

How to finish the last few holes for a score

Are you having difficulty finishing a round of golf with a score you're happy about? I'll just call it "closing round blues." And it's an all-too-common lament. You play great golf on the first nine holes but you tend to lose it on the back nine – especially on the last four holes.

Meltdowns in the final rounds and final holes have become legendary among tour pros. In 1999, Frenchman Jean Van de Velde had a three shot lead standing on the tee on the 72nd and final hole of the Open Championship at Carnoustie in Scotland. As meltdowns go, this was epic: Van de Velde made a triple bogey

and then lost in a playoff. As Yogi Berra once said, "it ain't over 'til it's over!"

In our own games, we can find it challenging and downright bothersome to overcome nerves and keep our head while trying to finish out a round of golf. Stories are plentiful from golfers who are trying to break 100, or 90, or 80 for the first time, only to falter on the last few holes. In my humble opinion, those breakdowns are all set up by the player focusing on his score instead of paying full attention to the process of his play, trusting that the

results will follow confident swings, shots and putts. As I look back, some of my best golf rounds have been when I didn't know what I shot until the round was over.

Late-round fatigue can also be an energy-sapping and score-ruining problem. Golfers need to hydrate and utilize energy snacks early and in the middle of rounds. Playing golf for over four hours on warm (or even mild) days is usually more tiring the older we get, so we have to be disciplined in keeping our stamina up, both physically and mentally.

On most golf courses the second nine holes is harder than the first nine. Golf course designers like to make the last few holes especially difficult because tournaments and matches often come down to the final few holes to decide the winner. That was the case at the Donald Ross designed Pinehurst No. 2 several weeks ago. For that reason players' coaches usually recommend a "conservative target – aggressive swing" approach for the closing holes. Even Scottie Scheffler pays attention to that strategy.

If you think just "trying harder" is the answer to closing out your round, think again. Golf is not

like football or wrestling, where the harder you try, the better you may get. You may be forgetting about calming your nerves, your pre-shot routine and reassured breathing, before you swing the club.

You know what kind of shots you are expected to hit on the three or four holes to finish a round. A fool-proof way to develop the confidence you need to play the final few holes well is to identify the shots you will need for those particular holes, and practice those very shots on the practice range. But there's the old saying: "Every time someone comes up with a fool-proof solution, along

comes a more talented fool."

Finally, try eliminating the self-imposed pressure you put on yourself by demanding that you absolutely must achieve the results you're expecting on your round of golf. It would be best if your first goal is to "do your best," while the rest is mostly beyond your control. Sometimes we have to put golf, which is our fun recreation, in its proper perspective.
