Welcome to southern New Mexico ...

Chile capital of the world, tradition, culture, and SPACE!!

Not only does Southern New Mexico have all of this and more to offer, we are on the forefront of space adventure thanks to Virgin Galactic. Leadership Las Cruces 32nd class got to experience this on Friday October 18th when they took the hour and a half drive out in the middle of the desert to a futuristic oasis!

Upon arriving the group was met by Leadership Las Cruces alumni Cory Leiferman. He gave a brief introduction and welcome to Virgin Galactic and put the group of about 30 people into 3 teams. Eric Owens, Tory Hoffman and Auhdra Houston guided each group to different stations within the compound. LLC was in awe as they learned about the Mothership named Eve after Sir Richard Branson's mom. The Virgin Galactic mothership, the Virgin Mother Ship Eve (VMS EVE), has a wingspan of 141 ft (43 m). The VMS EVE is a twin-fuselage aircraft with four jet engines, two on each wing. The VMS EVE carries the Virgin Spaceship Unity (VSS Unity) in the center of its wing. The VSS Unity is a rocket plane that ignites its engine and boosts to the edge of space after being released from the VMS EVE. Once in space, the VMS Unity does the unthink-



able. It folds in half and completely rotates upside down while paying astronauts look and float in awe down on New Mexico, Texas and to the outreaches of California and Mexico. Once the rotation completes, the VMS Unity returns back to exactly where it is planed to land. Guided by technology and two decorated pilots. After learning about this, the groups were able to experience the Simulator room where a decorated Russian Pilot goes through every scenario possible with the pilots. Lastly LLC sat in the control room and learned all of the different jobs that the command center executes during a flight. As you can imagine, there are many factors to make the \$650,000 ticket a dream come true!!

After a wonderful lunch was provided LLC class bused over to Spaceport America. Charles Hurley met the group with a welcoming smile and spoke of all

of the amazing entrepreneurial options they have to offer. Spaceport America is "the world's first purpose-built commercial spaceport," designed and constructed specifically for commercial users, that had not previously been an airport or federal infrastructure of any kind. The site is built to accommodate both vertical and horizontal launch aerospace vehicles, as well as an array of non-aerospace events and commercial activities. Spaceport America is owned and operated by the State of New Mexico, via a state agency, the New Mexico Spaceport Authority. It has many current tenants including UP Aerospace, Spin Launch and Virgin Galactic, and is continuing to expand more!

Something that really stuck out is the retention and job offerings of New Mexico professionals and graduates at both Virgin Galactic and Spaceport. Not only New Mexico, but NMSU! They have really continued to keep integrated in the Las Cruces community and hope to provide the betterment of our hereafter. So, next time you are looking up... think of the oasis out in the middle of the Southern New Mexico desert and know the future is on the horizon!
