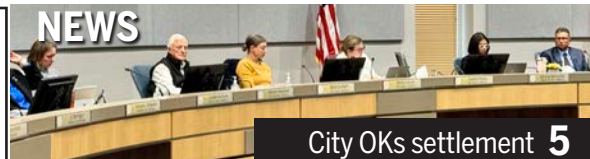

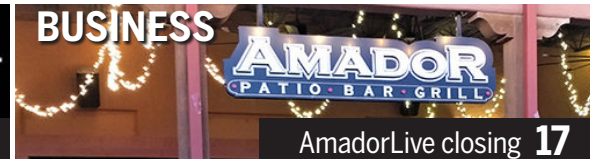

New commissioner aims to reconnect southern Doña Ana County

Gloria Gameros has as much stake in southern New Mexico as anyone could.

She grew up in Chamberino, attended Gadsden High School, owned a business in Las Cruces and served as an elected trustee of the city of Anthony, N.M., where she's lived for about 34 years.

In a recent interview, Gameros told the Las Cruces Bulletin that her experience and care for her part of the county drove her to seek a seat on the Doña Ana County Board of Commissioners.

And now that she's got it, she's got big plans.

For her first year, Gameros has two main goals: Clear up lines of communication between southern county residents and their elected officials and reevaluate land use codes that allow

residential and industrial development to coexist or overlap in the southern county.

"I'm one of those people who likes to push things," Gameros said.

Gameros defeated incumbent commissioner Diana Murillo in a June Democratic primary and then prevailed over a Republican challenger to win the seat.

She joins the board at a transitional moment. In 2024, the board parted ways with the former county manager and hired Scott Andrews for the role. The board gave Andrews a mandate to build up the county's economic development capacity.

Much of that will likely focus on border development in Gameros' district, which extends to the Luna County line but has its heart in the communities along the Rio Grande from Berino to Anthony. It's also the only district that doesn't include any part of Las Cruces.

Gameros' victory over Murillo, who is also the mayor of Anthony, followed months of criticism and upheaval for the now-former county commissioner. Lawsuits between her and Anthony's trustees and questions about transparency

and the use of city resources have plagued Murillo's term.

Gameros also said that communication has been lacking. She described constituents telling her that officials repeatedly failed to field their concerns and calls.

"That's all I kept hearing; nobody hears, and nobody cares about what we have to say. And this is in our rural areas," Gameros said.

Gameros said she plans to host regular meetings in her district and attend local community meetings to remediate this. She also wants to start a newsletter in English and Spanish to reach her constituents.

"I came (into the office) in the first place because I wanted to represent the people that didn't have a voice – the underdogs, as I call them," Gameros said.

Another goal for her first year is to examine land use codes in the southern part of the county. Too often, Gameros said, industrial areas abut rural residential areas, leading to health impacts.

"We have too many residential areas near industrial areas

City pushes transparency remedy to next week

The city of Las Cruces tabled a resolution on Jan. 6 meant to remedy a violation of a transparency law that restricts what elected officials can discuss in closed session.

The resolution follows a New Mexico Department of Justice finding that the city council violated the Open Meetings Act when they “engaged in closed deliberations and invalid (final) actions prior to the single, open public meeting held to discuss the hiring of a new city manager on Apr. 1, 2024,” a letter announcing the finding said.

“These actions deprived the public of any meaningful opportunity to participate in, or even witness the deliberations on, a question of significant public importance,” the NMDOJ said.

In the same findings, the NMDOJ said the city of Las Cruces could restart the search or pass a resolution declaring what was discussed in closed

meetings. The city chose the latter. However, ahead of the meeting’s action items and public comment on Jan. 6, Mayor Eric Enriquez said the discussion would be moved to Jan. 13.

Brad Douglas, the attorney for the city of Las Cruces, said that the city submitted their proposed remedy to the NMDOJ. Douglas said the Attorney General’s office responded to the city on Friday afternoon, requesting a more detailed remedy.

“I think it’s important for everyone to know that when we do bring these items to an open meeting, the entire governing body will not only summarize their past actions in closed meetings, but they’re going to have an open discussion about every item on the agenda,” Douglas said.

He added that he expects the new remedy to be spread out over four to six resolutions.

The issue came to a head following Las Cruces Bulletin reporting that raised questions as to whether the selection of

the current city manager followed the law. The city has argued that no policy vote took place and that, therefore, no violation of the law occurred.

“I would say I own it,” Enriquez said at an impromptu news conference after the meeting.

Enriquez also raised concerns about the NMDOJ findings. He said he didn’t feel some of the “evidence was correct” and that some of the findings were more like inferences.

“We’ll move forward. I

time passes.

“As I’m learning and getting an idea of what I can and can’t do and can create and can solve, it will probably help me to change and evolve what I’m going to do next year,” she said.

Gameros was sworn in on Dec. 30, 2024. Her first county meeting takes place on Jan. 14.

feel that the compromise to ratify it, to bring it to a resolution and bring it forward, I feel is, is fair,” Enriquez said.

Despite being removed from the agenda, the OMA violation was more fodder in the always raucous crowd for public comment. At one point, commenters accused the council of violating OMA again because they felt there was not enough information about spending changes in the agenda

packet.

At another point, a member of the conservative activist group Businesses for Safer Las Cruces briefly refused to leave the podium and shouted at the mayor.

City Manager Ikani Taumoepeau was not present for the meeting. A spokesperson for the city said that Taumoepeau was out of the office on a vacation that was scheduled prior to the AG’s findings.

or near animal manufacturing or landfills,” she said. “That’s a little hazardous to the community.”

At the same time, Gameros said that improving infrastructure and allowing the county to provide more services – especially

improved road maintenance – is a key priority. She’s joined by planning documents and statements from other commissioners who have also called for infrastructure improvements to southern Doña Ana County.

But for now, it’s all in the future, and Gameros acknowledged that her priorities may change as

Elected officials sworn in at start of 2025

Fourteen people were sworn in as elected officials at a ceremony on Dec. 30, 2024, at the Doña Ana County Government Center in Las Cruces, marking the start of several new terms for elected officials.

Most of the officials sworn in were incumbents who had won re-election. The ceremony also confirmed new faces for 3rd Judicial District Attorney, state House of Representatives District 53 and the Doña Ana Board of Commissioners.

“This ceremony is not just a formality. It is a

reminder of the trust that the people have placed in us,” said County Clerk Amanda López Askin, one of the incumbent officials who won re-election. “Democracy is about representation, making sure every voice is heard, every concern is taken seriously, and every decision is made with the best interest of our community in mind.”

For an hour, officials and their families filled the commissioners’ chambers at the government center for the ceremony. As they took their oaths, many of the officials were surrounded by family and friends as they swore to uphold the

laws of the state of New Mexico and the United States.

“To those being sworn in today, you’ve chosen to lead, to listen, to serve. The road ahead will not always be easy. But it is filled with opportunities to make a real difference and to deliver on the hopes of those who voted for you,” López Askin said.

Returning congressman Gabe Vasquez was the first to be sworn in. He was followed by state Senator Bill Soules, state Senator Carrie Hamblen, state Representative Micaela Lara Cadena, state Representative Joanne Ferrary, state Representa-

tive Sarah Silva, District Attorney Fernando Macias, District Judge James “Jim” Martin, Magistrate Judge Nathan Willam Graff, Clerk López Askin; county commissioners Gloria Gameros, Manuel Sanchez and Susana Chaparro; and County Treasurer Marisol Richardson.

Other officials not present can be sworn in at later dates, according to the clerk’s office.

Heinrich takes on new role

New Mexico’s senior U.S. Senator, Martin Heinrich, a Democrat who won a third term in this November, was sworn in Jan. 3, and named ranking member for the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee in the 119th Congress. As ranking member, Heinrich is the senior representative of the party holding a minority in the Republican-led Senate.

Heinrich begins his 13th year on Capitol Hill with the new title and will play a major role in setting national energy policies and managing the U.S.’s public lands within the U.S. Department of the Interior and the U.S. Forest Service. The committee also oversees the U.S. Department of Energy and has jurisdiction over nuclear waste policy.

“As I take on this role, I want to be clear about who I am working for: the electrician looking for a job in her home community, the family trying to make ends meet by lowering their utility bill, the manufacturer looking to expand but needing a strong electric grid, and those just looking to clear their mind or fill their freezer on public lands nearby,” Heinrich said in a news release.

The news release also noted that Heinrich is following former U.S. Senators from New Mexico

– Democrats Jeff Bingaman, Clinton Anderson and Carl Hatch as well as Republican Pete Domenici – in taking a role on the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee.

“The reality is that all of us will need steadfast leadership to deliver water security for communities and farmers and to slow and mitigate the effects of climate change as the unnatural disasters it is causing continue to wreak havoc— from New Mexico to North Carolina. I will work every day to deliver that leadership,” Heinrich said.

New Mexico’s entire delegation to Congress consists of Democrats. Senators Heinrich and Ben Ray Luján, and House of Representatives members Vasquez, Melanie Stansbury and Teresa Leger Fernandez, all returned to Washington last week for the opening of the new Congress.

Council approves financing for \$20 million shooting settlement

The Las Cruces City Council voted unanimously on Monday, Jan. 6, to approve a funding mechanism for a \$20 million settlement in the police killing of Teresa Gomez.

The vote marked another step in the historic settlement following the 2023 killing of Teresa Gomez by Las Cruces police officer Felipe Hernandez. The funding mechanism was the sale of municipal local option gross receipts tax bonds. The move does not raise taxes.

Hernandez killed Gomez after confronting her as she sat in a parked

car outside a housing complex. After an encounter laden with curse words, Gomez attempted to drive away, whereupon Hernandez fired several shots at her.

When prosecutors announced criminal charges, they pointed out that Hernandez was several feet from Gomez and argued that he was in no danger. Hernandez faces one charge of second-degree murder with a trial set for early June.

The criminal case is one of two pending against former LCPD officers charged with murder or manslaughter.

The council had little to say as they passed the funding mechanism for the historic settlement.



District 4 councilor Johana Bencomo was the only councilor who spoke on the matter.

“First of all, to the family of Teresa Gomez,

I want to offer my sincerest condolences and genuine apology. I will never forget her name, and I will continue to say her name,” Bencomo said.

Bencomo cited a database that lists New Mexico as having the highest rate of police killings in the nation and then

addressed an argument made by LCPD Police Chief Jeremy Story at the governor’s Las Cruces town hall last July, without naming him. Story had implied at that event that police shootings were uncommon compared to the majority of police encounters that don’t end in a shooting.

“This is not the spirit that we should be having these conversations,” Bencomo said. “Perhaps the spirit should be like how we talk about crime in general.”

Governor picks El Paso Electric boss for NMSU regent slot

Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham nominated El Paso Electric Regional Vice President Ricardo Gonzales to fill a four-year term on New Mexico State University’s Board of Regents last week.

The Board of Regents oversees the university’s operations and is responsible for university governance. The regents also oversee the president’s office and some university policies and approve all degrees. NMSU’s regents also oversee the New Mexico Department of Agriculture, which is housed at NMSU, a land-

grant institution.

“As an Aggie, I’m incredibly proud to have been nominated to the New Mexico State University Board of Regents. As a kid, I remember cruising campus and cheering on the Aggie basketball teams; I could never have imagined an opportunity like this. Thank you, Michelle Lujan Grisham,” Gonzales wrote in a post on LinkedIn.

Gonzales oversees EPE’s operations and strategy in New Mexico. He also leads government relations and lobbying efforts with the state. The privately-owned utility covers much of southern

New Mexico.

According to a news release from the governor’s office, Gonzales has been a legislative affairs director for the university and the state Department of

Agriculture. His LinkedIn profile reports that he holds a bachelor’s degree in history from NMSU.

“I look forward to working with our new President and the university community as we extend our engagement and impact across the Mesilla Valley, urban and rural New Mexico. Go Aggies,” he stated.

In New Mexico, boards of regents are nominated by the governor and confirmed by the state senate. That confirmation will likely occur during the upcoming legislative session. NMSU regents serve staggered 6-year terms.

WNMU regents depart in wake of spending scandal

Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham accepted the resignations of the remaining regents of Western New Mexico University on Tuesday and said she was reviewing candidates for a new board governing the Silver City-based university.

The resignations followed a series of controversies stoked by a November review of spending at the university by New Mexico State Auditor Joseph Maestas.

The Office of the State Auditor reviewed expenditures including procurement and travel expenses from 2018 to 2023, reporting in November that the review uncovered “wasteful spending and improper use of university funds” indicating that the board of regents and university management had failed to

comply with university policies and procedures. The review specifically found misuse of purchasing cards and expense accounts, as well as improper travel and lodging expenses, by university president Joseph Shepard, his spouse and regents. Among the findings was a purchasing card issued to Shepard’s spouse, Valerie Plame, although she was not a university employee.

Shepard, who has led the university since 2011, announced his resignation in December, with an effective date of Jan. 15. Yet a new controversy arose after the board of regents unanimously approved a \$1.9 million severance payment for Shepard, plus a five-year faculty appointment at a \$200,000 annual salary.

Lawmakers had expressed concerns about the university’s leadership

since 2023, when Searchlight New Mexico first published a report about spending by Shepard and trustees.

On Dec. 31, Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham called for the entire board of regents to resign, which would permit her to appoint a new board for the public university. Regents Lyndon Haviland, Dal Moellenberg and Dan Lopez all resigned, while regents Mary Hotvedt and Trent Jones (a student representative) concluded

their terms on Dec. 31.

In a scathing statement issued Tuesday afternoon, the governor wrote, “The WNMU Board’s tone-deaf decision to approve a \$1.9 million severance package for Dr. Shepard demonstrated an appalling disconnect from the needs of our state, where the median income of a family of four is just \$61,000. The amount of money contained in Dr. Shepard’s separation agreement could have addressed food insecurity across the entire WNMU student body for a full year.”

New Mexico Attorney General Raúl Torrez filed an emergency motion on Jan. 6 asking a court to halt payment of Shepard’s severance, “to prevent a gross misuse of funds appropriated to support the education of Western’s student population,” the office stated in a news release.

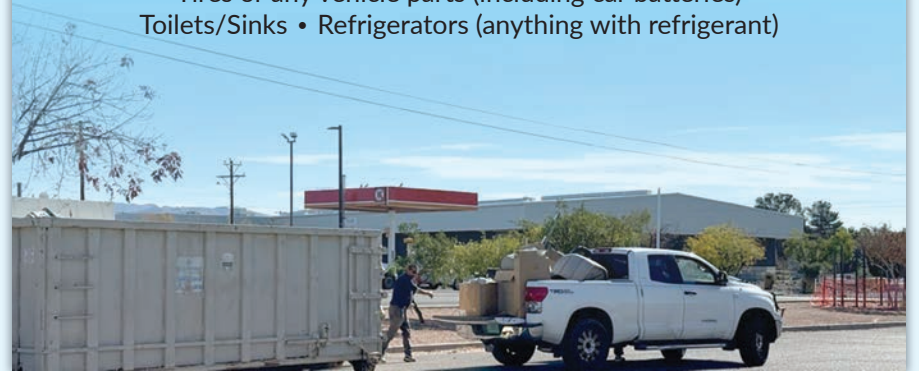

Carter warned of problems ahead

Jimmy Carter was an honest, reverent and decent man during a time when those qualities were seen as a political asset. Now, I fear they would all be seen as weakness.

It's been clear for some time that the Carter presidency will not be viewed positively by history. A 2021 survey of professional historians conducted by C-SPAN ranks Carter 26th, between Grover Cleveland and James Garfield.

I've often wondered how things might have been different if the helicopters hadn't crashed in the desert.

Carter lost to Ronald Reagan 489-49 in the electoral college vote of 1980. He lost by nearly 10 percent in the popular vote, a margin that likely would have been greater if not for third-party candidate John Anderson,

who siphoned off 6.6 percent. Today, our incoming president won 49.8 percent of the popular vote and claims to have an "historic mandate."

Few people who lived through it remember Carter's presidency fondly. Like all presidents, Carter inherited the problems created by his predecessors. Only George Washington started with a clean slate.

Carter inherited an enraged populace in Iran that vehemently hated America for our role in propping up Iranian leaders who were friendly to our oil companies but brutal and oppressive to their own people. That rage boiled over in November of 1979 when the Shah was overthrown and 66 Americans serving in the US Embassy were taken

hostage.

In April of 1980 Carter gave the green light to Operation Eagle Claw. Eight helicopters from the newly created Delta Force took off for the first staging area, but three suffered damage along the way

storm and mechanical failures. Carter decided to abort the mission. As they were preparing to leave, one of the helicopters crashed into a transport aircraft carrying jet fuel. Eight servicemen were killed in the accident.

Even before the hostage crisis, the Carter presidency struggled with rampant inflation and an energy crisis caused by a decrease in foreign production, specifically in Iran. In July of 1979 Carter himself acknowl-

edged that, "For the first time in the history of our country a majority of people believe that the next five years will be worse than the last five."

He added, "As you know, there is a growing disrespect for government and for churches and for schools, the news media and other institutions. This is not a message of happiness or reassurance, but it is the truth and it is a warning."

Carter's warning went unheeded. The number of people who regularly attend religious services has fallen from 42 percent to 30 percent in the past two decades. Cable news and the internet have transformed the media into a mishmash of truth and fiction in which even the most radical consumers can find validation for their beliefs.

As for faith in govern-

ment, we just elected a man who promised to tear it all down.

Carter would go on to have one of the most productive periods following his presidency of any of our modern leaders. During their 30-plus years of service to Habitat for Humanity, Jimmy and Rosalynn Carter joined with more than 108,000 volunteers to renovate or repair homes in 14 countries, while also raising awareness of the need for more affordable housing.

When he died last week at age 100, there were plenty of critics ready to denounce his policies. That's fair. But almost nobody had a bad word to say about the man. That's a rare and special thing in today's politics.

Paid family leave is essential for New Mexico's future

In 2022, I faced the fight of my life. After enduring nine grueling months of unexplained fevers, night sweats and a swollen spleen, I booked a one-way ticket to Mayo Clinic in Phoenix, Arizona. There, I received a devastating diagnosis: hepatosplenic T-cell lymphoma, a rare and aggressive blood cancer with a median sur-

vival rate of just three to 28 months.

The treatments were challenging and time-consuming. Treatments for complex conditions like cancer can take months and sometimes years. Chemotherapy, total body irradiation and a stem cell transplant

required me to relocate to Phoenix for six months to stay close to Mayo Clinic. On top of the physical toll, renting an apartment near the hospital and covering living expenses added a significant financial burden.

ctigue, nausea and other side effects meant I had to carefully balance work with my energy levels, focusing on tasks when I felt up to them. These careful calculations went on for months. But even this was a privilege: I could keep my health insurance and adjust my work responsibilities. Only some have that option. For many

Legislature must reform competency and direct treatment

Our communities are paying the price for our broken criminal justice system, which is failing those with mental health problems and/or drug addiction. Shortly, the 2025 legislative session will be underway in Santa Fe. Like many others, I'm wondering whether our legislators will take action to fix the situation.

Here in Las Cruces, repeat offenders are responsible for innumerable crimes. Many repeat offenders are deemed incompetent to stand trial, so they are just released back onto the streets where they commit crime after crime after crime. For instance, from a public records request, one of the top repeat offenders in Las Cruces has over 120 charges for aggravated assault, drug dealing (meth), battery, trespassing, shoplifting and more.

Another top repeat offender has been charged 95+ times,

with offenses including criminal trespass, possession of illegal drugs, assault, property damage, indecent exposure, shoplifting, battery on a peace officer and unlawful carrying of a deadly weapon. These are just a couple of examples, but there are dozens more. Twenty-eight of the top 40, or 70 percent, of the top repeat offenders in Las Cruces are homeless, given that Mesilla Valley Community of Hope is listed as their place of residence. I can drive around downtown and see several repeat offenders on the streets on any given day.

Meanwhile, families and businesses in Las Cruces are suffering the consequences. Businesses and homes are being vandalized, windows are being broken, property is being taken and vehicles are being stolen. Homeless people are camping out at businesses and homes, approaching people asking for money, scaring children, threatening people

and leaving trash and feces all around. Drugged out people are wandering the streets, harassing people and leaving dangerous needles lying around where children can find them.

My own two teens have often ridden the city bus to a class in downtown Las Cruces. They've witnessed men behaving erratically, drug dealing in broad daylight and two vagrants outside their classroom window smoking crack or meth in the middle of the afternoon in full view of children as young as nine years old. Like many mothers, I am concerned for my children's safety, especially in downtown Las Cruces, parking lots and city parks.

People are being harmed while trying to live peacefully and responsibly, such as Rosa Ortega, who was brutally attacked by a homeless person in broad daylight while walking to the grocery store. Another example is a yoga teacher in downtown Las Cruces, who was attacked with rocks

thrown at her car and threatened with being raped and killed. Less than a year ago, LCPD Officer Jonah Hernandez was murdered while responding to a trespassing call, leaving behind his wife and two young children.

It is not compassionate to allow people to continue destroying their own lives and health with drugs; and it is the duty of government to ensure that these people are not allowed to continue destroying our community.

The New Mexico Legislature must enact laws to allow "incompetent" offenders to be directed into treatment, for the good of all. Currently, part of the problem is that the state's definition for mental disorders does not include substance abuse disorder. This makes it very difficult to direct those who are addicted to drugs into the stabilizing treatment they need.

Furthermore, the current assisted outpatient treatment

model is not enough. AOT is voluntary and, while it can work well for some offenders, it's clearly not working for the top repeat offenders, many of whom are violent and unstable. Much as we'd like to wish it wasn't necessary, there must be a mechanism for involuntary commitment and treatment of those who are deemed incompetent.

The upcoming legislative session is a prime opportunity for change. Both Democratic and Republican legislators need to stop politicizing the issues and find common ground so that our communities and our state can survive. Safety across our state should be a top priority for our legislators, but it remains to be seen whether they will actually take any meaningful action.

ery or care for a loved one isn't financially viable.

Three in four New Mexico workers lack access to paid family leave, forcing families to make heart-breaking choices during crises. The Paid Family and Medical Leave Act would provide a lifeline, ensuring workers can take the necessary time without risking financial stability or their financial future

Paid leave allows people

to focus on healing, caregiving or welcoming a new child without fear of losing everything they've worked for. It's not a luxury, it's a necessity for creating healthier families and communities.

As the cofounder of a Las Cruces-based gaming company, I understand how important it is to balance supporting employees with managing costs. Comprehensive paid family and medical leave makes this possible. Funded through modest contributions from employees and employers,

the program would enable workers to take essential time off without requiring small businesses to bear the entire financial burden.

Businesses with fewer than five employees, making up 66 percent of New Mexico businesses, wouldn't pay into the program but could still benefit from it. Evidence from other states shows that paid leave policies reduce turnover, improve morale and increase productivity – outcomes that strengthen businesses of all sizes.

Paid family leave is also an economic opportunity. States with similar programs have seen higher workforce participation, particularly among women. This policy could be transformative in New Mexico, where labor force participation is among the lowest in the nation.

Additionally, paid leave reduces reliance on public assistance programs, saving taxpayers money and allowing families to stay financially secure. When workers can take time to recover from illness or care for loved ones, they

return healthier and more focused, benefiting both their employers and their communities.

When I think back to my six months in Phoenix, I'm deeply grateful for the flexibility and support I had. But I also remember meeting people who didn't have the same opportunities, people who delayed or skipped critical treatments because they couldn't afford to stop working.

Paid family leave isn't just good for business, it's the right thing to do. It's about recognizing

our shared humanity and about ensuring that no one is forced to choose between their health and their livelihood. It's about building a New Mexico where we care for one another, and every worker has the dignity of knowing they won't be left behind in their time of need – because at some point, all of us will encounter a time where we need help.

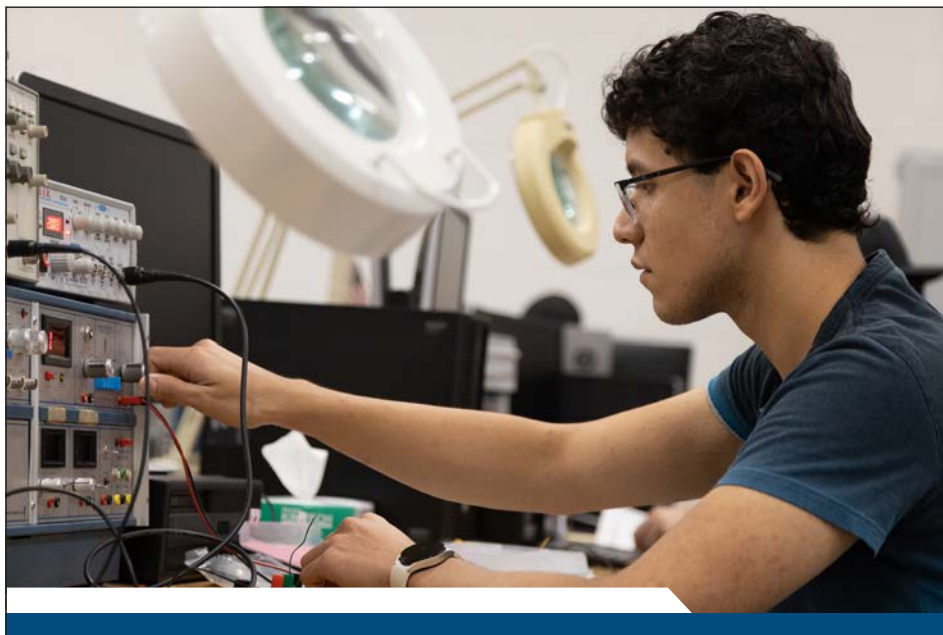

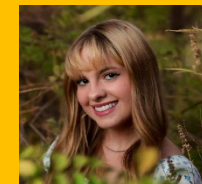

New Bohemians' Bush stops in Las Cruces

The alternative rock band Edie Brickell and New Bohemians was best known for the hit single, "What I am," from their 1988 debut album, "Shooting Rubberbands at the Stars," but the ensemble made music together over decades with hiatuses between periods of activity.

The band's percussionist, Austin, Texas-based John Bush, has extended his creativity into music producing, visual art and, more recently, writing fiction. On a January tour across Texas, New Mexico and Colorado, Bush is stopping in Las Cruces Jan. 18 to read and play music.

Bush will read from his novel, "Queen Daffodil's Demise," and play with Cleve and Sweet Mary Hattersley of the band Greezy Wheels. Hattersley said the Las Cruces event will also feature the Blazing Butlers "with a Cajun overture with twin fiddles."

The tour kicks off in Dallas on Jan. 10, with stops in Austin, Marfa, and Alpine, Texas; Las Cruces, Albuquerque and Santa Fe; and finish up in Manitou Springs, Colo. on Jan. 28.

In a news release, Bush said his presentation combines reading with improvised percussion loops. At some of the eight tour stops, he also exhibits works of art fashioned from used drumheads. In a news release in Austin, Bush stated, "Instead of throwing away my used drumheads, I paint them. Most of them are abstract faces. I've been collecting them for years..."

The recently self-published "Queen Daffodil's Demise" is described by Bush as "a cosmic dystopian fairytale about the powers of the mind and the struggles between good and evil."

Bush will appear at the Center for Spiritual Living in downtown Las Cruces, 575 N. Main Street, at 7 p.m. on Jan. 18, according to the news release. The Center's website indicates the event is scheduled to conclude around 9:30 p.m. Downtown Blues Coffee will provide snacks, coffee and matcha, per the release.

Q: It's good to see Jon Hamm doing series work again with "Landman," but what was his first TV series?

A: Though AMC's "Mad Men" (2007-15) certainly was the show that cemented his television cred as advertising executive Don Draper, Hamm had a couple of series roles prior to that show. He appeared regularly on the NBC drama "Providence" during its 2000-01 season as a firefighter, then he played a police inspector on

the largely female-driven Lifetime series "The Division" for the last three of its four seasons (2002-04).

During the 2006-07 season, Hamm has recurring parts on two shows, CBS's "The Unit" and ABC's "What About Brian." Then came "Mad Men," which changed his career trajectory and earned him awards including a Primetime Emmy and two Golden Globes. Even before that show was over, though, he appeared in "A Young Doctor's Handbook" (2013-14) on Ovation – and right after "Mad Men," he joined Netflix's "Unbreakable Kimmy Schmidt" (2015-19) in another recurring role.

Also in 2015, Hamm was in the ensemble cast of Netflix's "Wet Hot American Summer: First Day of

Camp." He did considerable voice work in animated shows including Comedy Central's "TripTank" (2015-16), Prime Video's "All or Nothing" (2016-20) and the Internet series "The Amazing Gayl Pile" (2016-18). Hamm also co-starred in Prime Video's "Good Omens," which debuted seasons in 2019 and 2023 and still has a series finale in the works.

After more animation voiceover work in Fox's "Bless the Harts" in 2020-21, Hamm was in Season 3 of Apple TV+'s "The Morning Show" (2023) and the fifth season of FX's " Fargo" (2023-24). He's also in the voice cast of Fox's continuing "Grimsburg" (which has been renewed for a second season) as he plays an oil-industry magnate in Paramount+'s podcast-inspired "Landman."

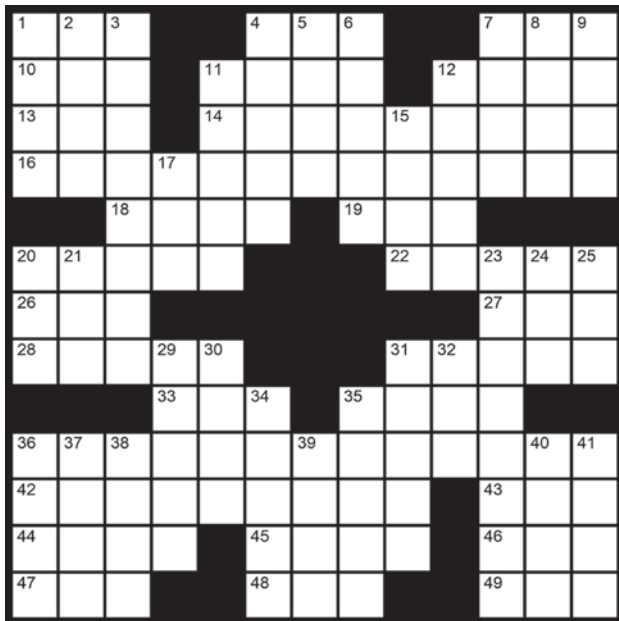

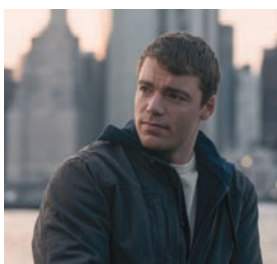

Both December and 2024 outperformed market expectations

Nationwide, December is referred to as the slow month in real estate. Las Cruces, however, had its own rhythm, which resulted in some good news for those selling homes in the winter season. The number of closings, the increase in sold prices and even the list-to-sale price ratio all increased compared to the prior year.

Homes spent more time on the market, which may have been a result of higher-priced homes at the beginning of a listing

period.

A majority of listings saw at least one price drop before going under contract. Sellers took a breather last month as Las Cruces saw a large drop in new listings compared to the prior year. Absorption rates were down by over 20 percent compared to this time in 2023, indicating Las Cruces is still in a strong sellers' market with just a little over four months of current inventory available.

With December numbers finally here, I can report that 2024 has officially outperformed 2023 in the

number of closed sales.

Despite high interest rates, buyers and sellers are still finding a way to get to the closing table.

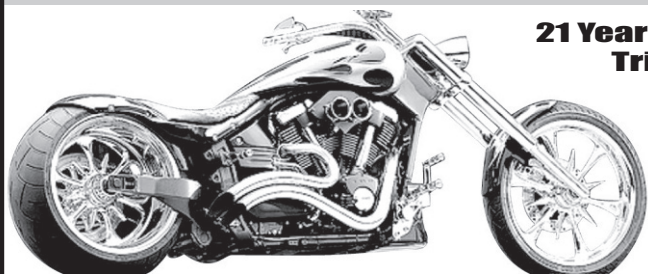

Owner says AmadorLive to close, blames market

BULLETIN REPORT

The AmadorLive Eatery and Entertainment District in downtown Las Cruces, a collection of restaurants and event spaces, announced on Jan. 6 that it would close in the near future.

In a video released on the venue's Facebook page, owner Max Bower announced the closure but did not say when the final day would be. He blamed market conditions for the closure. The Bulletin reached out to Bower for comment and is awaiting a response.

"2024 was a tough year

for a lot of people in town, a tough year for a lot of businesses. Amador was no exception," Bower said in the video.

Bower opened the space in March 2019. The complex contained four brands: Amador Patio Bar Grill, Broken Spoke Tap-house, JAX and 575.

The venue was part of a \$6.5 million public-private partnership with the city of Las Cruces, which invested the money in redeveloping the area.

"It's one of those things that, if there was a light at the end of the tunnel, we could probably find a way to keep it going," Bower

said. "But at this time, the way things are, it's just something that we are not prepared to do."

Bower thanked customers of the last six years and left open the possibility of reopening in the future.

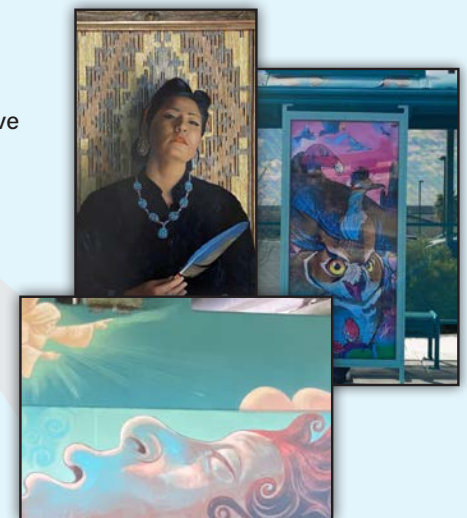

CITY OF LAS CRUCES, ET AL., CIV-23-00952 AND PAYING THE COSTS OF ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE METHOD OF SALE OF THE BONDS PURSUANT TO A NEGOTIATED PUBLIC SALE WITH AN UNDERWRITER; PROVIDING FOR THE MATURITY DATES AND AMOUNTS, INTEREST RATES, PRICES, REDEMPTION FEATURES AND OTHER FINAL TERMS OF THE BONDS TO BE ESTABLISHED IN A PRICING CERTIFICATE; DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY FINANCIAL SERVICES DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A PRICING CERTIFICATE AND BOND PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE SALE OF THE SERIES 2025 BONDS; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER DETAILS CONCERNING THE BONDS.

A general summary of the Ordinance is: The Ordinance authorizes the issuance and sale of (1) the City of Las Cruces, New Mexico Taxable Municipal Gross Receipts Tax (One-Half Percent) Revenue Bonds, Series 2025, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$21,000,000 for the purpose of paying, discharging, and satisfying the City's risk management measures entered into in the Full and Final Release of All

Claims and Indemnity Agreement in connection with Estate of Teresa Gomez, et al. v. City of Las Cruces, et al., CIV-23-00952 and paying the costs of issuance of the Bonds; provides that the Bonds will be payable and collectible from the revenues derived from 0.50% municipal gross receipts tax imposed by the City pursuant to Ordinance Nos. 385 and 427; provides that the maturity dates, interest rates, redemption provisions and other details of each series of the Bonds will be as established in the Pricing Certificate, and delegate authority to the City Manager or City Financial Services Director to execute and deliver the Pricing Certificate and Bond Purchase Agreement; provides a form of the Bonds; approves preparation, execution and delivery of certain documents relating to the Bonds, including the Preliminary Official Statement, Official Statement and Continuing Disclosure Undertaking; makes covenants for the benefit of owners of the Bonds; ratifies action previously taken in connection with the Bonds; and repeals all action in conflict with the Ordinance.

'NMSU needed a change.' Ferme speaks after firing Mario Moccia

New Mexico State University's athletics department is turning the page after a decade of Mario Moccia at the helm.

That was the main message that new NMSU president Valerio Ferme and acting athletics director Amber Burdge hoped to impart during a news conference a day after announcing Moccia's firing. Ferme officially started at NMSU as interim president in November, and assumed the presidency outright on Jan. 1. Ferme

confirmed Friday that Moccia had been fired and did not resign.

"My assessment was that NMSU needed a change," Ferme said in a prepared statement to start the news conference. "Because it has been two and a half years that we have been embroiled in controversy with athletics. ... We need to do better."

Ferme also confirmed that Burdge, who has been the deputy athletics director for strategic initiatives and leadership and deputy Title IX coordinator since August

and previously served as senior associate athletics

director since December 2022, will hold the position for at least six months. No national search will occur in that time, and Burdge has Ferme's "full confidence," he said.

For her part, Burdge thanked Moccia for bringing her on and thanked the NMSU administration for trusting her. "This is not a time for a break, and we, as an athletic department, will continue moving forward. We owe that to our student-athletes, our coaches, and our staff," she said.

The New Mexico Department of Justice released a scathing report on Dec. 19 that found systemic failures and oversights contributed to three basketball players sexually assaulting teammates as part of ritual hazing during the 2022-23 season. The report found

that the assaults occurred in an environment characterized by a toxic culture that permeated the basketball program, opportunities to observe and intervene were missed by those close to the team and institutional safeguards were insufficient to prevent or address misconduct.

Ultimately, then-Chancellor Dan Arvizu suspended the men's basketball program for a year following the revelations. Criminal charges and civil lawsuits followed, yet Arvizu moved to give Moccia a five-year contract extension despite the controversies.

As to the remainder of Moccia's contract, Ferme said, "We are not providing a buyout at this point."

Public records show Moccia signed a five-year extension in 2023 with a salary of \$371,800 in 2024. He was set to receive yearly increases that would have bumped his salary to \$391,800 in 2025, \$400,000 in 2026 and \$425,000 in 2027.

It's unclear whether Moccia will sue NMSU over the firing. He has not responded to requests for comment from several media outlets.

As for the department's future, Burdge and Ferme said the top goal will be implementing the suggested changes from the NMDOJ report. Those

changes were described as:

- **Enhanced Coordination:** Develop written guidelines for collaboration between the Athletic Department, Office of Institutional Equity, and Dean of Students.

- **Mandatory Training:** Institute recurring Title IX and anti-hazing training for all students and staff.

- **Consistent Discipline:** Enforce proportional disciplinary measures for student-athletes based on the severity of misconduct.

- **Recruiting Scrutiny:** Strengthen standards for recruiting practices and coach/player vetting.

- **Leadership Commitment:** Ensure senior leadership prioritizes and adequately funds safety initiatives and programming.

- **Resource Center Creation:** Establish a center dedicated to sexual violence education, prevention, and victim advocacy.

"I've just stepped into this role yesterday, and it was quite a surprise, so I do need a little bit of time, but one thing that I will say is that we'll continue with the forward momentum that we have built and that includes supporting everyone that I've mentioned before, in terms of our student-athletes, our coaches and our staff," Burdge said.

Remembering Jackie Burke, Chi Chi Rodriguez

John Joseph Burke, Jr. – Jackie Burke to the golf world – was born in Fort Worth, Texas, and passed away on January 19, 2024, just 10 days shy of his 101st birthday. After high school, Burke attended Rice University. He played in the U.S. Open in 1941 but missed the cut. In 1942, Burke joined the Marine Corps and was stationed at Air Station Miramar in California, where he taught combat skills to marines headed overseas for World War II. He served until 1946. After several club teaching jobs, he turned to professional tour golf in 1949. Burke's finest year was in 1956, when he won both the Masters and the

PGA Championship. In all he won 16 PGA Tour tournaments. In 1956 he won Player of the Year; in 2003 he was presented with the PGA Tour Lifetime Achievement Award; and in 2004 he won the Bob Jones Award for sportsmanship. He was inducted into the World Golf Hall of Fame in 2000.

In 1957, as his playing career was winding down, he and Jimmy Demaret founded Champions Golf Club in Houston, which has hosted dozens of professional and amateur tournaments over the years, including the PGA

Championship a total of five times. In his wonderful 2006 book, "It's Only A Game: Words of Wisdom From A Lifetime in Golf," he wrote: "Sometimes we win because we control our performance and expect success.

Most of the time, though, we win because others lose. Be cautious about judging yourself a champion." Also: "Don't let the thought of improving turn into a fantasy. We have enough dreamers. Get out on the course and go to work."

Chi Chi Rodriguez, one of the most popular and most entertaining

ever in professional golf, passed away on August 8, 2024 at age 88. Born Juan Antonio Rodriguez, Jr. on October 23, 1935 in Rio Piedras, Puerto Rico, he was one of six children. He played baseball as a young man and adopted the name "Chi Chi" for himself after his favorite baseball player in Puerto Rico, Chi Chi Flores. As a boy he began caddying at a course in Puerto Rico and taught himself to play golf using limbs from guava trees to propel crushed tin cans into holes he had dug on baseball fields. When he was 12 he shot 67 with real golf balls on a real golf course.

Rodriguez played 591

PGA Tour events and made 422 cuts; he would win eight times on the PGA Tour, winning by one stroke over Arnold Palmer in the 1964 Western Open and winning the 1972 Byron Nelson Classic in a playoff over Billy Casper. He would later win 22 tournaments on the PGA Tour Championships. He was inducted into the World Golf Hall of Fame in 1992.

As a player, he wasn't always appreciated by other members of the tour, and some were annoyed by his antics. Rodriguez believed that "golf is show business (and) I love to make people laugh." One of his most famous tricks was his "sword

dance": after holing a longish putt he would unleash and wave his putter like it was a sword, wipe the "blood" off the blade with his towel and mimic putting it back into the sheath.

Rodriguez was one of golf's great humanitarians, founding the Chi Chi Rodriguez Youth Foundation in 1979. Partnering with The First Tee of Clearwater, Florida, he created the Chi Chi Rodriguez Golf Club, helping hundreds of kids learn golf. The public-private Chi Chi Rodriguez Academy serves grades 4 through 8 with the public school system of Pinellas County for children that need help.
