

# Governor calls for tougher penalties in State of the State

SANTA FE – Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham delivered her annual State of the State address on Tuesday, the opening day of New Mexico's 60-day legislative session at the state Capitol building.

The speech opened with a celebration of "six years of incredible success" since she took office in 2019, though she soon turned to crime and oversight of the New Mexico's Children, Youth and Families Department as issues dominating her requests of lawmakers.

Lujan Grisham spoke before a joint session of the state House and Senate as well as a gallery packed with state employees and members of the public. Frigid temperatures outside did not discourage protesters outside the Roundhouse, while inside throngs bustled through the curving hallways and browsed display tables in the rotunda.

The governor touted gains in jobs, education access, health care resources, movement toward the state's net zero carbon emissions goals and a recent upgrade to the state's credit rating by national credit rating agency Moody's.

She celebrated programs to fund child care, universal pre-Kindergarten and free college tuition, and called on lawmakers to boost support, including an additional \$205 million for universal free child care and fund-

ing to extend a structured literacy program she said

turned to crime, public safety and behavioral health, saying, "Everyone in this room knows that crime is out of control in New Mexico ... we're in a state of crisis."

She called on the Legislature to enhance penalties for people illegally possessing guns after felony convictions, and for traffickers in fentanyl and other illegal drugs. She called on lawmakers to reform laws protecting people deemed incompetent to stand trial. She also reiterated a call for laws allowing "civil commitment," or involuntary treatment, a proposal that has raised constitutional questions and concerns about civil freedom.

Many proposals in this section of the speech echoed calls the governor has made during a series of local town halls across the state – including Las Cruces last July – since a special session she called last year to address public safety was shut down by legislators in a few hours.

She also called for a renewed effort to rebuild the state's behavioral health care system.

She appealed to her fellow Democrats, who hold majorities in both chambers, with an argu-

ment tying public safety and crime to initiatives aiding working families and lifting New Mexicans out of poverty: "...Our crime problem destabilizes the very communities we seek to empower. It threatens the very prosperity of our state, in which we have invested so much. We cannot and we must not let this continue."

The governor proposed creating funds to help local businesses pay for security features, as well as state-sponsored programs for medical malpractice and fire insurance, saying the private market leaves too many people without coverage.

A major portion of her speech focused on the CYFD, an agency rocked by scandals involving worsening rates of repeat maltreatment of children and mounting lawsuits over abuse, overdose deaths and other neglect.

The governor said reforms of the agency had made progress but she called for twice-annual independent reviews of CYFD's performance and an independent child protection authority. She also said the state needed to support foster families and suggested they be exempt from personal income taxes and eligible for increased stipends.

Shortly after the speech, a group of Republican lawmakers responded by noting that the governor appeared to

have adopted several proposals they had offered in bills that had previously gotten nowhere in the Democratic-led body. Sen. David Gallegos, R-Eunice, said his support would be contingent on a close reading of any bills that came forward, saying he would watch for "poison pills."

"She did acknowledge that we have serious crime problems, but she was more focused on behavioral health than on what the real crime was," Sen. William Sharer of Farmington, the Senate minority leader, said at the news conference.

# NMSU hazing scandal prompts attorney general to propose new crime

ALBUQUERQUE – The New Mexico Department of Justice announced on Jan. 16 that it would spearhead legislation to make hazing a criminal offense following a report detailing the administrative breakdown in 2023 on the New Mexico State men's basketball team.

The bill would make it a crime to engage in ritualistic hazing of any kind, and depending on the severity of the incident, it could lead to jail time and a criminal record.

Attorney General Raúl Torrez, who led the news conference, argued that the current laws are inadequate for the digital age.

Torrez announced the proposal at a news conference in Albuquerque alongside state Sen. Antonio "Moe" Maestas, D-Albuquerque; New Mexico Parent Teacher Association board vice president Renata Witte, and 8th Judicial District Attorney Marcus Montova.

The group also proposed legislation that would make cyberbullying a state crime.

"It's time to take a stand and protect our children in the digital space, just as we do in the real world," Maestas, who will be sponsoring the bill, told reporters.

In the NMDOJ's report on NMSU, the Attorney General's Office found that several systemic and

institutional failures led to three basketball players being sexually assaulted by their teammates as their coaches did nothing.

The men accused of the assault have been criminally charged, and some have pled guilty. However. Torrez said he still

felt that the current law doesn't provide prosecutors with enough flexibility to criminally punish perpetrators of hazing.

"They just simply don't map onto the existing sexual assault charges in a way that ... takes full account of all that went into

it," Torrez said. "Because, again, in the usual situation where sexual assault occurred, none of the other exigent social circumstances and dynamics are coming into play."

The severity of the criminal penalty would depend on the hazing outcome and ranges from a misdemeanor crime to a second-degree felony in the event of a person's death.

"We think it's a balanced approach. We think it's a necessary element of any comprehensive package," Torrez said, referring to the escalating penalties. "But I do want to stress the fact that it's far past time for New Mexico to move on these issues."

The law also features what anti-hazing advocates call a "consent clause," which means that even when a person agrees to participate in a hazing ritual, those conducting the ritual can still be charged and convicted.

New Mexico is one of just six states without a specific hazing crime, according to StopHazing, an anti-hazing advocacy and research organization.

The other states are Alaska, Hawaii, Montana, South Dakota and Wyoming. However, according to StopHazing, only 29 states with hazing laws have a consent clause.

Torrez said the consent clause was key because of the power imbalance inherent in hazing rituals. "It's easy enough to

say this person hit me,

assaulted me, engaged in this activity, and you wouldn't consent to that in any normal situation. But there are situations where a member of a team, because they're trying to be a part of a team, would appear to go along with something because they feel pressured to do that," Torrez said. "And that's what makes this unique."

Answering questions from the Las Cruces Bulletin during the news conference, Torrez also addressed the possible outcomes of saddling young people and children with criminal charges and convictions.

Research shows that kids and young adults who go through the criminal justice system are less able to find steady housing and steady employment and are more likely to commit more crimes.

Torrez said he was aware of that reality. But he said that as attorney general, it was his responsibility to push for laws that reflect the will of the people. And he said increasing the government's ability to jail and punish children and voung people accused of crimes was the will of the people.

"If you showed this, including the proposed criminal penalties, to the citizens of this community and citizens of this state, without seeing one bit of polling, I'll bet you right now they're in alignment and support with this," Torrez said.

# **ASCMV** moves on searching for a new director

The Animal Services Center of the Mesilla Valley Board of Directors took a major step in recruiting a new director for the area's animal shelter.

The board, comprised of Las Cruces city councilors, Doña Ana County commissioners and community members. voted to establish a subcommittee and hire an outside search firm on a 6-1 vote.

The move launches a search to replace Clint Thacker, who served as AS-CMV's executive director for 10 years. Thacker left the post in December for a

similar job out of state.

"For me, the most important parts of this are one, that we're able to do it in a pretty expeditious fashion but not so expeditious that we don't have ample participation," said Becky Corran, a Las Cruces city councilor and ASCMV board member. "But I also think we might need a conversation about where we see community input in all of this."

For about an hour, the board debated the merits of hiring a firm to conduct the search. All the members wanted a new executive director quickly. But some on the board felt that the city of Las Cruces' human resources department could handle the search without

spending money on an outside firm.

Jess Williams, who was appointed to the board by the city to represent the community, championed the idea of keeping the search in-house. Williams said he was involved in the last two searches for an ASCMV director. Both searches were in-house and yielded good directors, Williams said.

"The city's HR department does have a national reach," Williams said. "They're fully capable of posting this in ways that are going to get fully qualified candidates."

But Williams' confidence wasn't enough to alleviate concerns about unqualified candidates.

Corran said that recent city searches for niche high-level jobs left her less than impressed with the candidates. Despite high salary offers, she said those searches yielded unqualified candidates.

"It seems like something we need a headhunter for," Corran said.

Williams still voted against hiring an outside firm, but the decision received support from the other six. According to information presented at the meeting, the decision could cost the shelter around \$25,000.

Williams will also serve on a fourmember subcommittee that will lead the search and work with the interim director to hire a firm. The other members are City Councilor Becki Graham, **County Commissioner Christopher** Schaljo-Hernandez and community member Gennifer Gates. The board said they formed the subcommittee to expedite the process.

Next, the subcommittee is tasked with finding bids for a firm, approving a job description and deciding how and when the public can provide input on candidates. For Thacker's hire 10 years ago, the final three candidates held town halls to discuss prospectives, problems and solutions.

On the New Mexico Legislature's opening day Jan. 21, climate justice protesters blockaded the street in front of the Roundhouse, demanding state lawmakers take immediate climate action.

Demonstrators parked vehicles on Old Santa Fe Trail, while a crowd of young people painted a clock on the pavement to show the urgency of the climate crisis and demand protection for stolen, sacred lands and of their futures.

The group escalated to a blockade after disrupting the governor's State of the State address in 2024, and staging a die-in inside the capitol rotunda in 2023.

Protesters included members of Youth United for Climate Crisis Action, Pueblo Action Alliance, Southwest Organizing

Project, the Santa Fe Ad Hoc Committee on Palestine, Third Act New Mexico and students from United World College in Las Vegas, N.M.

YUCCA Policy Campaign Manager Ennedith López said since her organization was founded six years ago, lawmakers have largely ignored climate and environmental justice. Her group plans to support legislation focusing on human rights, housing and specific proposals creating a one-mile buffer zone preventing oil and gas operations around schools, day cares, parks and playgrounds, and limiting ozone air pollution.

YUCCA plans to oppose Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham's strategic water supply proposal, López said. That program would receive \$75 million under a bill sponsored by Rep. Susan Herrera, D-Embudo, that would make the state government a



middleman to solicit projects to develop treatments for salty water deep underground or oil and gas wastewater, and to create rules to regulate those projects.

"Knowing that there isn't science to back safety for human consumption or even simply the Earth, it's just too risky of an investment for our communities," López said.

Today's protest follows yesterday's executive order from President Donald Trump withdrawing the U.S. from the Paris climate agreement. Gov. Lujan Grisham, co-chair of the United States Climate Alliance, vesterday released a letter with co-chair New York Gov. Kathy Hochul to the executive secretary of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change reiterating the Alliance's commitment to its climate goals: "This is not the first time we've responded

to this challenge in the U.S," the letter noted. "Our coalition was launched after the President's decision to withdraw our country from the Paris Agreement back in 2017. Since then, our reach, resolve, and impact have only grown."

Climate change legislation during this year's session includes The Clear Horizons Act, which would codify Gov. Michelle Lujan Grisham's 2019 executive order to reduce 2005 level emissions by at least 45 percent by 2030. The bill would set the goals of reducing emissions by 50 percent by 2040 and 100 percent by 2050, and charge the **Environmental Improvement** Board with inventorying progress towards the goals.

# **Managing New Mexico public lands**

**Q&A WITH COMMISSIONER STEPHANIE GARCIA RICHARD**

Former state Rep. Stephanie Garcia Richard of Los Alamos was elected as the New Mexico's Commissioner of Public Lands in 2018, becoming the first woman and first Latina to manage the office responsible for stewardship of state trust lands and maximizing revenue through leases on those holdings. This includes, and by no means is limited to, leases for production of petroleum energy on stateowned land. The revenue primarily benefits K-12 public education throughout the state. In 2019, for the first

time, the State Land Office reached the \$1 billion mark in revenue from New Mexico land, and the yield has grown since then, reporting \$2.75 billion in revenue during the 2023 fiscal year.

Born in Tucumcari and raised in Silver City, Garcia Richard, a Democrat, was an educator prior to joining the House in 2013. In 2022, she was reelected for her second and final four-year term.

Q. What drove you to seek this office in 2018? SGR. Initially, it was the money for the schools, because I am a former school teacher; and remember, I was six years in the legislature, really into transformative government, wanting to push the boundaries and be bold about what we could do here.

What drew me to this office was the money we make for public schools. My argument was, who better than a school teacher? Who better than a school teacher to understand the value of a dollar in a classroom? Everything we do here has a mind towards bringing in as much revenue as pos-

**Q.** Tell us about the land the office manages. It's not all contiguous – how spread out is it?

SGR. We call it a checkerboard. It's about 13 million acres, about a fifth of the state. That checkerboard nature lends itself to certain things. We practice landscape-level land management, because we're so spread out. We've got partnerships with other land managers, or we can actually come into communities to help solve whatever challenges communities are having. Housing is a very good example of something we're doing recently, particularly in the Las Cruces area. Renewable energy development lends itself to vast landscapes. Conserving a particular area, like Organ Mountains-Desert Peaks, lends itself to having a more vast portfolio. We have about 2 million acres of oil and gas development in the southeast part of the state, out of that 13 million.

We have trust land in every single county of New Mexico. We have a dozen field offices spread throughout the state, the concentration of them actually being in the north or the southeast.

Q. What are some uses

of public lands besides oil and gas leases?

SGR. With the uncertainty of the future of oil and gas, we are looking to diversify how we use our state lands. In particular, in the Las Cruces/Doña Ana area, we already have some pretty lucrative renewable energy development there. We also have housing developments that we are proposing for state trust land in the Mesa Vista area (of Las Cruces). We are really wanting the development of that area to be incredibly intentional. We are talking with developers about making it all electric, having a significant portion of both affordable housing and attainable housing, and being very intentional about how we develop that area.

Because we make so much money for the public institutions, we estimate it's a savings to tax-paying households of about \$1,700 a year in taxes they don't have to pay.

**Q.** The state relies heavily on oil and gas for its budget even as it prepares for a transition away from that dependence. How quickly is that transition moving and how does your office facilitate it?

**SGR.** You see varying projections. I would say probably within the next decade, we will see significant either plateauing or a downturn in the production. We look at that two different ways. We diversify our activity on state land to ensure we always have revenue coming in. We'll never be able to have an industry that gives billions of dollars like the oil and gas industry does. It's necessarily going to have to be kind of a network

# Sandoval convicted in 2024 Mesilla killing

# **BULLETIN REPORT**

A jury voted on Jan. 15 to convict Oscar Renee Sandoval of Chaparral, N.M. in the killing of his wife, Shiereen Al-Jibury, in April 2024.

Sandoval, 58, was convicted of first-degree murder and aggravated assault and will face sentencing in the coming months. He faces a potential sentence of life in prison, based on the conviction.

Police accused Sandoval of fatally shooting Al-Jibury, the mother of his children, in Mesilla. In charging documents, police noted that the shooting happened in front of witnesses as Al-Jibury attempted to flee from her vehicle on a quiet segment of University Avenue connecting Mesilla and Las Cruces.

Sandoval was arrested about a week later in Ciudad Juárez and has been held in the Doña Ana County Detention Center since then.

The trial was scheduled to last five days but took just three, beginning on Jan. 12 and ending on the 15th.

# LCPS nets \$200,000 language grant

Las Cruces Public Schools announced that the district received a \$200,000 grant to promote bilingualism and biliteracy throughout the district.

The announcement on Jan. 16 stated that the W.K. Kellogg Foundation, a philanthropic organization that funds hundreds of projects across the U.S., including education efforts, selected LCPS for the dual language grant.

"This grant will support the celebration of student achievements, foster collaboration with community partners, and elevate the importance of bilingualism within

our community," a news release announcing the grant stated.

According to the district, the grant will be distributed over the next two years and used for teacher professional development, student resources and improved communications with parents and stakeholders. The district also pointed out that the W.K. Kellogg Foundation gave LCPS \$160,000 in 2022 "to create and establish a clear dual language pathway for students in preschool-12th grade."

"In total, the W.K. Kellogg Foundation has invested \$960,000 to improve education in Doña Ana County, expanding community schools and providing integrated services that address academic, health, and social needs. These efforts aim to enhance student learning, strengthen families, and build healthier, more vibrant communities," the news release said, adding that the district was grateful for the money.

# **City welcomes clean financial audit**

The city of Las Cruces received high marks on its yearly financial audit, receiving the best possible designation, according to a presentation to the city council on Jan. 21.

City auditor Chris Garner said the auditing firm of Patillo, Brown and Hill gave Las Cruces a clean opinion. That means the auditors found Las Cruces' financial statements are fairly presented in accordance with best practices.

"This is exactly the kind of opinion the city wants to receive," Garner said.

Garner also said auditors found no issues in two other reports meant to test Las Cruces' financial book and record keeping.

Garner said that in New Mexico, audits have more

transactions to test compared to Texas, for example. As a result, there are typically more findings. But not for Las Cruces, he said. Those extended reports include reviews of grants and federal monies. It was the first time in 15 years that auditors reported no findings.

"You're going to have findings year to year, and

Second, we want to ensure that we're not left holding the bag when oil and gas finally does bottom out. I'm talking about things like paying for infrastructure, paying for cleanup, paying to remove equipment and things from from our public resource. We can make money while at the same time that's fine," Garner said. "What you want to see as a council is how are we responding to those findings. Are we learning and getting better? That's the whole purpose of an audit."

The auditors also said that they had no difficulty with city staff during the audit. If they do, they're required to report it.

Garner also pointed out that Las Cruces again received recognition by the Government Finance Officers Association for "going above and beyond," as Garner put it.

The council raised no questions or concerns before unanimous approval. Councilor Bill Mattiace and Mayor Eric Enriquez congratulated the staff on completing the process and receiving recognition.

The Doña Ana County chapter of the NAACP is requesting that the state Attorney General's Office investigate what it says is a pattern of civil rights abuses by police against minorities.

From Here of Presley Eze, a Black man who had allegedly stolen a can of beer from a convenience store. Eze was shot three times in the back of the head at point-blank range after he allegedly took the officer's taser. His sisters have filed a lawsuit against the city. It remains to be seen how much that settlement will cost taxpayers

The payouts don't end there. The city reached a \$2.75 million settlement with the family of Amelia Baca, a confused 85-yearold Spanish-speaking woman who was shot twice by police officer

Jared Cosper when she refused to immediately comply with angry commands that she didn't understand.

"It's only going to get worse. There are still some high-profile cases pending," Green said. "There was a young man who was shot 12 times. He lived, but he's crippled for life. And his vehicle was shot at ... there were 109 rounds, right there down the street from the police station. This was an unarmed black man."

He is being represented by the same lawyer who handled the Rodney King case, Green said.

The NAACP is requesting a citizens' police oversight committee, a proposal that city council members have previously considered and rejected. Similar committees have had mixed results in other communities. At best, they

can serve as part of the solution.

My instinct and experience tells me the Las Cruces Police Department is not inherently racist, but my mirror tells me I am in no position to make that determination.

I don't know if there is a pattern of abusive policing. Sometimes bad things happen all at once for no apparent reason. And, as we consider the issue, we have to also keep in mind Jonah Hernandez, a Las Cruces police officer who was killed in the line of duty.

But I can't help but wonder how many streets we could have fixed or homes we could have built with all those millions of dollars lost in legal settlements.

# Residents, council talk 'cariño' as Trump takes office

**Dozens of Las Crucens** expressed fear but promised resistance regarding promises of mass deportation and repression of LGBTQ rights in a lengthy public comment session at the Jan. 21 meeting of the Las Cruces City Council.

The session was held a day after Donald Trump was sworn in as president of the United States for a second time, in Washington.

Residents of various ages and backgrounds spoke about how mass deportation would affect them, their families and their friends. Five of the seven councilors in attendance acknowledged the fears and promised support.

"We believe that we are a 'city of cariño," Mayor Eric Enriquez said, referring to a slogan adopted by the city professing love and care. "We are a welcoming city. We will continue to work with whatever we need to do and whatever resolutions we need to continue the support and means to help

those individuals here and work for our residents here in Las Cruces."

"Our community has always been special and close," said Lucas Herndon, a community organizer and activist who kicked off the public comment session. He continued: "The Las Cruces I know is inclusive, not divisive. Please work for that," he said.

Jovany Hernandez, a community organizer at New Mexico Dream Team, the state's largest youth-led immigrant rights organization, said mass deportation would deprive him of friends and family who are immigrants.

In terms of the administration's anti-LGBTQ agenda. Hernandez said this, too, would deprive him of his friends and family, many of whom are queer or transgender.

"I'm proud to call them my friends and work every day to make sure they feel safe in my presence and in our community. Those friendships and their very lives are at stake under this administration," he said.

Robert Williams, who identified himself as a business

owner and father, asked the council and staff to proceed as if they were acting on their children's behalf.

"A true leader, I believe, doesn't just take orders from people. They give orders as well and remember that, especially you, Mr. (Jeremy) Story," Williams said, addressing the city's police chief. "I'm not trying to single you out. I know your job is hard. And there are no border patrol agents to speak to, but

you guys (the police) are not the ing for compromise at the New Gestapo."

After the public comment session and regular business, the council responded to the comments. Councilor Yvonne Flores was not present for the entire meeting, and Councilor Bill Mattiace left before the end of the meeting.

Councilor Cassie McClure said she saw and heard things that disturbed her during the televised presidential inauguration ceremony. She said it prompted her to have what she called a difficult conversation with her family.

"We're going to have hard conversations here at city council too. And I just want to let you know, to those that are afraid, I see you. I hear you. And I'm with you," McClure said.

McClure brought the conversation back to cariño.

"Our cariño isn't just empty. It means something. It means that everyone is welcome here. And it's our job to hold the line against hate," McClure said.

Councilor Becki Graham did not address the public commenters directly, instead callMexico Legislature. She asked that representatives consider multiple perspectives and find common ground.

Councilor Becky Corran noted that the inauguration had occurred on Martin Luther King Jr. Day. She pointed out that King faced seemingly insurmountable backlash and disapproval from much of the American public prior to his assassination in 1968.

"It's a basic human quality that we care about you. It's part of what we do here in the city. We owe you a fight for your existence and belonging," Corran said.

Councilor Johana Bencomo. who is often the target of local conservative backlash and has been the target of threats of violence, said that living in the imagination of people who want to scapegoat immigrants, LGBTQ residents and other marginalized groups is unfeasible and exhausting.

"Hate. Deny. Erase. That is a miserable imagination. And I do not want to live into it," she said.

was arrested for breaking and entering (a felony) and assault on a peace officer (a misdemeanor!). He was released within the week. Like his other cases within New Mexico. this case ended with a determination that he was incompetent to stand trial and promptly released.

This story is not uncommon in New Mexico.

This is the definition of what most people have attributed to the "revolving door" in our justice system: catch and release. racking up arrest after arrest, charges on top of charges, victim after victim.

The latest charges for Jones. related to the driver's brutal beating, include criminal damage to property, aggravated battery which may cause death or great bodily harm and failure to com-

ply with conditions of release.

Fortunately, Las Cruces' new District Attornev. Fernando Macías. who has been on the job for a grand total of three weeks now, was able to have Jones deemed a danger to society and he is being held at this time. Thank goodness for small miracles.

It is a common theme in New Mexico of late: people being recycled by the criminal justice system. In safety concerns the citi-

broad strokes, most of the repeat offenders should receive help (in the way of involuntary commitment) long before they commit atrocities or have atrocities committed against them. But our justice system errs on the side of caution, sometimes in the defendant's favor. which may not serve the accused either, if they suffer from mental illness and/or substance use disorder.

These are serious public

zens of New Mexico must demand be addressed during the new legislative session. Mental health and substance use disorders must be treated, for the good of all, even involuntarily. Competency must be addressed because, right now, dismissing it from the docket is only insanity. Bail reform must be rescinded and rewritten, because right now, some feel criminals have more rights than their victims. Don't let

these policies continue to cause additional tragedies against innocent New Mexicans.

This grandfather will likely suffer excruciating headaches for the indeterminate future, if not for the rest of his life. He is home, but his injuries, especially those you can't see, may never heal. My thoughts are with him and his family as they recover from this very near tragedy.

n impressive team of collaborators at the Rio Grande Theater offer us a polished, sometimes breathtaking production of "Jesus Christ Superstar."

Composer Andrew Lloyd Webber and lyricist Tim Rice were rebellious twentysomethings looking to make a name for themselves when they created the initial album 54 years ago. A huge step towards rock music overtaking Broadway, it was wildly controversial to some and enticingly edgy to others.

In 2025, the tools used to stir controversy or evoke edginess in a 1971 staging will no longer shock. Blank Conversations Theatre Company balances traditional approaches to the design with casting that defied expectations. The audience was rapt. Often, a neighboring audience member emitted a breathy "wow!"

Though the production's design is customary, it is excellent. Costume designer Heather Striebel's colors, fits, and juxtapositions are flawless. Melissa Munoz-Chavez's striking scenic and detailed prop design are brilliantly complimented by Aaron Krohn's compelling lighting. Highlights of the collaboration include superb shadow-play during "Pilate's Dream" and the intention put into the book-ending opening and closing moments.

> Another collaborative highlight is the cast's commitment to choreographer Ryan Mc-Mullen's inventive movement, where even the least experienced performers engagingly displayed character and focus. While the dance did not consistently support the storytelling, "39 Lashes" is a powerfully moving sequence for the ensemble.

The enticement of this production might be its casting, which is certainly not traditional, but encouragingly did not seem controversial. In recent years, there have been highly visible productions that cast historical charac-


ters in unexpected ways. "Hamilton" cast men of color as America's founding fathers. A Broadway revival of "1776" used only performers identifying as female or non-binary to depict the creation of the Declaration of Independence. Those particular theatre makers demanded audiences reflect on race and gender in a variety of ways, making this central to the narrative and marketing of their pieces. "Hamilton" was billed as "the story of America then, told by America now." "1776" was pitched as "not a relic from the past, but something that we can learn from in the present."

Though the historic characters of this biblical tale are predominantly male, this production features prevalently treble

voices. Alyssa Gose offers a poised, grounded Jesus. Peyton Womble navigates the complexities of Judas admirably. Kelly Jo Waggoner's Annas and Maya Melody Marquee's King Herod are a joy to behold. Mattie Ruminer's Pontius Pilate is exquisite in every moment.

Director Lisa Hermanson didn't bore me for a moment, yet despite this casting never seemed to bring considerations of gender into the presentation. Gender didn't occur to me as Mary Magdalene (Karen Shaw) was touching a female-identifying performer who plays Jesus. The actors are playing characters, not commenting on characters. The more I reflect on it. the more I realize the subversion and power of focusing on the humanity of these historic individuals in this moment.




# openings," naming pastors to positions that are open due to retirement or changes in pastoral status, following a process the conference said was new and "allows for increased transparency and

MacDonald is also a former music director at First United Methodist Church of Deming.

In a statement the church said it was sad to see Kennedy retire "but excited for the opportunities he will have in retirement to continue to do ministry..." as well as for the arrival of MacDonald.

"Joe (possesses) the skill set that we were looking for as he helps us build on our history and leads us into the new future God has for us," the church stated.

# **Advocates seek \$60M for emergency solar power**

New Mexico lawmakers and renewable energy advocates will once again seek funds and legal authority during this year's legislative session to help rural and tribal governments establish solarpowered centers, in part to ensure residents have stable electricity during disasters like wildfires or blizzards.

Lawmakers also introduced the Local Solar Access Fund last year. unsuccessfully. This year,

the \$60 million funding request is reduced by \$50 million, along with other tweaks like making land grants eligible, sponsors said during a Jan. 17 news conference organized by Public Power New Mexico.

"I feel very optimistic that this is our year to truly deliver on these benefits for rural communities," said House Majority Leader Reena Szczepanski, D-Santa Fe, who is sponsoring the legislation along with Sen. Harold Pope, D-Albuquerque. If passed, the New Mex-

ico Finance Authority would, after establishing rules with help from the state energy department, provide grants to small public entities like counties. school districts and tribes and pueblos to help them plan for, purchase and install solar energy systems on public buildings and other infrastructure they own.

In addition to expanding the use of renewable energy, the grants would help rural areas be more self-reliant and resilient to power outages, including those that might occur

"We had a couple of bad wind storms earlier in the year that knocked out

the power and we were able to maintain all of the functions of the fire staconference. "The emergency power switches on within about two seconds we were able to not only serve the purposes of the fire station, but also of the community."

The funding would also provide grants for technical assistance to apply for federal funding or to design solar systems. Ruidoso Mayor Lynn Crawford said it took years for the village to understand and design the solar power system that will soon power its wastewater treatment plant.

For the fourth time this season, women's basketball player Molly Kaiser has earned CUSA Player of the Week for New Mexico State.

In the Aggies' first matchup last week, Kaiser sunk 11 field goals along with flushing a perfect 5-for-5 at the charity stripe to record 28 points on FIU while picking up two steals and a defensive rebound in the process. Her incredible shooting performance, which included a wild contested step-back fade away in the third quarter, rallied her a team a 24 point victory over the Panthers.

In her second matchup, she

scored a massive 31 points for the Aggies as they took on Liberty. This is now the fourth time in the 2024/25 season that she has finished with 30+ points in a single game as she continues to lead the conference in scoring. The Watuaga,

Texas native has now moved up to ninth on the national rankings list in points per game (22.1) and seventh nationally ranked in total points (397). While knocking down her 10 field goals on Saturday, Kaiser also went 10-for-11 at the line. This is the first time in nearly five years that an Aggie has made 10 free throws in a single game (January 30, 2020). Molly now also sits in seventh nationally and first in the conference in free throws made, having scored 109 thus far this season.

# Is tech-infused TGL worth watching?

If you didn't watch the debut of TGL golf on ESPN a couple of weeks ago, you were missing something special. The hype leading up to the opening of the TGL brief indoor season was major. spurred by stakeholders Tiger Woods and Rory McIlroy. TGL isn't "Tiger golf league," as many surmised. TGL is "Tomorrow's Golf League," and was the brainchild of Mike McCarley, former CEO of The Golf Channel. at GlobalGolfPost.com,

The specially built indoor arena. named SoFi Center, sits on the campus of Palm Beach State College in Florida. The format of TGL is for two teams of PGA Tour golfers to compete by hitting golf

shots to a giant screen simulator – 65 feet high by

52 feet wide – which displays creatively designed golf holes, and then chipping and putting on a manufactured "grass" turf green

which changes contours by means of Golf Doctor

600 hydraulic lifters under the surface. Everything is controlled by computer keystrokes.

As Ron Green, Jr. wrote "After decades of pushing back against change, golf has suddenly gone all in on updating its image and TGL pushes the envelope the way microwave ovens changed kitchens when they arrived."

The best part is the shot clock, up high in big red letters, set at 40 seconds once it is a golfer's turn to play. No messing around; no caddies; no yardage books; no lengthy referee rulings. None of the six

players came close to getting dinged by the clock. Ludvig Aberg took an average of 21 seconds to hit his shots. While watching TGL it was a relief not seeing a snail player taking forever to pick a club for his shot, even though his caddy established the true yardage, then take a half-dozen practice swings, then walk closer to the green, then back to his ball, then switch clubs and do it all over again. No wonder one tour player's nickname is "All Day."

Tour veteran Billy Horschel explains, "TGL is supposed to be new, it's supposed to be fast ... you're going to be able to see every shot.

You're going to be able to see guys more engaging than they would be out on a PGA Tour event." Referencing the importance of fan enjoyment, Horschel says, "We have to be entertainers. We have to take ourselves away from what we are inside the ropes and have to be different. We have to show more of ourselves in here at TGL." It strikes me that Tiger Woods – a co-founder of TGL with Rory McIlroy - wouldn't have signed on 20 years ago due to his disdain for the media.

With the much-anticipated launch of TGL, there are a number of questions that emerge. First, is TGL worth

watching? Apparently one million TV viewers thought so. But will it have legs to keep going?
