





Since its founding in 1968, the foundation has awarded more than 19,000 grants totaling more than \$1.2 billion.

Locally, The Dennison Lions Club and its members work to support the Dennison area in a variety of ways. This includes awarding scholarships each year to area graduating students or making donations to families and individuals that may be experiencing a medical emergency or financial hardship. In addition to local contributions, the club supports area school activities like class field trips that help further student education. The Dennison club supports several of the larger programs Lions International works on like Lions Eye Bank program and The Leader Dog program, and also provide support to other area Non-profit groups, schools and activities that benefit the area and its residents.

The club has continually worked to support the city park in Dennison, helping get new equipment in the park for several years ago. The club also supports area fire departments and first responders, including the Nerstrand Volunteer Fire Department, which not only provides fire protection to Nerstrand, but also the City

of Dennison, area townships, and mutual aid to surrounding fire departments. The club made contributions to help expand the Nerstrand Fire Department to include keeping an additional truck in Dennison and add equipment back into the Dennison Fire Hall on Main Street.

Other local community events and activities the club supports is the annual Dennison Days Festival, The Halloween Pizza and Game Party at City Hall . Thanksgiving Turkey Bingo, Christmas with Santa and Christmas Sharing, The Flake Out Festival (The Clubs winter community event in February) and annual Spring breakfast.



#### Our Story

#### 1917 The Beginning

Chicago business leader Melvin Jones

asked a simple and world-changing question – what if people made a commitment to improving their communities? More than a century later, Lions Clubs International is the largest service club organization in the world, with more than 1.4 million members in 48,000 clubs acting on the same simple idea – when Lions come together for the good of humanity, there's nothing we can't achieve.

#### 1920 Going International

Helen Keller addressed the Lions Clubs International Convention in Cedar Point, Ohio, USA, and challenged Lions to become "knights of the blind." Since then, we have worked tirelessly to aid those who are blind or visually impaired.

#### 1945 Uniting Nations

We were one of the first nongovernmental organizations invited to assist in the drafting of the United Nations Charter. We host an annual Lions Day with the United Nations to continue our partnership and identify global solutions to the challenges facing humanity.

#### 1957 Organizing Youth Programs

We started the Leo program to provide the youth of the world with an opportunity to serve and lead with Lions. There are approximately 180,000 Leos and 7,200 Leo clubs in more than 140 countries worldwide.

#### 1968 Establishing Our Foundation

Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) assists Lions with global and large-scale humanitarian projects. Through our global Foundation, Lions have received more than US\$1 billion in grants to help meet the needs of their local and global communities.

#### 1990 Launching SightFirst

Through the support of LCIF, Lions are restoring sight and preventing blindness on a global scale with the SightFirst program. Launched in 1990, Lions have raised more than US\$351 million for this initiative that targets the major causes of blindness.

#### **2017 Celebrating Our Centennial**

Lions celebrate a century of service by serving more than 250 million people around the world through a special Centennial Service Challenge.

#### 2018 Rallying Around Global Causes

Lions unite to support the global causes of vision, hunger, the environment, child-hood cancer and our new global focus, diabetes. LCIF launches Campaign 100: LCIF Empowering Service to raise US\$300 million to increase the service impact of Lions around the world.

#### 2020 Responding to COVID-19

Lions found innovative ways to safely serve their communities during this global health crisis. Our global Foundation, LCIF, donated millions of dollars in emergency grant funds, providing critical supplies and equipment to hospitals, medical clinics and emergency management systems, including front-line health care workers and first responders.
