We at Seattle Theatre Group (producers of THING) want to express our sincere gratitude to all who are supporting the 3rd edition of THING, particularly the residents of Port Townsend, our hosts at Fort Worden (and all its fabulous resident organizations), the artists, volunteers,

and of course, the attendees. It is our hope that we all show up with an open mind and an appetite for checking out something new and different. This spirit of discovery is at the heart of THING. It is our belief that taking in a wide variety of arts and culture is essential to a life well lived.

THING exists as a unique event in a unique part of the world. The Pacific Northwest has long earned a reputation for innovation and independence. We try to reflect this by programming an eclectic mix of established artists like Fleet Foxes (who have strong ties to Port Townsend), Lil Yachty, Thundercat, Sylvan Esso,

and Cigarettes After Sex alongside exciting rising stars like Soul Glo, Samia, and Thee Sacred Souls. We are also excited to welcome several acclaimed international artists: Tash Sultana (Australia), Black Country New Road (England), The Beths (Australia), and Laufey (Iceland).

We are honored to shine a light on up-and-coming artists from the region: Port Townsend's own Grace Love, Seattle's experimental jazz collective High Pulp, soulful rockers King Youngblood, jazz and hip hop innovator Kassa Overall plus stand outs from STG's annual More Music @ The Moore artist development program: Midpak, Cherry Ferrari, and Them.

Seattle Theatre Group is a year-round nonprofit arts organization with three historic theatres and a robust slate of education and community programs, including the DANCE This camp which also take place at Fort Worden. Get a taste of what these programs offer by checking out a variety of workshops and showcases for our signature programs: DANCE This, More Music @ the Moore, and ELEVATE!

Beyond the music we invite you to explore Fort Worden and its 434 acres with 12 miles of forested hiking trails and two miles of walkable saltwater beaches. On the festival site you'll find a wide variety

of "Other THINGS" to surprise and delight, including live podcasts: Weirder Together (Ben Lee & Ione Skye), Labyrinths (Amanda Knox & Chris Robinson), and Omnibus (Ken Jennings & John Roderick), a conversation with Nabil Ayers (Beggars Banquet label group president, author of My Life In The Sunshine), an encore performance from British Columbia's Modern Biology (Tarun Nayar) producing electronic music from mushrooms, absurdist opera singer Joseph Keckler, native storytellers Barbara Lawrence and Lois Landgrebe from the Tulalip and Suquamish tribes, and the Sound Cave Project making its debut at THING with their incredible immersive sound art installation.

Lastly, you cannot miss our evening comedy shows which take place at 10pm each night in McCurdy Pavilion. We are overjoyed to have 3 of the absolute best, surreal, absurd, and hilarious this year with SNL's Sarah Sherman (aka Sarah Squirm), Jacqueline Novak, and Kate Berlant.


Port Townsend and Fort Worden so special.

For 22 years, STG's More Music @ The Moore has featured exceptional young musicians mixing up diverse music styles with the opportunity to learn through group collaborations, mentorships from music industry professionals, as well as opportunities for production and promotional support. THING performances include Midpak (Friday, Parade Grounds Stage, 12:55 PM), Cherry Ferrari (Saturday, Jeremiah Green Stage, 12:05 PM), and THEM (Sunday, Jeremiah Green Stage, 12:05 PM).



ELEVATE

(v.) raise or lift to a higher position
ELEVATE showcases Black and Brown voices uplifting one another through the art of spoken word. The program shares untold and unseen work centered around local and national historical events, the impact of systemic racism, and individuals challenging racist ideologies. 




