Flesh-Eating Bacteria Is a Rare Condition

DEAR DR. ROACH: What do you know about flesh-eating bacteria? After going to a hospital to get a mole checked, I developed an itchy rash that won't go away. I am worried. — H.W.

ANSWER: Let me reassure you that this isn't flesh-eating bacteria. Itchy rash around a mole can be due to eczema, or it might be a fungal infection or one of several other benign skin conditions. A dermatologist can help figure out which. But, since you asked ...

The term "flesh-eating bacteria" is misleading since it's a disease, not a particular bacteria species. The term refers to a condition called "necrotizing fasciitis" ("necrotizing" means that the infection kills cells, and "fasciitis" references the connective tissue in the body that the infection proceeds along).

However terrifying, it is fortunately a rare condition. There are only about 1-3 cases per 100,000 people. It may occur in people who are otherwise healthy and who happen to get an injury that penetrates the skin. But it is more common in people who have a diminished immune system due to chronic illness (diabetes, kidney or liver disease, cancer, heavy alcohol use).

In most cases, in people with chronic disease, it is a combination of bacteria that cause the infection. In previously healthy people, the bacteria most associated are group A streptococcus. This bacteria strain has enzymes that damage the body and has the ability to evade the immune system. It can grow very rapidly, and early treatment is paramount to stopping the infection before permanent damage is done. In some cases, amputation is necessary; in others, no treatment is effective. The

disease has a high mortality rate. The particular bacteria in a person with this diagnosis are very dangerous, and there are cases of person-to-person transmission of the bacteria, leading to additional cases, so caregivers and family need personal protective equipment.

Effective treatment starts with recognition of the diagnosis. That can be hard; initial signs, such as redness, swelling and fever, can be nonspecific. Skin lesions, like blisters or bruising, can be misleading. However, a very high fever and more pain than expected are big clues to the diagnosis. Treatment is primarily surgical. Antibiotics alone are ineffective.

DEAR DR. ROACH: A recent column on sinusitis argued against routine antibiotics. Your advice, while sound, does not apply to all of us. I am an MDS patient with compromised immunity. When I get sick, it takes three times as long to recover. I feel the rules may apply to "normal" people, but not all of us. What would you recommend for someone like me? — B.F.

ANSWER: My answers certainly do not apply to all situations, and immunocompromised individuals are an excellent example. In the case of sinus infections, it depends on the person's exact type of immune problem. Immunocompromised individuals certainly are more likely to be prescribed antibiotics, and are more likely to be subject to diagnostic testing when things don't go as expected. Some kinds of immune system disease predispose people to unusual infections, which require specific treatments.

Taking care of anyone requires judgment and experience, and physicians who have known their patients a long time are in a better position to judge who needs antibiotic treatment for sinus infection and who does well with supportive treatment. In the case of someone with immune system disease, that is even more important.

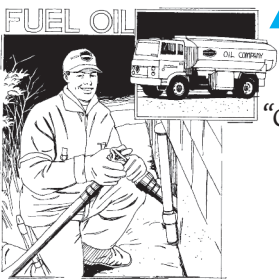

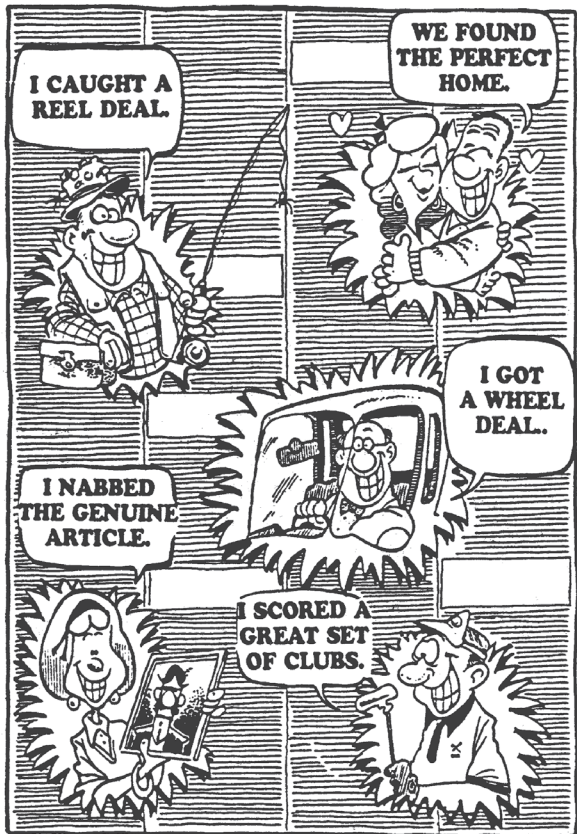

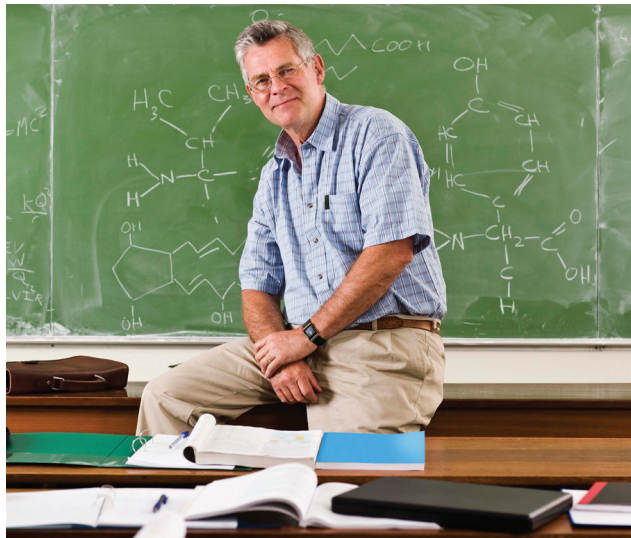

## How To Ask For A Letter Of Recommendation



Knowledge, skills and personality can get students far, but having the right people in their corners can open doors for new opportunities that students might otherwise never have considered. Perhaps this is why recommendations are so coveted when applying to schools.

Asking for a letter of recommendation is something that should be done with forethought. The correct approach and proper timing can mean the difference between receiving a recommendation or not.

### Who to ask

The first step for students is to decide who they want to ask for a recommendation. Select those teachers who know you well or can validate how you performed or improved in class. Opt for a teacher whose class you recently took so the recommendation reflects the student you are today and not the student you might have been when you were younger.

It can also help to ask for a recommendation from teachers or staff who have sufficient experience. Their input may carry more weight than someone whose career is less accomplished. A well-established teacher who leads a class that pertains to your academic goals is a good fit.

Remember to consider the requirements of a college or university as well. Schools frequently ask for recommendations from specific people, such as a teacher in a certain subject.

### Ask early

Teachers may be inundated with college letter recommendation requests around application deadlines and at the end of semesters. It's better to leave plenty of time than to put teachers under pressure. The same rule applies to anyone else you're asking to write you a recommendation.

### Request in person

Underscore the importance of the recommendation by making it a personal request. Schedule an appointment with the individual and discuss why you believe he or she would be the right person to provide the recommendation. Remind the person of your attributes and point out something that exemplifies your skills. Speaking face-to-face shows respect and gives you the advantage to make your points personally, rather than through email.

### Make the process easier

Provide all of the necessary items to help the person along. This can include a brief résumé, academic progress report, required forms, and so on. Also offer any college- or employer-directed requests. As the deadline looms, offer concise reminders that you will need the recommendation. Offer to pick it up personally. Make copies or scan and save the original just in case a mix-up in the admissions office occurs.

Recommendations are a key part of landing a job or being offered acceptance into a college or university. Asking the right people early will translate into recommendations that paint an accurate picture of applicants.

## Lawn Equipment: Keep Safety In Mind

(NAPSA)—When spring is on its way, home owners are often eager to get outside and spruce up their yards. It's important when doing so to keep safety in mind.

"Before you use a mower, trimmer, blower, chain saw, pruner or other piece of outdoor power equipment this season, it's important to refresh yourself on handling and safety procedures," said Kris Kiser, president and CEO of the Outdoor Power Equipment Institute (OPEI), an international trade association representing outdoor power equipment, small engine and utility vehicle manufacturers and suppliers. "We're all eager to get outside and enjoy the living landscape after a long winter, but take the time to do basic maintenance now to ensure your equipment operates safely for the season and is ready to get the job done."

These six tips can help:

1. **Read your owner's manual.** Follow all guidelines for your outdoor power equipment and familiarize yourself with the controls. If you have lost your manual, look it up online (and save a copy on your computer for easy reference in the future).
2. **Inspect equipment.** Check for loose belts and missing or damaged parts. Replace any parts needed or take your equipment to a qualified service representative for servicing.
3. **Drain old fuel.** Never leave fuel sitting in the gas tank of your equipment for more than 30 days. Untreated gasoline (without a fuel stabilizer) left in the system will deteriorate, which may cause starting or running problems and, in some cases, damage to the fuel system.
4. **Protect your power by using only E10 or less fuel in outdoor power equipment.** Some gas stations may offer



**When fixing up your outdoor living space for the season, remember to keep safety in mind.**

15 percent ethanol (E15) gas or higher-ethanol fuel blends but any fuel containing more than 10 percent ethanol can damage—and is illegal to use in—small engine equipment not designed for it.

5. **Store fuel safely.** Label your fuel can with the date of purchase and ethanol content of the fuel. Never put "old" gas in your outdoor power equipment. If you don't know the date of purchase, dispose of the fuel in the can safely and buy fresh fuel. Always store fuel out of the reach of children or pets and in approved containers.

6. **Clean equipment.** Remove any dirt, oil or grass stuck to it. Clean equipment will run more efficiently and last longer.

"Now is also a good time to assess your outdoor power equipment needs," adds Kiser. "Whether you're needing battery-, gasoline-, propane-, diesel- or hybrid-powered equipment, there is a product to fit your unique needs that can handle any job."

**Edison Phonolamp**  
Phonographs were invented in 1877. The early ones had one needle for recording and another needle for playing. The music was recorded on tin-foil-coated cylinders using a needle to make tiny lines that, when played with

the other needle, made sounds. Thomas Edison, the inventor, founded his own company to make phonographs. He also invented movies, the light bulb and many other things, but failed to create a cement that could be used to make a case for the phonograph. And he never succeeded in making motion pictures with sound or creating a new way to mine iron ore.

His phonograph company was successful for a while, and he even designed a combination phonograph-lamp in about 1920. The lamp was made to be kept on a table in the living room so the whole family could listen. Many versions were made in the popular styles of the day. A design called a Phonolamp was made about 1920. It had an electric motor, metal case and an embroidered lampshade. These combination lamps soon went out of style but are liked by phonograph collectors. A rare, working Phonolamp recently was sold in a German auction for \$1,967.

**Q.** I have a dinette set and I'd like to find out its value. The table has a glass top on an iron base and there are four chairs. The chairs are marked "Daystrom No. 470820." It's a beauty!

**A.** Daystrom was founded in Olean, N.Y., in 1934. At first, the company made metal ashtrays. By 1938, the company was making chrome and Formica kitchen furniture, and upholstered stools and chairs. In 1962, Daystrom moved to South Boston, Virginia, and used the name Daystrom Furniture. It's low-end dinette sets sold well during the 1960s, but foreign competition began affecting the furniture market by the 1970s. The company was sold several times and closed in 1996.

Vintage mid-century design is increasingly popular, and prices for original pieces are going up. Many Daystrom dinette sets are great examples of mid-century modern. 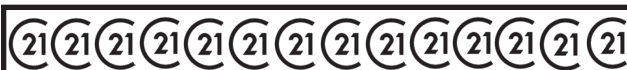

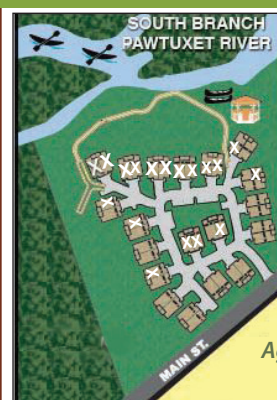

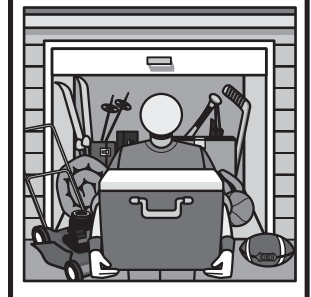

### Planning a staycation this summer?

From the Providence area to the scenic shoreline of South County, family-friendly options are available to make the arts a memorable part of your itinerary.

Artists' Exchange, located at 50 Rolfe Square in Cranston, and its nearby affiliates, Theatre 82 and Characters Café at 82 Rolfe Square, combine to provide community members with a wide range of artistic, creative and educational experiences in support of a worthy cause.

Emily Urban, marketing and promotional coordinator for Artists' Exchange, said all three entities operate as part of the nonprofit Gateways to Change Inc., which is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for the developmental disabled in community settings.

"Our mission is natural integration ... We foster natural, organic relationships," she said.

### The Coventry School Department is using scare tactics ...

I have in no way suggested that we go to last year's budget. I suggested and asked that renegotiations take place and cuts be made at the administrative level (nonteaching positions, otherwise known as overstaffed bureaucracy) since Coventry has double the administrative positions as other school departments with similar student count. This new, so-called budget that they are offering is chump change - one quarter of 1% reduction in the \$73 million dollar budget. So they are saying clearly "Take it or Leave it"... and if you reject, it is chaos. 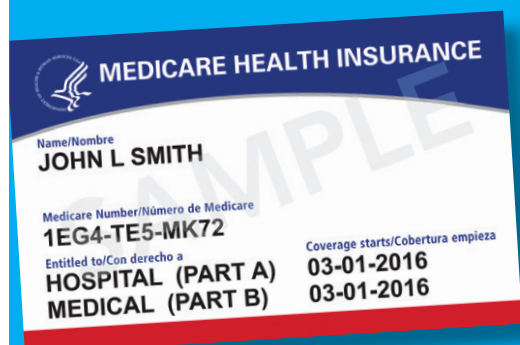
