Yes, Cats Can Learn How to Do Tricks

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: Can a cat learn how to do tricks, the way a dog does? — Will N., via email

DEAR WILL: Cats can be trained to do quite a few things! They respond differently than dogs to training methods though, so you might be a little frustrated if you try to teach a cat to sit down in the same way that you would a dog.

Cats respond best to positive-reinforcement methods of training. Giving a cat a treat when they obey a command is one example of this type of positive reinforcement.

Start by teaching your cat a simple command, like "sit." Work with him in 5- to 10-minute sessions a couple of times each day. Place your cat on a perch, like a table, and give him a friendly scratch. When he stands up, call his name while holding a favorite treat at eye level. Raise the treat directly over his head, where he can still see it. Your cat will need to sit down to maintain balance while looking at the treat — when he sits, you say, "Sit! Good, sit!" Give him the treat.

Repeat this training session until your cat sits when you simply hold your empty hand over his head and say "Sit."

Trainers have routinely taught cats to do more complex things — even using a regular toilet bowl instead of a litter box! You can find books on effective cat training online or at your local bookstore, so grab one and see what you can teach your cat.

Freeport Flag Ladies Retiring 9/11 Tradition

The Freeport Flag Ladies — Carmen Footer, Elaine Greene and JoAnn Miller — haven't missed a single Tuesday morning in 18 years, standing with U.S. flags on a corner in Freeport, Maine. Rain, snow storms, icy wind, heat and humidity, it didn't matter. The Ladies were always there, waving at the hundreds of honking cars that passed. They were often joined by others who came to stand and wave flags.

And now they're retiring from their Tuesday mornings. It all started when the plane hit the second tower on Sept. 11, 2001. Not knowing what else to do to honor the lives lost, they grabbed a flag and went to a corner on the main street in town, waving the flag. Cars honked in response, and they promised to be there every week for one year to help with our nation's healing. They stayed on to support the service members who were then placed in harm's way. That was 18 years ago.

They've been busy, despite their advancing years. (Elaine Greene, age 74, is the youngest of the three.) They've made appearances at Honor flights, candlelight vigils, parades, deployments from National Guard centers, homecomings, flag retirements and much more, always in support of service members, veterans and first responders.

There were all the airport greetings with servicemembers coming and going, with thousands of photos being snapped and loaded on their website (www.freeportflagladies.com). Those last-minute airport photos are most treasured by the families who couldn't be there. And then there are the tiny pennies, each placed in a tiny envelope with a card designed by the Flag Ladies and handed out at airports to departing service members.

While they'll continue some of their activities, the Tuesday flag days will end in September.





Expert Tips To Help Job Seekers Clean Up Their Social Identity

(NAPSA)—Social media is a popular pastime for work and play for nearly 70 percent of Americans.¹ For job seekers, social networking sites can be useful tools to share professional experience, network with peers and employers, and seek job openings, but the content that individuals post on social platforms could be detrimental during the job hunt.



Companies often use social media to research job candidates during the interview process to learn more about them. And, unfortunately, if a candidate's social media presence contains unsavory photos, comments or posts, that information can be factored into the decision about whom to interview and ultimately hire.

Job seekers may care to consider the reaction of potential employers before posting on social media.

The bottom line: Individuals seeking a new job would be wise to remove any potentially damaging photos or content. That said, can you truly hide your social identity? Dan Konzen, Phoenix Campus chair for the College of Information Systems and Technology at University of Phoenix, said the answer may be "no," but he has tips to help clean up your social identity.

Tips to Clean Up Your Social Identity
Konzen warns that what individuals post online can never be completely hidden, but people can take steps to help clean up their social identity.

Can Social Media Cost Me My Job?
The easy solution to hide your social identity seems to be to delete it entirely, but this may not be the best option for job seekers. Hiring managers are actually less likely to interview candidates who don't have a social media presence.²

"Consider how your social media accounts are perceived by others of different backgrounds, such as a recruiter sharing it with a hiring manager," Konzen said. "The best way to clean up your social identity is to be aware of what is already out there and be mindful of what you post."

Individuals must be careful, though, of what content is posted online. Knowing that a potential employer may be looking at your social media presence, it's best to present yourself in the most flattering way. It's not just about what you post, it also applies to what friends are posting about you, as the content is discoverable.

Konzen shares the following tips to help clean up your social identity:

Some social media snafus include inappropriate photos, videos or content; alcohol or drug use; discriminatory comments; slander toward previous company or fellow employees; and poor communication skills.

- Remove any provocative, inappropriate or distasteful photos or comments. This includes ones you've been tagged in by friends. Contact the poster and ask him or her to remove the photo or content. If that isn't possible, untag yourself.
- Tools such as justdelete.me and Lightbeam can help you manage accounts and see who's viewed your profiles.
- Google yourself and set up Google Alerts to monitor your online presence. If you find anything concerning, chances are, hiring managers will, too.
- Edit past social media and blog posts for grammatical errors. Poor communication skills on social media are a reflection of your brand. Consider making your social media profiles more career focused. Think of the type of candidate the employer is seeking and model your social media accounts after that. Creating a profile under a pseudonym can be used to keep in touch with old friends or post content that may not be work appropriate.

Current employees should also be wary of their online presence. Nearly half of employers said they use social media to research current employees, and one-fourth have fired an employee for what they found.³
